YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their sixth straight game, falling to the Curve, 7-5, to open the series. The Flying Squirrels took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first when **Ismael Munguia** scored on an error. In the second, **Jimmy Glownke** and Munguia each brought home runs with sacrifice flies to open a 3-0. Altoona closed the score to 3-2 in the fourth with a two-run homer by **Tsung-Che Cheng** and tied the game on a wild pitch in the fifth. Richmond went back ahead, 5-4, with a solo homer by **Jairo Pomares** in the sixth. The Curve took a 5-4 lead on a two-run homer by **Kervin Pichardo** in the top of the seventh. In the bottom of the inning, Glownke evened the score with an RBI single. The Curve reclaimed the lead with an RBI single by **Matt Fraizer** in the eighth and extended the lead to two with a single by **Tres Gonzalez** in the ninth. Richmond loaded the bases in the bottom of the ninth but did not score.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the second of a six-game series at The Diamond. The two teams first met for a six-game series in Richmond from June 4-9 with Richmond winning the first two before Altoona won the last four. From July 30-August 4 in Altoona, the Curve won the first four games before the Flying Squirrels won the final two. The two teams will also face off to close the season at Peoples Natural Gas Field from September 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost six consecutive games since Wednesday to drop to last in the Southwest Division. They are 2-10 in their last 12 games since August 9. They have been held to two-or-less runs in six-of-their-last-10 games since August 10's doubleheader. They have been held to one-or-less runs and four-or-less hits in four-of-their-last-10 games.

THE CURVE have gone 4-11 in their last 15 games since August 3. Last week, the dropped four-of-six against the Baysox at home. Altoona's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS **Tsung-Che Cheng** (No. 7), OF **Jase Bowen** (No. 27) and OF **Tres Gonzalez** (No. 28). Chen is also rated by Baseball America as having the best change-up in the Pirates system. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list including two Altoona players, including Solometo (No. 7) and **Cheng** (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Nick Morreale** makes his fifth Double-A appearance and his fourth start of 2024. He last pitched on Thursday at Harrisburg and allowed one run in 2.2 innings of work. In his first two Double-A starts in his previous two outings, he combined for eight scoreless innings, including four scoreless frames at Altoona on August 3. He was promoted to Double-A on July 26 after spending parts of four seasons in High-A with the Eugene Emeralds. This year, he went 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 25 bullpen appearances for Eugene. Morreale was selected in the 14th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Georgetown University. **For more on Morreale, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander **Nick Dombkowski** makes his 12th Double-A appearance and his third Double-A start of the season. Last time out, he threw four hitless relief innings against the Baysox on Thursday with four strikeouts. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels in a start on August 3 in Altoona and allowed two runs over three innings. Prior to that outing, Dombkowski pitched his previous 14 appearances for the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, going 2-2 with a 4.32 ERA. He was assigned back to Double-A Altoona on August 1. Dombkowski began the season with the Curve working out of the bullpen and went 3-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight outings before being promoted to Indianapolis on May 27. Dombkowski has spent part of the last three seasons with Altoona. He signed with the Pirates as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of Hartford.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 80 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 52 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .294 (62-for-211) with four homers, 11 doubles, nine walks and 29 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 18-of-45 games dating back to June 15.

TAKE THE JAIRO: On Sunday, **Jairo Pomares** hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season, a 445-foot blast at FNB Field in Harrisburg. It snapped a stretch of 29 games without a home run. He went deep again in his next game on Tuesday at The Diamond against the Curve. For the season, Pomares' 12 homers are tied for fourth-most in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth with 32 extra-base hits. Last homestand, Pomares hit a walk-off double for an extra-innings win over the Yard Goats in the second game of a doubleheader on August 10.

TO THE MUNGUIA: In his 14 August games, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .346 (18-for-52), sixth-highest in the Eastern League, with three doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12-of-14 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .286 (120-for-419) in 106 games, which is the sixth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,553), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023) and **Grant McCray** (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: There have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).
