### RIDERS FALL TO MIDLAND 5-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the third game of the six-game series to the Midland RockHounds 5-3 on Thursday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. The RockHounds (35-25) dealt the first run against Frisco (33-26) starter **Josh Stephan** in the bottom of the fourth inning on a Luke Mann RBI single to make it 1-0. Stephan ended up going seven innings, allowing three runs while striking out five and walking one. After Midland starter Gage Jump sat down the first 13 batters he faced, **Aaron Zavala** tripled and **Josh Hatcher** plated him with an RBI single in the fifth to tie the game at 1-1. Midland then took the lead in the bottom of the fifth with an RBI triple from Colby Halter and an RBI single by Euribiel Angeles, taking a 3-1 advantage. The Riders volleyed right back in the top of the sixth when **Cam Cauley** hammered a two-run double down the left field line, scoring **Luis Mieses** and **Abimelec Ortiz**, to tie the score at 3-3. That held until the bottom of the eighth inning when Mann launched a solo homer against **Larson Kindreich** (2-2) before Clark Elliott added a run with an RBI single to make it 5-3. Steven Emanuels (6-1) threw two scoreless innings in relief to earn the win for Midland.

### POWER OUTAGE:

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have gone three-straight games without a home run. This is the first time they have gone three-straight games without a home run since May 20th-22nd against Midland.

### HIGH-LEVEL MATCHUP:

Over the last two seasons, the RockHounds (119) and RoughRiders (117) are the two winningest teams in the Texas League. The RockHounds have won more games than any other Double-A team while the RoughRiders are tied for the second-most wins. Midland's 3.17 ERA as a team over the last two seasons is first in the Texas League and third in Double-A. Since 2021, the RoughRiders are second in the Texas League in wins (319) while Midland is third (314).

### MONTHLY HONORS:

On Monday, the Texas Rangers announced that Frisco RoughRiders LHP **Mitch Bratt** earned Starting Pitcher of the Month and infielder/outfielder **Cam Cauley** secured Defender of the Month in the Rangers farm system for the month of May. Bratt went 3-0 with a Texas League-best 1.33 ERA across five starts in May. His 10.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball (min. 5 starts) during the month. Bratt's May was highlighted by a career-high 10 strikeouts across six shutout innings at San Antonio on May 10th. Cauley posted a .975 fielding percentage in 26 games during May, committing two errors on 81 total chances. The versatile Houston native played 10 games at second base, nine in center field and seven at second base. Playing in the outfield for the first time professionally, Cauley recorded his first two career outfield assists in May.

### CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Over his last 29 games, **Cam Cauley** has hit .301 (31-for-103)/.362/.505/.867 with nine doubles, three home runs and 20 runs scored. Over his last 13 games, he is batting .348 (16-for-46)/.426/.500/.926 with eight runs scored. He is tied for fourth in the league with 17 stolen bases.

### SLOW START:

Over their last nine games, in which the Riders are just 2-7, Frisco's starting pitching has struggled. Riders starters have gone 1-3 with a 6.17 ERA (last in the Texas League) while allowing a .312 batting average. Overall in the last nine games, the Riders are last in the league with a 5.35 ERA. On the season, RoughRiders starters own a 4.45 ERA, which is 7th in the Texas League.

### SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** leads the team saves (five) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fifth in the Texas League.

### OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 25 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .265/.360/.531/.891 with eight doubles, 16 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 14 walks to 17 strikeouts. Two Fridays ago, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). This season, his walk rate of 12.6 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.2 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits also pace the league. While on a 13-game on-base streak, he is hitting .298 (14-for-47)/.424/.511/.935.

### DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

**Aaron Zavala** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .304 (42-for-138)/.419/.507/.926 over his last 39 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (40) and is third in OBP (.411) while leading the league in walk rate (19.1 percent). In his last 16 games, he is hitting .311 (19-for-61)/.382/.525/.907 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs.

### ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

### 2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

-Finished May with a 3-0 record and 1.37 ERA over 5G/4GS, 26.1 IP, 21 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 12 BB, 11 K. His 1.37 ERA was second among Texas League starters with at least four games started.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

### 2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

### 2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

### 2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

### 2019 SEASON

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
