SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 6-5. Austin Murr broke a 5-5 tie with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth. The SeaWolves opened a 1-0 lead in the first with a solo homer by Gage Workman, the only run allowed by **Nick Morreale** in his start. In the top of the sixth, **Victor Bericoto** hit a grand slam to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-1. Erie rallied to take a 5-4 lead in the bottom of the sixth inning. **Ismael Munguia** hit a solo homer in the eighth, a solo shot, to tie the score, 5-5.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the opener of a six-game series at The Diamond, Richmond's finale home series of 2024. The two teams faced off in the first series at The Diamond this year from April 9-14, splitting the set. From April 30-May 5, the RubberDucks won five-of-six at Canal Park. Richmond returned to Akron for three games coming out of the All-Star Break from July 19-21, with the 'Ducks winning two-of-three.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in the series after going 4-1 in their previous five games from August 21-25 which followed losing a six-game losing streak from August 14-20. In their last 13 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .274 (121-for-441) and averaging 9.3 hits per game (121 total) and averaging 5.3 runs per game (69 total), also best in the Eastern League. In their last 13 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels have homered 14 times after hitting six homers in their previous nine games from July 27-August 17.

THE RUBBERDUCKS clinched the Southwest Division's second-half on Saturday night. They swept all six games of last week's series against the Baysox at Canal Park. Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including 1B C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 19), SS Kahlil Watson (No. 20), C Cooper Ingle (No. 21) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes Kayfus (No. 7), Ingle (No. 15), Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28) and Watson (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his league-leading 26th start of the season and the seventh of his career against the RubberDucks. Last time out, he struck out six batters over five innings and allowed three runs in a loss last Wednesday at Erie. Against Akron this season, Bertrand is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (1 ER/16.0 IP). On the year, he leads the minors with 19 groundball double plays induced and he is second in the Eastern League with a 50.5 groundball percentage. In fielding, he leads all MiLB pitchers in total chances (36) and assists (29). This year, he has made nine scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tommy Mace makes his 25th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start, Mace pitched 5.2 innings and allowed one run in a win over the Baysox last Wednesday. Against the Flying Squirrels this year, Mace is 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP). This season, Mace is ranked eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.75), tied for fifth in games started (24), fifth in innings pitched (129.2), eighth in BAA (.234) and fifth in WHIP (1.20). Mace was selected by the Guardians with the 69th pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 85 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

WELCOME HOME, BRYCE: Bryce Eldridge was assigned to the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday afternoon. The 19-year-old first baseman was selected with the 16th pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Madison High School in Vienna, Va. With his debut, he will become the fifth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history born in Virginia, joining **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14), **Matt Winn** (2016-19), (2018-19) **Connor Overton** and **Spencer Bivens** (2023). At 19 years, 10 months and 14 days old, Eldridge will become the second-youngest player in franchise history, trailing only **Anyesber Sívira** (2019) and just ahead of **Heliot Ramos** (2019, 2021). As the 16th player selected in last year's draft, Eldridge will become the seventh-highest draft pick in franchise history, trailing only **Joey Bart** (2, 2018), **Hunter Bishop** (10, 2019), **Patrick Bailey** (13, 2020), **Tyler Beede** (14, 2014), **Will Bednar** (14, 2021) and **Will Wilson** (15, 2019). This season, Eldridge leads the Giants organization in home runs (22), RBIs (86), SLG (.542), OPS (.923), extra-base hits (48), total bases (205), ranks second in batting average (.296), second in OBP (.381), second in hits (112), second in runs (69), fourth in doubles (25) and sixth in walks (52). He also ranks tied for eighth in the minors in RBIs. Last week, he was named Northwest League Player of the Week for Eugene after hitting five home runs.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 61 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .293 (71-for-242) with six homers, 12 doubles, 14 walks and 37 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. On Sunday, he hit a grand slam in Erie.

MUN-SHOTS: In his 23 August games, **Ismael Munguia** batted .353 (30-for-85), third-highest in the Eastern League, with three homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 19-of-24 games played since August 1. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .292 (133-for-455) in 116 games, which is the third-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA). In his last eight games since August 24, Munguia is batting .400 (11-for-28) with four homers and 10 RBIs. He has eight RBIs in his last four games since Thursday.

GO, DIEGO, GO! **Diego Velasquez** is batting .406 (13-for-32) in his last eight games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has six hits in his last three games played with three RBIs. Among Giants full-season Giants minor leaguers this season, Velasquez is ranked third in batting average (.284), third in hits (109), fifth in stolen bases (21), tied for seventh in triples (4), eighth in OBP (.361), ninth in OPS (.744), ninth in total bases (147) and 10th in SLG (.383).

HOWELL AT THE MOON: **Carter Howell** has collected 14 hits in his last 10 games since August 21, batting .333 (14-for-42) with a double and seven runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), tied for first in triples (6), tied for third in hits (115), fourth in extra-base hits (39), seventh in total bases (166) and 10th in batting average (.278).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,543), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duval**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023) and **Grant McCray** (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 3), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 19).
