### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 24 games over .500 with a 55-31 record (.640 winning percentage).

- 55 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, two behind the 56-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .640 winning percentage overall this year is the 2nd-best in the Minors ... the top mark in MiLB belongs to the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (56-31 / .644) Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- The Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

56 of Omaha's 86 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 31 losses in 2024, with 12 of 31 losses by just one run (39%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 6 of its last 14 save opportunities, since June 5 (43%).
- Omaha is 17-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 3rd-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 26 saves are tied for the 6th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 483 to 391 this season, a +92 run differential.

- A +92 run differential ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just ahead of the Tacoma Rainiers in Triple-A (+90)
- Omaha ranks 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +150 (517 to 367).

#### DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 25 games (since June 9), a .989 fielding percentage (10 errors in 895 total chances) is the 2nd- best in Minor League Baseball over that span ... overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 13th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 9 of the team's last 13 games, with a streak of 6 errorless games snapped Friday ... early in the season, Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 31 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 31 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.35 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .212/.323/.354 ... the .212 opponents' average is tied for the 0th-best in the Minors ... a 3.81 ERA is 2nd at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.53 games ... however, 15 consecutive games entering today without a scoreless bullpen effort is the longest stretch for the team this season.
- The longest active scoreless streak for a Chasers pitcher belongs to **Austin Cox**, who has compiled 5 straight scoreless outings since June 19, with 11 strikeouts in 9.0 innings, and just 3 walks and 9 hits.

TODAY'S START

- Hoffmann is making his 10th start of the season with Omaha and his 13th start overall in 2024.
Opened the season in Omaha's rotation, but was placed on the Injured List April 17 ... made 3 rehab starts in the Arizona Complex League between May 21 and June 1, activated from Omaha's IL on June 4, this is his 5th start since coming off the IL.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JULY 2 vs. IOWA

Charged with a loss for his 3rd straight start, but struck out a season-high 8 batters on a season-high 82 pitches ... worked a scoreless 1st inning, but allowed 2 runs in the 2nd inning on a walk, double, single and RBI groundout ... ended his day with 3 scoreless innings ... retired his final 7 hitters between the 3rd and 5th and 11 of his last 12, between the 2nd and 5th innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games (1 start) and went 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (1 ER in 4.2 IP), with 4 strikeouts.
In his 2024 season debut on March 31 vs. Iowa, retired 15 of his final 18 after the homer, including his last 7 straight.
Made 3 rehab appearances with the Arizona Complex League Royals (R) and combined to allow 1 unearned run over 6.0 innings, with a walk and 8 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Opened the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and made 19 starts for the Naturals with 1 relief appearance (as the bulk pitcher) before getting promoted to Triple-A on August 12, where he ended the season ... combined to go 7-9 with a 5.53 ERA (77 ER in 125.1 IP) and 133 strikeouts (9.55 K/9) between the Naturals and Storm Chasers.
Was supposed to make his Triple-A debut on August 13 vs. Iowa (CHC), but the game was rained out ... instead pitched twice in next series, including his Triple-A debut August 15 at Toledo (DET), where he retired 6 of his first 7 with 3 strikeouts, before allowing a 5-run third inning ... tied a season-high at the time with 8 strikeouts on August 20 at Toledo, but also set a career-high with 6 walks.
Threw exactly 5.0 innings in 5 of his last 6 Omaha starts ... held his opponent to 5 hits or less & 3 runs or less in 6 of his last 7 Chasers starts.
2022: Split his season between the Rome Braves (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) traded from the Braves to the Royals on July 11 along with OF Drew Waters and INF CJ Alexander for a draft pick (Competitive Balance A, #35 overall).
Opened the season with the Rome and made 15 starts in the South Atlantic League, going 7-2 with a 2.36 ERA (21 ER in 80.0 IP), with 90 strikeouts to just 21 walks (4.29 K/BB) ... promoted to the Mississippi Braves (AA) on July 8 but did not appear in a game for the M-Braves, with the team three days before being traded.
Threw at least 5.0 innings in 13 of his 15 starts with the Rome Braves, seven of them being at least 6.0 innings, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts on April 27 vs. Greensboro (PIT) and June 16 at Asheville (COL) ... recorded 3 scoreless starts, including 2 of his last 3.
Recorded a career-high 13.0-inning scoreless streak from June 16 to 29 spanning parts of 3 starts ... also did not allow a run across his last 9.0 innings in the Braves system before the trade, ending with 6.0 shutout innings July 6 vs. Asheville, where he struck out eight.
2021: Before being drafted, pitched for the Mahoning Valley Scrappers in the first year of MLB's Draft League, 1 of 39 players to be drafted from the circuit when the Braves took him in the 12th round ... over 5 relief appearances, allowed 2 earned runs in 7.2 innings, striking out 13.
Ended his season with a pair of back-to-back scoreless starts for a total of 12.0 scoreless innings, named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week both weeks to end the year ... on September 9 vs. Columbia (KC), threw 5.0 hitless innings against the in the second game of a doubleheader ... on September 15 @ Myrtle Beach (CHC), threw 7.0 innings and allowed 3 hits with a season-high 8 strikeouts.
COLLEGE (2019-2021): Pitched 3 years at 3 schools with a 34-game undefeated streak to end his collegiate career that stretched back to his last start at Oakland as a freshman ... including summer ball, went 16-0 in those starts and allowed 3 runs or less in 31 of 34 starts.
JUNIOR (2021), ILLINOIS: Served as the team's Friday night starter, making 11 starts and led the Fighting Illini with a 2.87 ERA and 62.2 IP ... named All-Big Ten Third Team, going 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA (20 ER in 62.2 IP) and 64 strikeouts to 15 walks ... only the sixth Illini pitcher since 1980 to not suffer a loss in a season (min. 10 starts).
SOPHOMORE (2020), JOHN A. LOGAN CC: Across five starts (26.0 IP), went 5-0 with a 2.08 ERA, 7 walks and 46 strikeouts.
FRESHMAN (2019), OAKLAND UNIVERSITY: Started 12 of 13 games (56.0 IP), went 2-6 with a 6.75 ERA, 33 walks and 46 strikeouts ... second on the team in ERA and third in innings pitched ... in the summer of 2019, played for the Traverse City Pit Spitters of the Northwoods League and was named the 2019 Northwoods League Pitcher of the Year and 2019 Northwoods League All-Star.
MISCELLANEOUS:
2018: Graduated from Plainfield East HS, where he was a two-year letterwinner and played for head coach Adam O'Reel ... was named All-Southern Prairie Conference, has the Plainfield High School all-time strikeout record.
Is color blind, mixes up red/orange and blue/purple ... doesn't affect his everyday life.
Uses conditioner and coconut oil to maintain his curly hair, has been growing it out for the last 3 years.
