RIDERS FALL TO HOOKS ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks 12-4 from Whataburger Field on Friday night. Corpus Christi (19-30, 40-77) jumped on Frisco (23-26, 61-56) starter **Josh Stephan** (5-6) in the third for seven runs. Zach Cole started the scoring with a two-run triple and scored on an RBI groundout before John Garcia blasted a grand slam to cap the seven-run frame. That score remained until the Riders found the scoreboard in the top of the seventh. **Frainyer Chavez** laced an RBI single to right, **Luis Mieses** added a two-run single and **Keith Jones II** added an RBI knock to bring the deficit to 7-4. Corpus Christi then volleyed right back in the bottom of the seventh, scoring four runs on one hit, helped by five Frisco walks and one hit batter, boosting the lead to 11-4. In the bottom of the eighth, the Hooks scored another run off of Chavez, who pitched as a position player, capping the score at 12-4. Tyler Guilfoil (4-2) took home the victory for Corpus Christi, throwing 1.2 innings out of the bullpen.

CAULEY'S HISTORY NIGHT:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from Cam Cauley against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742.

WIN, WIN AND WIN SOME MORE:

The Riders have won eight of their last 11 games and 11 of their last 15 games. During their last 11 games, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 3.62 ERA as a staff allowing just three home runs. In the 14-game stretch, they are second in the league with a 3 22 FRA

THAT'S ZA-BALLGAME:

Aaron Zavala walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on Friday night for his first walk-off homer with the Riders and second walk-off hit. In a 14-game on-base streak, he is hitting .269 (14-for-52)/.339/.500/.839 with six doubles, two home runs, 12 RBIs, four walks, nine runs scored and two steals.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In 19 games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.78 ERA while they are 8-for-12 in save opportunities.

ROTATION ROTATING:
With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of Trey Supak and Ben Anderson and the trade of Mitch Bratt, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). In 19 August games, Frisco has a 3.26 ERA for starters which is second in the league. **Jose Corniell** (15.2 IP, 0 ER), **Leandro Lopez** (18.2 IP, 5 ER) and **David Davalillo** (43.0 IP, 11 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (71). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .985 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They snapped a string of 10-straight games without an error on Friday (they were 8-2 in those games), the longest such streak in the Texas League this season.

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 30 steals over 123 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
