- The Blue Jays used six scoreless innings from its bullpen and a third inning 3-RBI double from Kekai Rios to take a 3-1 win over Palm Beach on Saturday night.
- After Dunedin fell behind 1-0 in the second inning, the Jays loaded the bases in the top of the third. With two outs, Rios blooped a double into left that cleared the bases, paving the way for the win.
- Starter Nolan Perry lasted three innings, leaving runners on first and second to finish his outing.
- Irv Carter started the bullpen's day with 2.2 scoreless frames, followed by four straight retired by TJ Brock.
- Felipe Bello picked up his second save of the season, facing the minimum in the eighth and ninth for a drama-free finish.
- The victory clinches at least a series split for Dunedin.

SERIES WIN IN SIGHT

With a victory today, Dunedin would clinch a series victory - their first on the road since April 9-14 at Tampa, when the Jays took five of six from the Tarpons. By clinching at least a split this week, the Blue Jays have gone four straight sets without a loss (one win, two splits).

REHAB CITY, USA

With Kekai Rios starting a rehab assignment with the Blue Jays last night, Dunedin has hosted 10 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. This week. Rios and Damiano Palmegiani have combined to account for seven RBIs and seven hits.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

All five of this week's games have been decided by two or fewer runs. Dunedin has played 20 one-run games this season, going 9-11 in those contests. 40 of the Blue Jays 56 games this season (71%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 20-20 record in those games. Nine of the team's last 10 games have been decided by two or fewer.

BELTRE GETS ON BASE

With his seventh inning single last night, Manuel Beltre extended his on-base streak to 22 games - the longest by a D-Jay this season, beating Jean Joseph's 19-game streak. The stretch is now the longest active streak in the Florida State League. Across the streak, Beltre is hitting .323 with a .861 OPS. Beltre, who turns 20 today, is 11-24 this week, racking up the most hits in the FSL.

OUTSTANDING STANIFER

Across his last four starts, RHP Gage Stanifer has been among the Blue Jays' best. In 16 IP, Stanifer has allowed just 2 ER, striking out a whopping 21.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A DAY MAKES

After squandering a 6-0 lead on Friday night, Dunedin's bullpen redeemed itself last night by firing six shutout innings to clinch a win. Largely, the Blue Jays' bullpen has been strong this week, allowing 6 ER in 21 innings (2.57 ERA) in five games.

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays are tied for second in the Florida State League with 41 home runs, trailing Daytona by three for the league lead. However, Dunedin has been held to just two homers this week in four contests - both from Damiano Palmegiani. On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin has not allowed a home run this week.

FANTASTIC FIVE HITS

Manuel Beltre's 5-6 outing at the plate last night is the first five-hit game by a Dunedin Blue Jay this season, and just the fifth in the Florida State League this year. It's Dunedin's first five hit game since Jeffrey Wehler's on July 1, 2023.

PALMEGIANI PARTY

Damiano Palmegiani, the Blue Jays No. 14 prospect, joined the Blue Jays on a rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo last week. The slugger's two long balls this week are Dunedin's only homers of the series. Palmegiani played 56 games with Dunedin in 2022, hitting .256 with 11 homers before his promotion to A+ Vancouver. Palmegiani belted 23 homers in 2023 between AA-New Hampshire and AAA-Buffalo.
