**SPRINGDALE, AR** – Starting pitcher **Anthony Veneziano** pitched into the seventh inning for his second straight, striking out seven and the Northwest Arkansas' Naturals offense provided plenty of support, as the Naturals took Tuesday's series opener with the Arkansas Travelers, 7-5.

- After allowing a run in the first, Veneziano settled into a groove, retiring 16 of 18 batters between the end of the first inning and end of the sixth, including three 1-2-3 innings.
- Three straight Travelers reached base against Veneziano to open the seventh and the game turned over to the bullpen, as **Holden Capps** and **Will Klein** combined for the final three innings.
- Capps allowed an inherited runner to score but otherwise pitched scoreless inning, while Klein set down the final four he faced and struck out four across his 2.0 innings after giving up an early two-run homer that brought Arkansas within two.
- After being set down in order the first two innings, the Naturals' offense came alive in the third, took the lead and incrementally added run support for Veneziano.
- After **Tyler Cropley** led off the bottom of the third with a single, **Jake Means** connected on his fifth home run of the season, a two-run shot that put Northwest Arkansas ahead for good.
- Robbie Glendinning singled home **John Rave** with two outs in the bottom of the fourth, then after Cropley was hit by a pitch, Means drove in two more with a double, tying his career-high with a 4-RBI night.
- Three straight singles opened the bottom of the fifth inning, the third being an RBI knock from Rave for further insurance, at the time a 6-1 lead. **Logan Porter** plated **Nick Loftin** moments later on a fielder's choice play, the team's seventh and final run of the night.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 9-6 all-time when playing on June 15

On June 15, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals split a doubleheader with the Tulsa Drillers at ONEOK Field, a 4-2 win in Game 1 and 5-4 walkoff loss in eight innings in Game 2. In the second game, first baseman **Clint Robinson** went 3-for-4 with a two-run home run in the first inning, his first game of what went on to be a franchise-record 21-game hitting streak, including 12 multi-hit games. Tulsa scored a run in the bottom of the seventh to force extras, and while **Mike Moustakas** scored a run in the top of the eighth to tie the game, lost in the bottom of the inning as **Charlie Blackmon** drew a bases-loaded walk to win the game.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 17 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring six runs or more, the Naturals are 26-4, while when scoring five runs or less, just 4-24.
- The Naturals are 19-5 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 10-23.
- The Naturals are 27-8 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-20 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 18-9, whereas 11-19 when the opponent scores first ... oddly enough, the Naturals have scored first just once in their last six wins.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-12 in one-run games this season, meaning 12 of their 28 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Eight of the Naturals' last 14 losses have been by just a run.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in six losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 13 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

**RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG**

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, with a win yesterday going back a game above .500 with a 29-28 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 35 of 57 games this season.

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 - 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of four games under .500 on two occasions.
- After 12 of 57 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with a .500 record.
- After 23 of 57 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

**YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 57 games, the Naturals have stolen 82 bases in 97 attempts (average 1.44 steals/game, 84.54% success rate).

- 82 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and 20th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 18 steals (in 20 attempts) ranks fifth in the Texas League and tied seventh in all of Double-A.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 82 steals this year (29.3%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 38 of 57 games this season, including 21 games with two or more steals, with three occasions where the team has stolen five bases ... including perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 48 of the 54 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 32 occasions.

- In 255 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 98 times (64 hits + 45 walks), for a .386 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 34 times and struck out 43 times, a 0.79 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking fifth in steals (18), tied fifth in walks (34), tied seventh in hits (64), eighth in runs scored (42) tied eighth in doubles (15) ... he ranks among the Double-A leader in steals (tied seventh), runs scored (tied eighth) and hits (tied ninth).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**ROCKIN' ROBBIE**

Naturals first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has settled into the starting first base role with the team, but more importantly has consistently gotten on base with the club.

- Glendinning is responsible for the two longest on-base streaks this season, 15 games at the start of the season and 17 consecutive games from June 21 to June 10, a streak snapped Saturday night.
- The Australian reached in the first 15 games he played in 2022, hitting .300 (15-for-50) between April 8 and 29 with a .453 on-base percentage ... he has also reached base in 17 games from May 21 to June 10, batting .258 (17-for-66) with a .354 OBP.
- He's reached base at least once in 44 of 50 games this season, and has reached base multiple times in 22 games, one of six Naturals to do so 20+ times.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks third in on-base percentage (.461) .... he places third among Double-A hitters in OBP, seventh in batting average (.331) and tied eighth in OPS (1.002) ... in the Texas League, he is third in OBP, sixth in batting average, fifth in OPS and 10th in slugging percentage (.541).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest batting average, on-base percentage and OPS and ranks second in slugging percentage, behind Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (.608).
- Porter has reached base in 36 of 39 games he's played this season, with hits in 27 of 39 and 15 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- In the month of June, Porter is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with three home runs and six runs batted in, along with a 1.323 OPS. His batting average this month ranks fifth in the Texas League, while his OPS ranks as the second-highest.
- In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.


**#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER**

- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.




**#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH**

- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
