## INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Minor League Baseball's No. 3 prospect Paul Skenes matched his career-high in strikeouts as the Indianapolis Indians defeated the St. Paul Saints in a nailbiter on Thursday evening at Victory Field, 6-5. The Indians jumped out to an early lead to back Skenes in the first inning and never trailed, scoring four runs before the Saints could get on the board. Leading off the game for Indy, Nick Gonzales drew a five-pitch walk and was driven in when DaShawn Keirseay Jr. robbed Jake Lamb of extra bases with a leaping catch against the center field wall. The offense picked up again in the fourth with back-to-back doubles by Liover Peguero and Malcom Nuñez. One frame later, a run-scoring groundout by Yasmani Grandal and RBI single by Lamb plated an additional pair, extending the lead to 4-0. St. Paul broke up a one-hit shutout bid by Indians pitching in the seventh with an RBI bases-loaded infield single to Matt Wallner. J.C. Flowers then entered the game with two outs and struck out Yunior Severino swinging as the go-ahead run at home plate. The Indians offense wasn't done in the eighth inning, with Nuñez and Celestino each driving in insurance runs that would prove useful come the ninth. With Brent Honeywell on the mound and the bases loaded, the first out of the frame was recorded on a sacrifice fly. Wallner then stepped to the plate and continued to do damage, launching a three-run homer to tighten the score to 6-5. Honeywell closed the game by freezing Tony Kemp on a called third strike.

**STRIKEOUT COUNTER SKYROCKETING:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) punched out eight batters across 3.1 innings for the second consecutive start on Thursday vs. St. Paul. With two outs and the go-ahead run at home plate in the seventh inning, Flowers entered in relief of Connor Sadzeck and got Yunior Severino to chase an inning-ending 88.0 mph change up. He then returned for the eighth and worked around a leadoff hit-by-pitch with a swinging strikeout of Patrick Winkel and double play taken by shortstop Liover Peguero. After allowing runs in each of his first four appearances (one start), Flowers has logged back-to-back scoreless appearances (2.1ip) with three strikeouts vs. St. Paul this week.

**J.C. ANSWERS THE CALL:** J.C. Flowers earned his second win of the 2024 season last night with a masterful performance to fend off a comeback attempt by St. Paul. With two outs and the go-ahead run at home plate in the seventh inning, Flowers entered in relief of Connor Sadzeck and got Yunior Severino to chase an inning-ending 88.0 mph change up. He then returned for the eighth and worked around a leadoff hit-by-pitch with a swinging strikeout of Patrick Winkel and double play taken by shortstop Liover Peguero. After allowing runs in each of his first four appearances (one start), Flowers has logged back-to-back scoreless appearances (2.1ip) with three strikeouts vs. St. Paul this week.

**GONZO STREAKING:** Nick Gonzales walked and singled last night to extend his league-leading on-base streak to a career-high 17 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 17-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona. His fifth-inning single also extended his hitting streak to 10 games dating back to 4/6. Gonzales, who hit for the cycle at Victory Field on Sept. 19, 2023, vs. Rochester, also went 4-for-5 on Tuesday night and was a home run shy of becoming just the first batter in franchise history to accomplish the feat twice. Eight of his 16 games have featured multi-hit performances, and he currently leads IL leaders in hits (27) and doubles (10) while also ranking in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 12), batting average (3rd, .386), runs (T-2nd, 18), total bases (5th, 42) and OPS (1.034).

**LAMB CHOPS:** Jake Lamb joins Nick Gonzales on the International League leaderboards this season, ranking among qualifiers in batting average (7th, .366) and on-base percentage (8th, .471) through 13 games this season. Last night, he drove in Gonzales with a long fly ball in the bottom of the first, with a leaping catch against the center field wall by DaShawn Keirseay Jr. robbing him of extra-base hits. Lamb had his 11-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday after being reinstated from the temporary inactive list, but went 2-for-2 with a run, two RBI and walk last night to pick up where he left off.

**NUÑEZ KNOWS:** Malcom Nuñez has been a consistent presence for the Indians offense as of late, hitting safely in each of his last four games with four extra-base hits. Last night, he led the Indians offense by going 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI. In April, he has reached base safely in 11 of 13 games with a .326 batting average (14-for-43), five doubles, two homers and 10 RBI.

**NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES:** The Indians are currently tied with Omaha with 44 doubles, the most among all 30 Triple-A teams. Nick Gonzales, who has two more doubles than anyone else in the IL, is currently leading the pack. The Indians as a team are also hitting .280 (165-for-589), good for the second-best batting average in all of Triple-A behind Durham (.294, 180-for-613).

**TONIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians will look to win their fourth-straight game and clinch a victory in the six-game series vs. the St. Paul Saints this week. It is their first of three of three head-to-head series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. Taking the mound for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Wily Peralta (1-0, 8.64), who has appeared out of the bullpen five times for Indy this season. Peralta has faced St. Paul once in his career, taking the loss with three runs in 4.2 innings on 4/27/23 with Rochester. Countering is Minnesota's No. 24 prospect RHP Simeon Woods Richardson (0-1, 7.56), who has gone 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (7er/9.1ip) in two career starts at Victory Field.

**THIS DATE IN 2004:** The Indians walked off Richmond with a 7-6 win at Victory Field thanks to a broken-bat single to left field by shortstop J.J. Hardy in the bottom of the ninth. Hardy drove in five runs, the other four coming on a grand slam in the fifth inning that turned a 3-0 deficit into an Indians lead. First baseman Jeff Lierfe also clubbed a pair of solo home runs, the second tying the game at 6-6 in the eighth.
