Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds continue their series with the Norfolk Tides in game five at First Horizon Park. RHP Caleb Boushley makes his fourth start of the season, facing Norfolk lefty and the Baltimore Orioles' No. 6 prospect DL Hall.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley gets the start for Nashville, his International League-leading fourth start of the 2023 season. The right-hander is coming off a tough outing on April 11 vs. the Tides where he picked up just one out while allowing four earned runs (5 H, 1 BB). Boushley went 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA (127.1 IP/46 ER) across 25 starts with Nashville a season ago. The Wisconsinite was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. He was originally selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

DL Hall: 24-year-old DL Hall makes his third start of the season tonight at First Horizon Park. The southpaw is 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (7.1 IP/4 ER). He slung 4.1 innings of one-run ball on April 9 vs. Gwinnett but did not pitch long enough to earn the win. Listed as the No. 6 prospect in the Orioles system by MLB Pipeline, Hall made his Major League debut with Baltimore in 2022, going 1-1 with a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP/9 ER) in 11 games (1 start). He also appeared in 24 games between Norfolk (22), Bowie (1) and Aberdeen (1). Hall was selected by Baltimore in the first round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta High School (GA).

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

Strong Arms: The Sounds have posted a 3.29 ERA (112.0 IP/41 ER) as a staff through their first 13 games of the season, the best in the International League and second-best in Triple-A. Nashville boasts the best bullpen ERA at 2.69 (73.2 IP/22 ER), with relievers holding an 8-3 record.

Turning, Turning...: The Sounds turned five double plays over nine innings in last night's loss. The last time Nashville turned five double plays in a game was July 6, 2000, when they induced five twin killings against the Oklahoma RedHawks at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark.

Blake Bashing: After singling in last night's contest, outfielder Blake Perkins extended his on-base streak to a team-high nine games. Perkins has hit .375 (12-for-32) with three doubles, a home run and 3 RBI over the span, good for a 1.022 OPS.

Singleton Streaking: Jon Singleton extended his hit streak to eight games last night, matching Tyler Naquin's streak for the Sounds' longest this season. Singleton is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with two homers and 3 RBI over the span.

Not On My Watch: Brian Navarreto nabbed two Tides attempted base stealers last night, increasing the Sounds caught stealing total to eight, the most of any team in the minors or Major League Baseball.

Erceg's Excellence: Reliever Lucas Erceg's no-hit streak ended at 7.2 innings last night, but the lefty still has not allowed a run in 8.2 innings of work this season, the longest in Minor League Baseball. Erceg is 2-0 and has fanned 10 of 30 hitters faced (33%).

Houser Rules: Adrian Houser (2.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 2 K) threw 30 pitches and 18 strikes in his first MLB rehab start with the Sounds this season. The 30-year-old righty is recovering from a groin injury.

Count it Contreras: Sounds reliever Luis Contreras picked up his first win at the Triple-A level on Thursday night. Though he inherited a bases-loaded jam in the third, Contreras held Norfolk to two runs then worked a pair of scoreless innings. On the year, Contreras is limiting batters to a .150 average (3-for-20).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 608-523 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley started the series opener on April 11, but could not escape the first inning. He tossed 0.1 innings, allowing four runs on five hits, including a homer. Boushley walked one batter. The bullpen kept the Tides at bay for the rest of the game as the Sounds mounted a comeback in an 8-5 extra-inning win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: After Tuesday's start, Boushley has faced Norfolk four times. The rough start has ballooned his career stats against the Tides. Boushley is 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP/8 ER) and nine strikeouts against Norfolk.
