**ABOUT LAST NIGHT** - Wednesday's game between the Cubs and Chiefs was a rain delay-shortened seven-inning game in which the Cubs won 5-3. Last night, rain itself shortened the game, as South Bend fell to Peoria 16-7 after six-and-a-half innings were played at Four Winds Field. Josiah Hartshorn homered for a second straight day, and has homered in three of his last four games. Hartshorn has six homers in his first 15 games at High-A.

**CLINCH DAY?**- Even with last night's loss, South Bend lowered its magic number to two thanks to the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers having their doubleheader postponed. Wisconsin has attempted to play a twin-bill on back-to-back days, but got just one game in on Wednesday, and zero yesterday. With that, one of last night's games was cancelled, lowering South Bend's magic number. The Cubs can clinch the first-half in the Midwest League West Division today with a win over Peoria, and a Timber Rattlers loss in any of their two games tonight.

**KEEPING IT IN THE PARK** - South Bend gave up three home runs last night, and now have surrendered six in the series. Up until yesterday, South Bend had given up the fewest home runs in the Midwest League and all of High-A, but now have surrendered 45 on the campaign. Peoria leads the Midwest League with 97 home runs.

**NO SOUP FOR YOU**- Catcher Justin Stransky continues to help out the pitching staff in a big way, leading the Midwest League with 20 baserunners caught stealing this year. He is one of 15 MiLB catchers with 20 or more. In comparison, Milwaukee's William Contreras leads all of MLB in that category with 15.

**GRAND SLAM RETRIBUTION (x2)** - On May 29 and May 30 against Fort Wayne, Drew Bowser had back-to-back games with a grand slam, becoming the first South Bend Cubs player (since 2015) to accomplish that feat. Bowser joins the likes of Hank Aaron, Willie McCovey, Billy Williams, and Jorge Posada, who all did that in MLB. The last MLB player to do it was Casey Schmitt with the Giants in 2025. On a Sunday in Dayton last July, the Cubs and Dragons had their game cancelled due to rain in the 4th inning. Bowser had hit an early grand slam that day, and with the rain, stats from the game did not count. Bowser has homered in three of his last four home games.

**THE KANE TRAIN** - No. 6 Chicago Cubs prospect Kane Kepley leads High-A in stolen bases (32) and all of affiliated baseball (MLB and MiLB) in runs scored (67). Kepley, who broke the South Bend Cubs records (since 2015) for walks, stolen bases, and runs scored before the end of May, became the first Midwest League player since Byron Buxton (2013) to score at least 55 runs by the end of May. South Bend's everyday lead-off hitter also leads all of High-A in on-base percentage with runners in scoring position at .592. Ty Southisene is second in that category at .569.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Had his most struggle-filled start with the Cubs on June 5 at Quad Cities, giving up four runs on six hits in a single inning. Did not walk or strike out a batter. Had to throw 33 pitches in the inning.

Florentino began the year on the Development List, making his 2026 debut in the Arizona Complex League on May 4 against the ACL Guardians. In that start, he allowed one earned run in 3.1 innings. Florentino joined the South Bend rotation from there and made his Midwest League debut on May 10 against Lansing.

**ORGANIZATION'S HIGHEST PITCHING HONOR:** Florentino was named the 2025 Chicago Cubs Minor League Pitcher of the Year. After throwing in five ACL games in 2025, he was promoted to Low-A Myrtle Beach, where through the season he added 5 MPH to his four seam fastball. Went 4-3 with MB, with a 1.96 ERA in 11 games and 10 starts. Batters hit .187. Allowed one home run in 59.2 IP. Walked 20, struck out 67.

\*Pitched six shutout innings twice with Pelicans striking out nine against Augusta on July 18, and seven at Columbia on August 15.

**SOUTH BEND'S TOP PITCHING PROSPECT:** Ranked as the Chicago Cubs No. 17 overall prospect. Signed for \$10,000 out of the Dominican Republic at the age of 18 in 2023.

**OTHER CAREER NOTES:** Signed as an International Free Agent with the Chicago Cubs on January 15, 2023... Born in Azua, Dominican Republic, hometown of MLB pitcher Sandy Alcantara, former Big League infielder Maikel Franco, and former Fort Wayne TinCap Esteury Ruiz.. Pitched two seasons in the Dominican Summer League in 2023 and 2024, working 23 total games.. In 2023 had a 3.57 ERA in all relief outings.. Started seven games, with 10 total appearances in 2024, posting a 2.06 ERA.. Walked just 10 batters in 35 IP in both seasons, had 35 and 40 K's respectively ... 2025 was first season pitching in the United States, leading to Minor League Pitcher of the Year season..

**NO-HITTERS** – In total franchise history, South Bend has thrown 10 no-hitters. In South Bend Cubs history, there have been four.

\*June 6, 2018: South Bend beat Fort Wayne 7-0 as Rollie Lacy and Ben Hecht combined for no-hitter.

\*May 6, 2019: South Bend defeated Cedar Rapids 2-0 as Derek Casey and Peyton Remy combined for their no-hitter. Former Cubs catcher Victor Caratini caught half the game while on a rehab assignment.

\*August 12, 2021: At Fort Wayne, Alexander Vizcaino, Joe Nahas, and Burl Carraway combined to no-hit the TinCaps in a 3-0 shutout.

\*July 6, 2023: The most recent South Bend no-no, against the Peoria Chiefs, a 4-0 final, Michael Arias, Jarod Wright, Eduarniel Nunez, and Frankie Scalzo Jr. combined for the gem.

\*Last South Bend Silver Hawks no-hitter: July 10, 2014 Blayne Weller (9 inning solo no-hitter) at Dayton, 12 strikeouts.

\*South Bend has never thrown a perfect game in franchise history.

\*Last time South Bend was no-hit – April 19, 2026 vs Beloit (Beloit won game 10-0).

\*Previous prior opponent no-hitter: September 4, 2022 vs Lansing (Lansing won game 2-1).

**BUDDY BAILEY** – 2019 South Bend Cubs manager Buddy Bailey passed away this past fall on September 22, 2025. Bailey, whose 2419 career victories places him in third place on the all-time Minor League Manager wins list, spent his lone season with South Bend by winning the 2019 Midwest League Championship. The Cubs went an undefeated 7-0 in the 2019 playoffs, and Bailey also collected his 2100<sup>th</sup> professional victory while managing at Four Winds Field on June 6, 2019.

**TERRY FRANCONA** – The Cincinnati Reds manager was the skipper of the 1992 South Bend White Sox (73-64).

**CUBS DEN TEAM STORE** – In the summer of 2012, the Sons of Israel Synagogue was transformed into the South Bend Cubs Team Store (beyond the left field wall). The synagogue had not housed a congregation since 1991.

**THREE-PEAT** – South Bend became the first Midwest League franchise with three consecutive Midwest League Prospects of the Year (2014 Andrew Velazquez, 2015 Gleyber Torres, 2016 Eloy Jimenez).

**SEASON #38** – 2026 marks the 38th season of South Bend being part of the Midwest League. It's also been 11 years since the Chicago Cubs made South Bend their MWL affiliate.

**THE NEW FOUR WINDS FIELD** – With stadium construction being the story of the last two off-seasons at Four Winds Field, a 48-million-dollar has been completed leading into the 2026 season. A new natural playing field was installed for the 2025 seasons. In addition, last season's renovations featured brand new stadium seats across the ballpark, the Kids Fun Zone being moved to the right field corner, and the brand new splash pad complete past the left-center field wall. 'Phase Two' of the construction project has finished up with the installation of the new second deck, featuring new suites and party deck areas. As well as the South Bend Cubs Event Building in the left field corner, which will be headlined by the newly constructed 11/11 Club presented by Bacardi. It will feature an indoor climate controlled environment and outdoor second level balcony seating to accommodate 100 to 250 guests.

**EXTRA INNINGS** – South Bend was 2-8 in games going to extra innings last season. They have yet to play an extra innings game this season.

**2026 COACHING STAFF** - Daniel Wasinger begins his first season as South Bend Cubs manager after serving as the team's bench coach in 2025. The former Arizona Diamondbacks farmhand catcher was originally drafted by the Chicago Cubs out of high school, before getting selected by the DBacks out of college. He is joined by first year pitching coaches Henry Haack and JC Bonilla. As well as third year hitting coach, and former Boston Red Sox infielder Nate Spears, and hitting coach Chris Pieters, a 2017 South Bend Cub. Development Coach Max Anastasio also jumps into his first season in South Bend.
