**SHOREBIRDS CAPITALIZE ON RED SOX ERRORS:** The Delmarva Shorebirds picked up back-to-back wins over the Salem Red Sox on Thursday night by a score of 8-5. **Creed Willems** led the charge offensively with a 3-RBI performance beginning with an RBI single in the second inning. **Douglas Hodo** pushed Delmarva ahead in the fourth inning after briefly falling behind as he score two on a single to left with two outs. The power swing of Creed Willems returned in sixth as he smashed a two-run over the wall in right to give Delmarva a 5-2 lead. Salem used a three-run seventh to get within one, but thanks to two more runs in the bottom of the inning and a pair of shutout innings from Luis Sanchez helped the Shorebirds win game three. Delmarva scored 5 unearned runs on 4 Salem errors in the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan De Los Santos takes the mound for the fourth time this season as a starter after last Friday against Fredericksburg. He'll take on the opening day starter for the Red Sox in **Luis Perales** who is the No. 12 prospect in Boston's farm system. Perales Opening Day start was against Delmarva and only recorded two outs as the Shorebirds scored four times on him with four hits. The right-hander has allowed four hits in all three of his starts and has increasingly gone longer by the start, achieving 4.0 innings last time out on Friday against Lynchburg.

BASALLO ON FIRE: Samuel Basallo has on a roll during his first month of action in Single-A as the 18 year old is second for the Carolina League lead in RBIs with 19 and held an RBI streak of six consecutive games until his run was snapped on Tuesday. Basallo has also been a strong defender at catcher and first base and has showcased his strong arm behind home several times as he has thrown out 8 base stealers this season, good for fourth in the Carolina League. Delmarva as a team has caught a total of 14 base stealer which is also second most in the league behind Augusta (15).

SHARP ON THE MOUND: Reese Sharp is one of the top arms in the back of the Delmarva bullpen as the 20th Round pick from Indiana is tied for the team-high in strikeouts with 17 in just 9.2 innings on the mound, giving him a strong 15.8 K/9 innings. Sharp earned his first professional victory on Wednesday by retiring the final six batters and has struck out three or more batters in all five of his outings this season.

SWISS ARMY KNIFE: Adam Crampton has become a super utility defender for the Shorebirds as he started at five different position through the first 17 games. Crampton has made multiple starts at 3B, 2B, 1B, and LF. He made his first start at his natural position, shortstop on Wednesday night as the reigning Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year has become a reliable defender no matter where he's been in the field.

CLUTCH STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has been off to a terrific start in his first full-season in Single-A as he's batting .306 through his first 14 starts of the year with multiple hits in seven of those starts, including a two double performance last Friday against the Fred Nats with a new career-high of 3 RBIs in the game. Acevedo has a hit in 12 of 16 games this season and has developed the clutch gene as he has three hits this season in the eighth inning or later that has either tied the game of given the Shorebirds the lead. All of those hits for Acevedo have come with two outs in the inning.

LATE INNING MAGIC: The Shorebirds offense has been spectacular putting up runs in the final innings of the game. Of the 125 runs Delmarva has put up, 65 of them have come in the 7th inning or later, registering 52% of their runs entering Tuesday's game.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Juan De Los Santos makes his fourth start of the season on Friday night as he faces the Salem Red Sox for the second time this season, facing them back on April 8 in game three of the season.

**LAST OUTING (4/21 vs FBG):** The right-hander last appeared against the Fred Nats last Friday in Fredericksburg and tossed a nice three inning start where he gave up two runs on five hits. He struck out four in addition to four walks in a no decision as the Shorebirds won the game easily 16-4.

**vs. SALEM:** The Red Sox are no stranger to Juan De Los Santos as tonight will be his eighth start versus Boston's Single-A affiliate. The right-hander was 0-2 against Salem last year with a 6.52 ERA in 19.1 innings. De Los Santos threw a combined 11 innings with 14 strikeouts in his first two starts versus the Red Sox, but only covered 8.1 in his final four starts where he walked 13 batters, leading to 11 earned runs. In his first start against them in 2023, De Los Santos covered 3.2 innings, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits with 5 strikeouts and a walk in a 10-2 defeat.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003.
