HAPPY JULY: After winning back-to-back games to finish up June .500, the FredNats will try to start July on a positive note and win their third straight game against Salem tonight at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. RHP Brad Lord gets the start for the FredNats, who have won the last two games by two runs apiece. Lord has been solid since re-entering the starting rotation, allowing just four earned runs in his last 18 inning pitched. He faces off against Salem righty Jose Ramirez.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats jumped on Salem starter Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz for two runs in the first inning and never looked back on the way to a 4-2 win. Branden Boissiere had two RBI, Daylen Lile had two doubles and two runs scored, and Roismar Quintana hit his second homer of the year, a 418-foot shot to add some insurance. Jose Atencio pitched five scoreless innings to earn the win, and Pedro Gonzalez finished the game with four innings of two-run ball for his second save of the year, both against Salem.

RE-LILE-BLE: 2021 second round pick Daylen Lile has picked up his extra base hit production of late. 13 out of his last 18 hits are for extra bases - seven doubles, three triples and three homers. In the month of June, Lile slugged .589 and had an OPS of .924. He also drove in 16 runs in June, and leads the FredNats with 42 RBI overall, and he hit his first career leadoff home run last week in Columbia. He's top-5 in the league in batting average, RBI, OPS, extra-base hits, triples and total bases.

THE BOSS: Branden Boissiere has been a tough out for Salem so far in this series. In three games, Boissiere is 4-for-8 with two RBI, three walks and an OPS over 1.000. In the last two games, the only out that he's made was a sacrifice fly to drive in the game's first run last night. He will start at first base once again tonight for Fredericksburg.

TOLMAN THE SUN DEVIL: 2021 14th round draft pick Erik Tolman had a long road back to the mound before Thursday's start. He had Tommy John surgery after just three appearances his senior year at Arizona State, and then after 14 months of recovery, he re-injured his throwing elbow and needed Tommy John for a second time. He's finally back to the mound, and fired four shutout frames in his first start with the FredNats last night.

K-ROD: FredNat reliever Kevin Rodriguez has been one of the best relief pitchers in the Carolina League this year. He's allowed just two earned runs in the month of June, and just three earned runs since April 15. He's fourth in the Carolina League with 21 relief appearances, and he's done everything - long relief, closing games, piggybacking a starter.

WHAT THE BALK: Balks have been very prominent in the Carolina League this year. The FredNats have been called for 26, which is third-most in the league. Heading into play today, teams in the Carolina League have been called for 276 balks just over halfway through the season. By comparision, in the entire 2022 season, the teams in the league were called for 191 balks. There have been no actual rule changes to the balk rule, so it's unclear as to why so many more balks have been called this year.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Brad Lord comes to the FredNats as a 2022 draft choice of the Washington Nationals. He played a key role in the USF Bulls rotation over his three years in Tampa. Lord developed a reuptation as a postseason performer with the Bulls, earning an all-AAC Tournament Team honor in 2021.

WELL-TRAVELED: Lord has had to fight his way to the professional ranks, making stops at three schools before finally getting his name called in the 2022 draft. He began his collegiate days at Gulf Coast State College, a JuCo, before then landing at another Florida junior college, Santa Fe. Finally, Lord found a spot in the USF rotation for his final two years in school.

LAST TIME OUT: Lord turned in a gem of a performance on the road last week against the Columbia Fireflies. He twirled five innings of one run ball, scattering just three base hits and not walking or hitting a batter. Lord also struck out five Fireflies, his second highest total of the season.
