SHRIMP CLOSE HOME SLATE WITH DH SPLIT

Jacksonville split a Saturday doubleheader with Gwinnett, dropping the opener 5-3 but shutting out the Stripers 6-0 in the finale. In game two, Ryan Weathers tossed 5.0 innings, yielding only two hits and a walk with six strikeouts. Jake Mangum reached base three times in the effort, going 2-for-3 with a double, three RBIs and a run scored. Jordan Groshans also reached base three times, going 2-for-2 with a walk, two RBIs and a run scored. In the opening game of the contest, the Jumbo Shrimp went just 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position. Enmanuel De Jesus yielded just one run in 5.0 innings in his game one start.

ODDS & FNDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville has earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, that streak heading to three seasons is in dire jeopardy. With six games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 69-74 (.483) record. Thus, Jacksonville would have to sweep Nashville in their six-game set to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018. when they went 27-41 (.397).

'PEN PAIS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 35 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 59 runs, 48 earned, on 107 hits (7.8 H/9) in 123.0 innings for a 3.51 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 146 batters (10.7 K/9) against 80 walks (5.9 BB/9).

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 122, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 81.9 percent of their attempts a figure that ranks fifth in Triple-A. Over their last 30 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 26 of 32 stolen base attempts (81.3 percent).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

In Jacksonville's final five Double-A seasons, the club failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign from from 2015-19, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 34-35 (.493) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.753) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville has allowed the ninth-fewest runs (365) in the International League with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the fourth-most runs (423) in the league with a 5.80 ERA.

BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 18 games, with the club mustering a meager .200/.297/.292/.589 batting line as a team. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 52 runs (2.9 per game) rank last in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 67-52, Jacksonville has posted an 9-9 record during this stretch. Eight of those nine victories have been decided by three runs or fewer.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 46 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 58-for-178 (.326/.398/.534/.932) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 32 RBIs. Johnston reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 115 runs in 129 games this season, which leads MiLB. He is the first Marlins' minor leaguer to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals (Johnston has 26 and 22, respectively) since 2008.

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2023 SEASON

- Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for June 5-11 after yielding only one run on two hits with five strikeouts against one walk over 7.0 innings in a June 7 start against Nashville.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combined, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held righthanded hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
