#### LAST TIME OUT

**Columbus, OH (September 10)** - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders topped the Columbus Clippers 13-2 on Sunday afternoon. Estevan Florial swatted two homers in the win to total a farm system high 28 long balls on the season, while Josh Breaux had his first in Triple-A. The RailRiders notched 15 hits, with everyone in the starting nine reaching successfully.

The Clippers got the first run of the game in the second inning. Angel Martinez singled and reached home on Daniel Schneemann's RBI base hit.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre pushed the offense in the next frame. Wilmer Difo led off with a walk and Jesus Bastidas singled to reach. Estevan Florial crushed a three-run home run for a 3-1 advantage. The RailRiders added one in the fifth with a bases loaded walk to Jake Lamb. Florial struck again in the next inning with his second home run of the contest. He brought in Difo with him who recorded a base hit to get aboard. The visitors led 6-1.

In the eighth inning, the RailRiders saw the first four batters reach successfully. Difo singled and Bastidas with hit by a pitch. Florial doubled in a run for his sixth RBI of the contest. Andres Chaparro followed with an RBI knock to plate another. Franchy Cordero sent in Florial with his ground out and Jamie Westbrook's sac fly brought home Chappy for an 8-1 lead.

The Clippers Jonathan Rodriguez smoked a homer 438 feet to get a run in the bottom half.

SWB took it right back with Josh Breaux's first home run in Triple-A this season. He sent the ball straight away to center field for a 11-2 advantage. The Railriders kept the line moving as Brandon Lockridge and Difo drew back-to-back walks. Bastidas and Cordero each knocked in a run for an 13-2 lead.

Southpaw Edgar Barclay (W, 1-3) shined in his five innings of work. He allowed just one run while tying a career-high eight strikeouts. Aaron McGarity and Josh Maciejewski each had scoreless appearances. Michael Gomez gave up a run in his frame. Zach McAllister slammed the door shut in the ninth, just days after getting the call as the opener for SWB.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**FLO FLASHED GREATNESS** - Estevan Florial played in 101 games with the RailRiders before his call up from the New York Yankees. He recorded a team and career-high 28th home run of the season last week. The lefty was always the leadoff hitter for the RailRiders with 116 total hits for a .280 average, including 23 doubles and four triples. He also leads the team in steals with 25 as well. Florial can play all three outfield positions.

**WILL'S WAYS** - Starter Will Warren had a career game last week reaching a high in innings, pitches, and strikeouts. He has now combined for 13 straight shutout frames tracking back to his last start in Rochester. Warren has pitched into the fifth inning or more in his last seven starts now. In these outings he has not allowed more than three earned runs. The righty holds a 4.07 earned run average in 18 Triple-A appearances. Warren began the season in Somerset holding a 2.45 ERA in 29.1 innings of work. In total on the season, he has tossed 113.1 frames accumulating 128 strikeouts. In 2022 he set career highs with 129 innings and 125 strikeouts.

**STEALING SWIPES** - The RailRiders have gotten on a roll taking extra bases on the diamond. They have totaled seven on the week, while getting caught three times. The team has combined for 161 steals with Estevan Florial leading the way for 25 total. Brandon Lockridge has taken 23 and Wilmer Difo has 20. Last summer, SWB set a new franchise record with 172 taken.

**WESTBROOK IS WORKING** - Jamie Westbrook has produced career numbers with the RailRiders in his first season affiliated with New York. He had his 21st homer on the season, a career-high for the righty and third most on the team. He has upped his batting average to .303 on the season with 112 hits in 107 games. Since June 1st, Westbrook is batting .341 with more walks (42) than strikeouts (31).

**HOMER HAVEN** - The RailRiders have combined for 207 home runs on the season. Estevan Florial has 28 while Andres Chaparro has 24 to his name. Six different players have reached double digits on the summer. SWB sits in fourth place in all of Minor League baseball in the home run category to Las Vegas who leads with 214 long balls.

**ANOTHER YEAR DOWN** - The RailRiders a handful of September birthdays on the calendar. Franchy Cordero turns 29 on September 2nd, while his teammate's Nelson Medina and Jesus Bastidas have theirs on September 14th. Defensive coach Jose Javier celebrates his birthday on the 16th and the RailRiders manager Shelley Duncan's occurs on September 29th.

**LEADING THE CHARGE** - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb being the latest. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects making their first appearances in Triple-A season. Will Warren (#10), Clayton Beeter (#16), and Edgar Barclay (#28) are all essential parts of the starting rotation for the majority of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's season.

**GOT THE INVITE:** At Spring Training in March he tossed 2.0 innings in one appearance...no runs on one hit

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS** Has had 4 appearances with 8 strikeouts...Quality start in first Triple-A outing .Warren began the season at Double-A Somerset, after six starts received the promotion to Triple-A on May 17

**GRAYSON CRAWFORD'S TAKE (AA PITCHING COACH):** "With Will, opening up both sides of the plate has been a big focus of ours through spring training and into now with both fastballs, not just the two seam. Will's two-strike execution has been much improved from last year. That's showing in the amount of strikeouts that he's been able to get so far. I think he's definitely knocking on the door (for Triple-A). We're going to focus on what we can control in the process here and he's doing a good job of that. I think he's going to control the success that he has based off of his execution. He's walked some batters, but a lot of that was early just trying to strike more people out instead of maybe just pitching to contact like he's done in the early part of his career. I think you have to learn how to miss bats and we're seeing progress."

**UP TOP:** 2022 Kevin Lawn Award as the Yankees' Minor League "Pitcher of the Year"

**HITTING THE ZONE:** Can work the top and bottom of the strike zone and both sides of the plate...sound delivery...working on command
