YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels swept a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils. They won the first game, 9-1, behind a six-run second inning. Richmond scored the first run on a balk before Grant McCray hit an RBI double and Damon Dues singled in two runs. Carter Howell followed with a two-run double to open a 6-0 lead. Reading scored a run on an error in the top of the third inning, but Andy Thomas brought in a run with a groundout in the bottom of the frame. In the bottom of the sixth, Jairo Pomares hit a two-run homer, his second of the season, to extend the lead to 9-1. Hayden Birdsong tied his career-high with five innings pitched and allowed one unearned run with five strikeouts to pick up his second win this season. Eric Silva closed the game with two scoreless innings. In the second game of the doubleheader, the Flying Squirrels won, 3-1. Reading took a 1-0 lead in the second inning with an RBI single by Caleb Ricketts. In the bottom of the inning, Adrian Sugastey tied the game with an RBI single. Howell broke the tie with a go-ahead, two-run homer in the bottom of the fifth inning. Jose Cruz struck out four over two scoreless innings. Tanner Kiest picked up his second win of the season after throwing 1.2 scoreless innings. Nick Garcia closed out the save, picking up the final four outs and stranding five runners on base in the final two innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, in the fourth of a six-game series. This week marks the only series between the two team this season. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-1 against the Fightin Phils, their best record against Reading in franchise history. Richmond swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season and won five-of-six at Reading in June and July.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won three straight games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning on Wednesday night. In their last series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** are in fifth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. They won five-of-six in last week's series in Reading against Hartford, outscoring the Yard Goats 34-23 for the series. Reading's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including OF Gabriel Rincones (No. 10), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 16), RHP Christian McGowan (No. 17), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20) and RHP Tommy McCollum (No. 29). There are six Reading players on MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list, including Rincones (No. 10), De La Cruz (No. 13), McGowan (No. 16), Ricketts (No. 21), INF Robert Moore (No. 26), INF Jose Rodriguez (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his seventh start of the season and eighth appearance. He last pitched on Friday at Erie and allowed a season-high five runs over 4.2 innings in a loss, raising his ERA from 1.71 to 2.72. That outing snapped a scoreless streak spanning 17.1 innings of work. Bertrand worked seven perfect innings on April 27 against the Baysox en route to being named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week and followed with five scoreless innings in his next start on May 3 at Akron. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

**KEEP IT MOVING:** In **John Michael Bertrand's** last five starts since April 16, the Flying Squirrels have played games averaging two hours and 15 minutes, which is 24 minutes faster than the average MiLB game time in 2024.

FOR READING: Right-hander Matt Osterberg makes his seventh start of the season. He last pitched last Thursday against the Yard Goats in Reading and allowed three runs over five innings in no-decision. Osterberg went 0-1 with a 1.98 ERA (3 ER/13.2 IP) in his first three starts of the year before going 0-2 with a 13.14 ERA (18 ER/12.1 IP) over his last three starts since April 26. Osterberg was selected in the 15th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Phillies out of St. Cloud State. He first reached Double-A with Reading in 2022 and made one relief appearance. He started last season with High-A Jersey Shore and went 8-5 with a 3.61 ERA in 18 starts before being promoted to Double-A in mid-August. In his six starts with the Figthin Phils to close the year, Osterberg went 1-1 with a 3.26 ERA. In his final start of the year on September 14 at Binghamton, he threw seven scoreless innings and allowed two hits to earn the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award. Following the season, he was named an Mil.B.com Phillies Organization All-Star.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,860).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last three games, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .282 (24-for-85) and have scored 18 runs, an average of 6.0 runs per game. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win on Wednesday night. They outscored the Fightin Phils, 12-2, in Thursday night's doubleheader sweep.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are four relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 15 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top-12 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (4th - 0.95 ERA - 2 ER/19.0 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (9th - 1.59 ERA - 3 ER/17.0 IP), **Nick Garcia** (1th - 1.65 ERA - 3 ER/16.1 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (12th - 1.96 ERA - 5 ER/23.0 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (23.0).

**GLOW SHOW:** In his last seven games dating back to May 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .304 (7-for-23) with three doubles, two walks and four runs scored. In those seven games, he has three two-hit games, including Wednesday night against the Fightin Phils and Game 1 of Thursday's doubleheader. This year, he has picked up two-or-more hits in five-of-17 games played, including a four-hit game on April 6 at Somerset. This month, Glowenke has raised his batting average from .225 to .254.

**SETTING THE TABLE:** Carter Howell is batting .297 (11-for-37) over his last 11 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, seven walks and two runs scored. On Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his six games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .286 (6-for-21) with two doubles and three walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .360 (9-for-25).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Hayden Birdsong** is ranked second in BAA (160), fifth in ERA (2.08) and seventh in strikeouts (40). **Carson Ragsdale** is 10th in strikeouts (37). **Ryan Murphy** is ranked first in games started (8).

MOVIN' UP: On Tuesday, Reggie Crawford and Hunter Bishop were promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. In his nine outings with Richmond, Crawford struck out 19 batters over 9.2 innings of work and posted a 4.66 ERA. Bishop played 26 games for the Flying Squirrels. He ranked second on the team in batting average (.242), tied for second in homers (2), second in OBP (.314), second in SLG (.358), second in OPS (.672), tied for second in doubles (5). He also led the team in total bases (34) and stolen bases (5) and ranked tied for first in hits (23).

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
