SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 8-7, to take the series finale. Richmond won five-of-six in the series. Bowie opened the scoring with an RBI double by John Rhodes in the second, the only run allowed by **Ryan Murphy** in his four-inning start. In the third, **Will Wilson** reached on an error to score the tying run and **Blake Sabol** added a sac fly to give the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead. Bowie pulled ahead, 5-2, in the fifth with a solo homer by Anthony Servideo and a three-run homer by Silas Ardoin. In the sixth, **Victor Bericoto** brought the Flying Squirrels back within two runs with a sac fly. Richmond tied the score, 5-5, in the seventh inning. **Andy Thomas** scored on a wild pitch and Wilson brought in a run with a sac bunt. **Jimmy Glownke** gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with a two-run homer and **Luis Toribio** added a sac fly to pull ahead, 8-5. Servideo brought in a run with a single and Samuel Basallo hit an RBI single to pull the Baysox within a run at 8-7. **Evan Gates** pitched a scoreless ninth inning to close out his second save of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the opener of a six-game series at The Diamond. The week marks Erie's only visit to Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels were swept in six games at UPMC Park from May 7-12. Richmond returns to Erie for a six-game series from August 27-September 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 10-2 in their last 12 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won five-of-six in each of their last two series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie last week.

THE SEAWOLVES are in third place in the Southwest Division, two games behind first-place Akron. Last week, the SeaWolves won two-of-six against Altoona at home, dropping the middle four games. This season, Erie has the second-lowest team ERA (3.08) in the Eastern League. Erie's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 13) and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes two Erie players, including Melton (No. 10) and Lee (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his ninth start of the season and his second against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Wednesday at Bowie and allowed two runs over five innings with seven strikeouts. He last faced the SeaWolves on May 9 in Erie and allowed one over five innings with six strikeouts in a no-decision. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 35 IP) this season, Birdsong ranks first in BAA (.161), third in K/9 (11.97), fourth in strikeout percentage (32.4%), fourth in LOB% (87.6%) and eighth in WHIP (1.08). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. **For more on Birdsong, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Garrett Burhenn makes his third Double-A start. He began the season with High-A West Michigan and went 0-3 with a 2.89 ERA in seven starts. Burhenn was promoted to Double-A Erie on May 14. In his Double-A debut on May 16 at Harrisburg, he surrendered one run over five innings to pick up a win. He last pitched on Wednesday against Altoona and threw five scoreless innings, allowing four hits. Burhenn was selected by the Tigers in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (8,009).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last 12 games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .261 (101-for-387), second-best in the league, and have scored 76 runs, an average of 6.3 runs per game. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). In winning 10-of-thirteen last-12, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 76-41.

SETTING THE TABLE: **Carter Howell** is batting .313 (21-for-67) over his last 18 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, 12 walks and 10 runs scored. On May 16 in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin' Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his 13 games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .314 (16-for-51) with two doubles and eight walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .400 (14-for-35). On Friday, Howell scored a career-high four runs.

GRANTING WISHES: In his last 11 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .486 (17-for-35) with two homers, six doubles, two triples, eight walks, nine RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .223. He picked up a season-high three hits on Tuesday night at Bowie and matched it on Friday night. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .486 (17-for-35) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. McCray is fifth in the Eastern League in extra-base hits (9), tied for sixth in doubles (11) and tied for ninth in runs scored (27). On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the series in Bowie.

AWARDS SEASON: Along with **Grant McCray** being named Eastern League Player of the Week, **John Michael Bertrand** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He pitched six hitless innings on Thursday night at Bowie. He also threw seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and has combined for 13 hitless innings when facing Bowie this season. Bertrand became the second pitcher in team history to win two Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, joining **Eric Surkamp** (2011). Along with Surkamp, Bertrand is the fourth pitcher in team history to win the Pitcher of the Week award multiple times, joining **Matt Frisbee** and **Matt Gage**. Last week marked the fourth time the Flying Squirrels have swept the league's weekly player and pitcher awards, joining **Daniel Mayora** and **Justin Fitzgerald** (July 9-16, 2012), **Steven Duggar** and **Andrew Suarez** (July 18-24, 2016) and **Brett Auerbach** and **Wil Jensen** (August 1-7, 2022).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .324 (12-for-37) over his last 10 games since May 15 with a homer, three doubles and 11 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .232. Thomas has picked up two hits in four-of-his-last-eight games played dating back to May 16 and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch. On Friday, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high.

WILL POWER: **Will Wilson** reached base 10 times in five games in last week's series. On Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance on Wednesday and added a solo home run. On Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. He picked up three hits and a walk on Friday night. In last week's series, Wilson hit .333 (6-for-18). Wilson is now ranked seventh in Flying Squirrels franchise history with 26 career homers.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants

prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

IN OTHER WORDS...

Will Wilson on the team's recent offensive turnaround:
