NOT YOUR AVERAGE JONES: In Tuesday's series opener, Spencer Jones hit his 10th homer of the season in his 30th game of the season. In 2024, Jones didn't hit his 10th home run until July 2nd his 66th game. Through 30 games last year, Jones had 2 HR with a .223/.296/.331 slash line. Through 30 games this year, he has 10 HR with a .240/.378/.567 slash line.

SECOND HALF PATS: With the additions of RHP Carlos Lagrange (No. 17), INF Roc Riggio (No. 24) and OF Brendan Jones (No. 29), the Somerset Patriots' active roster now includes seven of the Yankees' top-30 prospects.

TOP OF THE HEAP: The Somerset Patriots have five batters with 8+ home runs (Rafael Flores-11, Spencer Jones-10, Tyler Hardman-9, Garrett Martin-8, Dylan Jasso-8), making up five of the top 10 in the Eastern League home run rankings. Only one other Eastern League team has two batters with 8+ home runs (NH).

THOR'S HAMMER: Tyler Hardman enters today with five home runs in his last five games after a two-hit, two-RBI performance on Tuesday. On Thursday 5/30, Hardman tied his career-high of six RBIs for the first time since 7/28/23 vs. BOW. In 13 games since 5/17 vs. POR, Hardman is 18-for-51 (.353/.365/.745) with 18 RBI, 9 R, 5 HR, 2 2B and 1 BB.

JASSO IS HOT-SO: Over his last 14 games dating back to 5/16 vs. POR, Dylan Jasso is 16-for-55 (.291/.350/.455) with 9 RBI, 8 R, 4 XBH (2 HR), 3 BB, and 2 HBP.

EARLY BIRD GETS THE WIN: In each of the last 17 games the Patriots have played, the team who has scored first has won. Over this period, the Patriots have won their last 10 games in a row when scoring first, dating back to 5/15 vs. POR. Overall this season, the Patriots are 21-8 when they score first and they are 15-4 when they score in the first inning. They are 3-19 when the opponent scores first and 4-11 when the opponent scores in the first inning.

THE MARTIN MASH: Over his last 11 games since 5/23 @ NH, Garrett Martin is 11-for-38 (.289 AVG) with 4 BB and 3 HBP (.400 OBP), 4 HR (.658 SLG), 7 RBI and 9 R. Garrett Martin has been hit by an Eastern League-high nine pitches this season. The Somerset Patriots' single-season record for HBPs is held by Jesus Bastidas, who was hit by 12 pitches in 2022.

PARTY FOR ONE: The Somerset Patriots lead the Eastern League with 56 home runs this season. Of those 56 home runs, 33 have been solo shots, which also leads the Eastern League. Somerset has collected 12 home runs in its last five games, marking the Patriots' most over any five-game stretch this season.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

2024

After making his professional debut in 2023, Beck underwent an additional elbow procedure in January of 2024, which caused him to miss the 2024 season.

2021-2023

After signing with the Yankees post-draft in July of 2021, Beck injured his right elbow while ramping up to pitch for Single-A Tampa in September of 2021 and underwent Tommy John, going on to miss all of the 2022 season. He made his professional debut on 6/12/23 in a rehab start with the FCL Yankees, pitching three perfect innings in which he started the game with five consecutive strikeouts. He then ended his professional debut season with High-A Hudson Valley, pitching in nine games before being shut down following his last start on 8/20/23. Overall for the Renegades, Beck went 0-1 with a 1.74 ERA, 35 K and 7 BB in 31.0 IP.

College

Beck pitched four seasons at Stanford (2018-21) including the Covid-shortened 2020 season. As a freshman in 2018, he pitched alongside his older brother, Tristan Beck, helping the Cardinal to become Pac-12 Champions. Over 17 appearances as a freshman (12 starts), Beck finished 8-0 with a 2.43 ERA over 66.2 IP. Following that season, he was named to NCBWA, Perfect Game and Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-America first teams. As a senior in 2021, Beck served as the Cardinal's No. 1 Friday night starter and was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, after having pitched to a 9-3 record and 3.15 ERA, which ranked 5th in the Pac-12 over 17 appearances (15 starts). He led the Pac-12 and ranked 4th in the nation with 143 K, compared to 26 BB over 108.2 IP with a .200 BAA. On 5/21 and 5/27, Beck threw back-to-back complete games, including a three-hit shutout with 10 strikeouts on 5/27 en route to being named Collegiate Baseball National Pitcher of the Week and Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week. Following the season, Beck also earned ABCA/Rawlings All-America first team honors.

Personal Notes

Beck attended Corona High School in his hometown of Corona, CA. He mainly played shortstop in high school, until he became a pitcher his senior year. As a senior, Beck was named Corona High School's 2017 Athlete of the Year, after leading the team to a league title and sectional runner-up. Brendan's older brother, Tristan, currently pitches for the San Francisco Giants.
