LAST TIME OUT:

THE MAJOR LEAGUE CURVE: Altoona's group features several staff and players with previous major league experience. On the coaching staff Manager Robby Hammock played 182 games in the major leagues with the Arizona Diamondbacks, highlighted by catching Randy Johnson's Perfect Game. Pitching Coach Fernando Nieve made 99 major league appearances with the Astros and NY Mets in his playing career, Catching and Game Planning Coordinator Taylor Davis played 22 games with the Cubs and Pirates before joining the coaching ranks this off-season and Bench Coach Gary Green played 106 games in the majors with the Padres, Rangers

Among the players, RHP Isaac Mattson made five appearances for Baltimore in 2021 and INF Seth Beer played 43 games with Arizona across the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

FAMILIAR FACES: Altoona's Break Camp roster, featured 29 players reporting to Altoona; 20 of which have previous experience in Altoona. Returning to the Curve lineup this season is INF Aaron Shackelford who smacked 26 homers, the second-most in a season in franchise history, during the 2022 season.

NEW FACES: Several Curve players will make their organizational debut with Altoona to start the season. On the pitching staff, RHP Chris Gau and RHP Isaac Mattson both joined the Pirates as minor league free agents this past off-season. Among the position players, INF Seth Beer was selected in the minor league phase of the Rule V draft from Arizona, while INF Kervin Pichardo was acquired just before the season from San Diego in exchange for LHP **Jackson Wolf** who'd been designated for assignment.

NOTHING SULLEN: Righty Sean Sullivan was one of Altoona's rocks in the rotation last season and looks to pick up where he left off last season where he went 6-0 with a 2.82 ERA (14 ER / 44.2 IP) in his last 8 appearances, 6 starts. In that time he struck out 37 batters and walked just 14 while holding opponents to a .227 average against. Sullivan finished the season all over the Eastern League leaderboards: 6th in ERA (3.88), 9th in IP (113.2), 9th in BAA (.245) and 6th in WHIP (1.27).

PROSPECT PARTY: The Curve roster features six players that are ranked in the Pirates Top-30 prospects by MLB.com, including four in the Top-10 and two players ranked among the top-100 prospects in all of Minor League Baseball. MLB Pipeline ranked Pittsburgh's minor league system as the ninth best among all organizations entering 2024, marking the sixth straight year that Pittsburgh's minor league system is ranked in the top 10 by MLB Pipeline. The Pirates have the only minor league system with four pitchers ranked in the Top 100 Prospects by MLB Pipeline, with all four having worn an Altoona Curve uniform (Paul Skenes, Jared Jones, Anthony Solometo, Bubba Chandler).

Headlining the returning group of position players for the Curve are No. 8 Pirates prospect INF Tsung-Che Cheng and No. 21 Pirates prospect ŎF Jase Bowen. On the pitching side, three are ranked in the Pirates Top-10 by MLB.com include No. 4 LHP Anthony Solometo, No. 5 RHP Bubba Chandler, and No. 7 RHP Braxton Ashcraft.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Right-hander Bubba Chandler electrified in his Double-A debut on Friday, September 9 against Harrisburg. Chander retired 13 straight batters to begin his Curve career allowing just a bloop single in 5.0 innings. Chandler struck out 8 on 69 pitches, 51 strikes. In his last 9 starts between Greensboro and Altoona he's gone 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA (9 ER / 48.2 IP), with just 27 hits, 13 walks and 51 strikeouts. <u>He and **Anthony Solometo** were 2 of the 13 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20-or-younger last</u> season. The Pirates and Arizona Diamondbacks (Hansel Rincon and Yu-Min Lin) are the only teams to have 2 pitchers age 20-oryounger to reach Double-A.

THE RUBBER DUCKIES: Greg DiCenzo takes over for the 'Ducks after spending last season as the Bench Coach at Triple-A Columbus. 2024 is Dicenzo's fourth season working in the Guardians system after spending 12 years as the Head Coach for Holy Cross where he led his team to 20 or more wins 10 times. Akron has several top prospects in their lineup including OF Chase DeLauter, OF Petey Halpin, INF Milan Tolentino and INF Kahlil Watson.

THE FIRST TO QUACK: Doug Nikhazy gets the Opening Day nod for the 'Ducks. Nikhazy made three starts against the Curve last season and allowed six runs in less than an inning in his outing against the Curve on September 13. Nikhazy is a 24-year-old from Windermere, FL who was drafted in the second round in 2021 out of Ole Miss. He struck out 128 batters in 24 starts for Akron, a team-high, a year ago.
