**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones came up short on Saturday afternoon despite a strong comeback attempt, falling 8-5...Brooklyn rattled off 5 runs over the final 2 frames after trailing 8-0, and brought the tying run to the plate in the 9th...**C Ronald Hernández** pushed his hitting streak to 7 games in the defeat...**LHP Jonathan Santucci** took the loss, tossing 4.1 innings of 3-run ball (2 earned), while Wilmington's LHP **Alex Clemmey** picked up the win with 5.1 innings of scoreless, 1-hit ball...Wilmington utilized a 5-run top half of the 7th inning, which included a 3-run home run from DH **Brandon Boissiere**.

**ROARIN' RONALD:** Brooklyn C/1B **Ronald Hernández** has been an integral piece of the puzzle for the Cyclones all season...The switch-hitter enters Sunday on a 7-game hitting streak, during which he is batting .500 (13-for-26) with multi-hit efforts in four games during the streak...During that span, Hernández has compiled 8 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI...He has also raised his batting average by 148 points from .125 to .273...The 21-year-old has also made it a point to be more aggressive on the bases - Hernandez has already notched a career-high-tying 8 stolen bases across his first 19 games...Hernandez logged 8 steals all of last year across 108 games

**NUNEZ IS NAILS:** RHP **Anthony Nunez** collected a 5-out save on Friday to continue his marvelous start to the new year...The righty has yet to allow an earned run through his first 8 appearances of the season...The University of Tampa product did not surrender a mere base hit until his 7th appearance of the year...Among players in the South Atlantic with at least 12.0 IP, Nunez is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00)...He is 1 of 3 players to not allow an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg** & Hub City's LHP **Larson Kindreich**)...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP leads the league amongst those with 12.0 IP, and is tops in all of High-A...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP is also the 2nd-lowest in Minor League Baseball among arms with 12.0 or more innings...Only Boston's High-A Greenville's LHP **Brandon Clarke** (0.35) has a lower mark...Nunez's .029 batting average against (1-35) is the lowest mark in MiLB.

**BLAZIN' HOT BENGE:** Cyclones OF **Carson Benge** is one of the hottest hitters in the league entering play on Sunday...Even with his 7-game hitting streak coming to an end on Friday, Benge is still 14-for-his-last-37 (.378) with 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 runs scored, 5 batted in, and 7 walks...Benge picked up at least 2 hits in 5-straight games spanning from April 25 until May 1, including an outstanding 4-for-5 performance on Tuesday that saw him score twice and drive in a pair...Since April 13, Benge is tied for 4th in the league in hits with 20.

**LUCKY NUMBER... 15?:** For the 2nd time in April alone, the Cyclones put up a 15-spot in a 15-1 win over Wilmington on Wednesday afternoon...Sure enough, the 1st time Brooklyn accomplished the feat this season also came against the Blue Rocks - also in the 2nd game of that particular series...The 'Clones bashed 5 home runs in their take down of the Nationals affiliate on Wednesday, good for the most in a game this season...The 15-1 win on April 5th came thanks to a bit of a different brand of ball - Brooklyn did not hit a single home run that day...Brooklyn had not scored 15 runs in a single game at Maimonides Park since 2010

**BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS:** After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni will have already accomplished the feat in 2025 by the end of the day...OF **Rhylan Thomas** (2023) had his contract selected by the Seattle Mariners from Triple-A Tacoma on Wednesday and went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night at Texas...Additionally, RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2023) will make his MLB debut for New York this afternoon at St. Louis in Game 1 of a doubleheader...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

**REIM TIME:** INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer became the 1st player in 20 years to record a 3-home run game for the Cyclones...He is 1 of only 3 players in the history of the franchise to do so, joining **Caleb Stewart** on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley and **Neel Devarez** on July 1, 2001, vs. New Jersey...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 9th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in doubles (9), is tied for the league lead in triples (3), and is tied for 4th in home runs (5)...Reimer also leads the league in OPS (1.018), extra-base hits (17), total bases (61), slugging (.629), and hits (31), tied for 3rd in RBI (22) and 3rd in runs scored (21).

**DIALED IN DÍAZ:** RHP **Joel Díaz** has been outstanding to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old's scoreless inning streak to start the year came to an end at 171 IP after allowing a run against Wilmington on April 30...The righty sports a 0.44 ERA, which is tops in the SAL among active players entering play on Sunday...His 0.68 WHIP also leads the league, while boasting a 24:2 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The San Cristóbal, D.R. native is also 4th in batting average against (.164)

**RUNNIN' WILD:** The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on Tuesday saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C **Chris Suero** and DH **Jesús Báez** each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK:** Brooklyn made a plethora of roster moves on Monday...The Cyclones added INF **AJ Ewing**, RHP **Chandler Marsh**, and INF **Marco Vargas** from Single-A St. Lucie...In corresponding moves, RHP **Ryan Lambert** and LHP **Zach Thornton** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while INF **Nick Roselli** was transferred to St. Lucie...RHP **Eduardo Herrera** was reinstated from the Development List, and RHP **Layonel Ovalles** was placed on the Development List...Ewing was hitting .400/.506/.615/1121 in 18 games with the Mets, adding a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 stolen bases...The 20-year-old led the Florida State League in steals (14), batting average (.400), on-base percentage (.506), OPS (1.121), and hits (26)...Ewing is also tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4), 11th in batting average (.386), 13th in OPS (1.074), tied for 5th in stolen bases (15), and top 20 in on-base percentage (.486)...Marsh held a 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 10.2 IP), and 1 save, allowing only 2 hits and 1 walk with 14 strikeouts over 8 appearances...Among FSL pitchers with 10.0 or more innings of work, the 22-year-old was 5th in the circuit in strikeout rate (41.2%) and 7th in walk rate (2.9%)...Vargas slashed .409/.527/.545/1072 in 13 games with St. Lucie, collecting a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 steals...Before joining Binghamton, Lambert did not receive a decision and held a 113 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP), allowing 3 hits, walking 1, and striking out 17 in 7 appearances...Thornton was dominant for Brooklyn, hoisting a 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...The southpaw leaves the South Atlantic League with a league-best ERA (0.44), tied for the league lead in wins (3), 2nd in WHIP (0.68), 6th in batting average against (.162), and tied for 7th in innings pitched (20.2) and strikeouts (25)...Thornton was 6th in the minors in ERA (0.44) and 9th in WHIP (0.68)...Roselli hit .133/.220/.222/.422 with 7 runs batted in over 13 games for Brooklyn.

**HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY:** INF **Estarling Mercado** has been red hot with the bat to start 2025...The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season last Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Sunday, Mercado is hitting .360 (18-50) with 7 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 10 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 10 of 12 games, posting a .385 average (15-39) with 5 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 9 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 60 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks 2nd in batting average (.360), 6th in OPS (.970), 8th in slugging percentage (.520), and 7th in on-base percentage (.450).

**HALL OF A START:** After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 5 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER in 23.2 IP), 29 strikeouts and only 18 hits allowed...Entering Sunday, Hall is tied for 14th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.28)...The Univer-

**vs. WILMINGTON:** After a two-week road trip, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking 4-of-6 at home against Aberdeen...The Cyclones swept the initial series with the 'Rocks taking all 3 games from April 4-6 on Coney Island...Wilmington is 2-12 on the road this season...The Blue Rocks boast 7 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects: INF **Seaver King** (4), LHP **Alex Clemmey** (5), C **Caleb Lomavita** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (17), LHP **Jackson Kent** (20), OF **Elijah Green** (24), and OF **Brenner Cox** (30)...Bennett is currently on the injured list...In 115 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 63-52 (.548)...Brooklyn is 37-22 in 59 home games against Wilmington (.627).

sity of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

**START ME UP:** Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 23 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 3.02 ERA (34 ER in 101.1 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 124-to-31 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 3.02 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (3.23)...It is also 3rd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (1.96) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 3.26 ERA (79 ER in 218.0 IP), which is good for the 5th-lowest at High-A and 3rd-lowest in the SAL...The 3.26 ERA ranks 11th in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.38) holds the top spot.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Sunday, Cyclones relievers have a 10-3 record with a 3.47 ERA (45 ER in 116.2 IP), 5 saves, 60 walks, and an eye-popping 162 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 111 WHIP from relief arms is 2nd at the High-A level and 5th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Erie is 1st (0.97)...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a .173 batting average against, which is the 3rd-lowest mark in MiLB...Miami's Double-A Pensacola (156) is 1st.

**SUPER SUERO:** C **Chris Suero** has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Sunday, Suero is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (5), 6th in slugging percentage (.552), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (11), 6th in OPS (.945), tied for 8th in RBI (17), tied for 9th in doubles (6), and tied for 8th in total bases (37).

**ELI'S ELITE NIGHT:** OF **Eli Serrano III** put together his best game as a professional in Thursday night's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano is the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B **Luke Ritter** also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Sunday, Serrano is tied for 7th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (10), tied for 8th in total bases (37), and tied for 10th in walks (17).

**BORN TO RUNS:** The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win v. Wilmington on Wednesday...It marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24th's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY:** On May 4, 2021, the Cyclones played their 1st full-season game at High-A, taking on Asheville at historic McCormick Field in North Carolina...That year's Brooklyn squad had INFs **Ronny Mauricio** and **Brett Baty**, who at the time, were the No. 2 & 3 prospects in the organization respectively...Brooklyn won their initial full-season contest, 8-2...C **Hayden Senger** clubbed a solo home run in the 2nd inning...He, Mauricio, Baty, and CF **Scott Ota** picked up multi-hit games in the win...LHP **Josh Walker** earned the win with 5.0 innings of shutout and hitless ball, striking out 8.

**REMEMBER ME?:** Brooklyn's roster features a former Wilmington Blue Rock entering this week's 6-game set...C **Onix Vega**, who is currently on the Cyclones' Development List, spent parts of 3 seasons with the Blue Rocks from 2022 until 2024...In 91 games with Wilmington, the 26-year-old hit .251/.364/.360/.724 with 42 runs scored, 21 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 39 RBI.

Ewing** (27)...Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision on Tuesday night vs. Wilmington...Allowed a season-high 4 runs (3 earned) on 5 hits in a career-high-tying 5.0 innings...Plunked a batter and walked 1, striking out 7...Yielded a 2-run home run to SS **Seaver King** in the top of the 3rd...Charged with a balk and induced a double play...Threw 77 pitches and 52 strikes (67.53%)...Allowed the leadoff batter to reach in 4 of 5 frames...Relieved by RHP **Anthony Nunez** to start the top of the 6th inning with Brooklyn leading 5-4...Wilmington rallied to take a 6-5 advantage before a DH **Jesús Báez** RBI single tied the game in the 8th...SS **Marco Vargas** provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in the Cyclones' 7-6 victory.

**NOAH'S ARC:** After an injury-shortened 2024, Hall has returned to form in 2025...Entering play on Sunday, the 24-year-old is tied for 14th among qualifiers in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.28)...Additionally, Hall has done a great job forcing ground balls, ranking tied for 4th in double plays induced (4)...The Charlotte, N.C. native also leads the SAL in infield flyball rate (53.8%) and sits 2nd in groundball rate (55.4%)...Hall's 29.6% strikeout rate is also 11th-best in the circuit.

**HALL PASS:** Hall started on Opening Day for the Cyclones for the second-straight year on April 4 vs. Wilmington...The 24-year-old was Brooklyn's starter on Opening Day in 2024, taking the loss on April 5, 2024, at Wilmington...Hall is the only pitcher in Cyclones history to start on back-to-back Opening Days and the only arm in franchise history to start the first game of the season multiple times.

**2025:** Earned the 1st victory of his professional career in his 2nd-straight Opening Day start, tossing a career-high-tying 5.0 innings of 1-run ball on 4/5 vs. WIL (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 3 K)...Punched out a career-high 8 in a no-decision on 4/10 vs. HV (4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 8 K)...Struck out 7, but suffered the defeat on 4/16 @ABD (5.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...Allowed 1 earned run or fewer in each of his 1st 4 starts (1.45 ERA).

**2024:** Spent most of the campaign with Brooklyn...Made his professional debut as the Cyclones' 2024 Opening Day starter on 4/5 at Wilmington...Suffered the loss, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits in 3.2 innings...Walked 3 and struck out 3...Best start of the season came on 4/18 at Jersey Shore...Allowed only 1 run on 4 hits in a career-high 5.0 innings...Walked 2 and punched out 3 in a no-decision...Placed on Brooklyn's 7-day injured list (shoulder) on 4/26...Transferred to 60-day IL on 5/12...Joined Single-A St. Lucie for a rehab assignment on 9/7...Combined to tally a 0-2 record with a 9.65 ERA (14 ER in 13.0 IP), 10 walks, and 12 strikeouts in 5 starts.
