YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox ended their three-game losing streak with a 3-2 victory over the Altoona Curve on Friday night. Starting RHP **Ryan Long** pitched five innings for a third consecutive start and allowed just one run on four hits with no walks and two strikeouts. **Creed Willems** drove in Chesapeake's first run with an RBI single in the fifth and **Adam Retzbach** homered in the seventh. **Silas Ardoin** scored the winning run on a wild pitch in the eighth and **Keagan Gillies** recorded the final four outs.

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 15 of the 19 games played this season (2.06 ERA in 129 innings pitched), which is tied for the Eastern League lead along with Erie. The Baysox have also already collected nine saves on the year, which leads all Double-A staffs, and have yet to blow a save. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** is on a team-leading nine-game hit streak, which is the second-longest active hit streak in the Eastern League, and has reached base in 14 consecutive games. During his hit streak, the Orioles No. 12 prospect is batting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, a homer and five RBI. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on a 15-game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team and is the second-longest in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is tied for the league lead in walks (15) and is ninth in OBP (.400).

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is fourth in the Eastern League in hits (20) and tied for second in doubles (7) to start the season. Over his last 10 games, Jackson has five multi-hit performances and is batting .341 (15-for-44) with six doubles, a homer and six RBI. The 25-year-old has struck out only six times in 75 total plate appearances (8% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. **The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.**

LET IT RIP LEVI

RHP **Levi Wells** is set to make his fourth Double-A appearance and his first Double-A start. The 23-year-old started the year as a tandem reliever and has allowed just one run over his last two outings, which have gone four innings each. Wells pitched all of last season in High-A Aberdeen exclusively as a starter. The Houston native was drafted by the Orioles in the 4th round of the 2023 Draft out of Texas State.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (55), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with **seven** so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve are the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Curve won their most recent series over Somerset after winning four of the last five against the Patriots. Chesapeake won two of three on Opening Weekend in Altoona. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): IF Termarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Alessandro Ercolani make his fourth start of the season for Altoona. The 21-year-old has yet to go four innings in a start this year after he gave up four runs in 1.2 innings in his Double-A debut before going only three innings in each of his last two starts. Ercolani pitched all of last year in High-A Greensboro where he was mostly used as a bulk reliever and struck out 93 batters in 76.2 innings.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season - 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore - a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
