"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

FESTA DOMINANT, LATE WALLNER HOMER LIFTS SAINTS TO WIN: Matt Wallner broke an early pitcher's duel by homering for the third consecutive game, a go-ahead three-run blast in the eighth as the Saints surged past the Storm Chasers 3-1 on Thursday night at Werner Park. Festa was impressive right from the start in his second outing since he skipped two starts due to shoulder fatigue. He finished five shutout innings with five strikeouts against just one walk. The game stayed scoreless because of an impressive 7.0 shutout frames from Omaha starter Thomas Hatch. The Storm Chasers broke the seal in the seventh without the benefit of a hit: Luke Maile reached on a two-base error followed by a walk, a sac bunt, another walk from Ryan Jensen, then a sac fly from Tyler Tolbert. Wallner turned the game in the Saints favor when he drilled a three-run blast in the eighth following back-to-back walks from Anthony Prato and Diego Cartaya. It was his fifth homer in six games on major league rehab. It marks the third time in Wallner's career he's homered in three straight games with the Saints, becoming the first player in franchise history to do so more than twice (see below); he is one game shy of Drew Maggi's record of homering in four consecutive games:

KEEPIN' IT IN THE YARD: Despite facing an Omaha lineup that entered the series having hit the second-most home runs in the league with 61 round-trippers on the year, St. Paul's pitching staff have kept the Storm Chasers in the yard the past three nights. It marks the first time the St. Paul pitching staff have gone three games in-a-row without a homer given up since April 6-9; they have not gone four games straight without allowing a homer since the first four games of the season, March 28-April 4. The St. Paul staff allowed just 1 homer in their first 8 games (65.0 IP) of the season, an average of 0.1 HR/9 innings. Since then, they've allowed 55 homers in the last 43 games (353.1 IP), the most in the league in that stretch, averaging 1.4 HR/9 during that run.

RETURN OF MCCRUSHER: Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks fourth in Triple-A in average exit velocity (see below). Despite spending 12 days on the big league roster, he still ranks 4th in the league in homers (10), 8th in RBI (36), and leads all qualifiers in the league in OPS and slugging%. On Sunday May 11 vs Buffalo, he drilled a 115.0 mph laser over the left field wall, recording the fifth-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history. McCusker has the three hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is the first batter in St. Paul Saints franchise history with double-digit homers before the end of May.

THE MERRIMACK MISSILE: Saints UT Mickey Gasper continued to turn heads with a two-homer game in the nightcap of Saturday's doubleheader, his 3rd career multi-HR game. The switch-hitter from New Hampshire now has nine round-trippers in 24 games with the Saints. With a home run in his next game, he would tie the franchise record for the fewest games to reach double-digit homers in a Saints uniform in a single season (see below). With the Saints this year, he is averaging a home run every 12.1 PA, the 4th-best HR/PA average of any hitter in the minors at the full-season level this year with at least 5 homers.

PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 86 runs across their last 112.1 innings of baseball going back to the start of their last series in Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.09 ERA (137 ER, 202.1 IP), the 4th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball since the turn of the calendar page. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .826 as an offense is the sixth-highest in MiLB in May, and the best in the Int'l League.

GONE, GOING, GONE: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 55 round-trippers in their last 39 games since April 14, which ranked 4th in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Greensboro (60), Charlotte (59), and Sugar Land (56). St. Paul have left the yard at least once each of their last six games and in 20 of their past 24 contests.

FORGET ABOUT THE CURVEBALL, RICKY. GIVE 'EM THE HEATER!: The Saints have crushed fastballs this season and rank 2nd in the International League in batting average (.307) and 3rd in slugging% (.494) against fastballs as a team this season. 34 of the Saints' 62 home runs as a team have come against the hard stuff. Some of the Saints' best hitters currently on the roster against fastballs are listed below:

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (30-25) were off yesterday as they traveled to Seattle for the second leg of their 11-day, 3-city road trip. Zebby Matthews (0-1, 7.71) starts for the Twins tonight at 9:10 CT. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (24-24) were edged by Tulsa 4-3 at home yesterday. INF Tanner Schobel extended his hit streak to 16 straight, the 2nd-longest active streak in the minors currently, with a 1-for-4 day. High-A Cedar Rapids (27-20) hit three home runs to win their second straight at home vs Lake County (CLE). Low-A Fort Myers (21-27) lost 6-4 vs Bradenton (PIT) at home. Payton Eeles had the day off after hitting .303 in the first 10 games on his rehab assignment on the Saints' IL. Maddux Houghton hit an inside-the-park home run for the Mighty Mussels in the loss.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Thursday in game one of a doubleheader in Iowa and got himself into a bases-loaded jam with a leadoff single and two walks. Struck out Carlos Perez before giving up a bases-clearing single to James Triantos. Pitched around three more walks the rest of the way to match a career-high with five free passes and recorded eight outs. Threw 21 cutters (31%), 15 curveballs (22%), 10 sinkers (15%), 9 sweepers (13%), 8 four-seamers (12%), and 4 changeups (6%). Generated five swings-and-misses. Recorded a strikeout apiece on the changeup and curveball.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Raya etched his name into Saints history in his start on May 24 vs Norfolk. After entering play with an ERA north of 12.00 on the season and more walks than strikeouts, he came out and struck out the first six batters he faced, becoming the third-ever Saints pitcher to go six up, six down all on the strikeout to start a game, joining Joe Ryan (Aug. 20, 2021 vs Iowa) and Bailey Ober (May 30, 2021 @Iowa). He came one shy of the franchise record of 7 K's in-a-row at any point in a game, a record held by David Festa (set on May 25, 2024 @BUF). Raya was also perfect through the first four innings of the game before reaching his pitch count, marking just the third time that the Saints took a perfect game bid through four innings (Mario Sanchez went 13 up-13 down to start on June 26, 2022 @Buffalo & Simeon Woods Richardson went 12 up-12 down on April 28, 2023 @Rochester). The Saints bullpen promptly followed his start with a leadoff walk in the fifth in a game the Saints would go on to lose 12-1 in 7 innings.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletics run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his seventh appearance and fourth start of the season with the Saints on Sunday evening vs Norfolk, and was roughed up, allowing nine runs on 11 hits and yielding four home runs, all season-highs. Gave up a solo homer to Orioles No. 2 prospect Coby Mayo in the first and a three-run blast to TT Bowens in the third. In the fifth, conceded four runs, three of which came on a pair of home runs. Threw 32 sweepers (35%), 32 four-seamers (35%), 17 changeups (19%), and 10 sinkers (11%). Racked up 10 whiffs on the evening, including four each on the sweeper and changeup. Recorded three of his five strikeouts on the sweeper and the other two on the changeup. Raised his Triple-A ERA nearly two full runs on the season from 2.16 to 4.30.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp and the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints will mark the 10th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings: he worked around three walks, without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineup in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT! Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former "Dirtbags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.
