RIDERS REGAIN FIRST PLACE WITH THRILLING WIN IN MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders came from behind late to topple the Midland RockHounds 2-1 on Saturday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (35-26) fell behind early when RockHounds (35-27) third baseman Colby Halter knocked in the first run on a safety squeeze play in the first inning against Mitch Bratt. Bratt was strong, allowing just the one run over six innings while striking out five and walking one. From there, pitching took over with Midland's Yunior Tur throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit baseball in his first career Double-A start. The no-hitter continued into the top of the eighth inning when Jax Biggers walked and Frainyer Chavez singled to left for the first Riders' hit. After a Marcus Smith sacrifice bunt, Tucker Mitchell bounded a go-ahead, two-run double down the left field line to give the Riders a 2-1 lead against Diego Berrera (0-1). Aidan Anderson (1-0) followed by tossing two scoreless innings to secure the victory and Skylar Hales then threw a perfect ninth inning for the save, his third of the season.

CHASE FOR THE TITLE:

The RoughRiders are back in first place after their win on Saturday against Midland with seven games remaining in the first half. They now have a 0.5-game lead on the RockHounds and a 1.5-game lead on San Antonio. With the seven games left, their magic number is seven. If they win the first half title, their seventh time in franchise history that they clinched a playoff spot in the first half and their second-straight season doing so.

#### POWER OUTAGE:

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have gone five-straight games without a home run. Frisco has hit just one home run in their last six games while averaging 3.0 runs per game and slashing .182/.265/.262/.527. On the positive side, Frisco leads the Texas League with 10 doubles over their last six games. They are 3-3 in those games because of a 3.91 ERA on the pitching

#### **HIGH-LEVEL MATCHUP**:

Over the last two seasons, the RockHounds (119) and RoughRiders (119) are the two winningest teams in the Texas League (tied with Arkansas). The RockHounds have won more games than any other Double-A team while the RoughRiders are tied for the second-most wins. Midland's 3.17 ERA as a team over the last two seasons is first in the Texas League and third in Double-A. Since 2021, the RoughRiders are tied with the Arkansas Travelers for the most in the Texas League in wins (321) while Midland is third (314).

#### MONTHLY HONORS:

On Monday, the Texas Rangers announced that Frisco RoughRiders LHP **Mitch Bratt** earned Starting Pitcher of the Month and in-fielder/outfielder **Cam Cauley** secured Defender of the Month in the Rangers farm system for the month of May. Bratt went 3-0 with a Texas League-best 1.33 ERA across five starts in May. His 10.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball (min. 5 starts) during the month. Bratt's May was highlighted by a career-high 10 strikeouts across six shutout innings at San Antonio on May 10th. Cauley posted a .975 fielding percentage in 26 games during May, committing two errors on 81 total chances. The versatile Houston native played 10 games at second base, nine in center field and seven at second base. Playing in the outfield for the first time professionally, Cauley recorded his first two career outfield assists in May.

CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:
Over his last 31 games, Cam Cauley has hit .297 (33-for-111)/.360/.486/.846 with 10 doubles, three home runs and 20 runs scored.
Over his last 13 games, he is batting .348 (16-for-46)/.436/.478/.914 with seven runs scored. He is fifth in the league with 17 stolen bases, but has just one stolen base in his last 10 games.

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (five) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fifth in the Texas League. Their 21 saves are tied for the most in the Texas League with San Antonio.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 27 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .267/.358/.514/.872 with eight doubles, 17 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 15 walks to 17 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.6 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 19.5 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits also pace the league. His 16 doubles through 61 games are tied for the fifth most by a Double-A teenager since 2005, trailing just Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (18), Fernando Martinez (18), Fernando Tatis Jr. (17) and Oscar Taveras (17).

#### **DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:**

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .297 (43-for-145)./415/.490/.905 over his last 41 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (42) and is third in OBP (.408) while leading the league in walk rate (19.3 percent). In his last 18 games, he is hitting .294 (20-for-68)/.377/.485/.862 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 198 walks over four seasons (294 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just eight walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by Guilder Rodriguez with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games)

#### **ABOUT TREY**

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

#### **2025 SEASON**

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen  $(3.1~I\!P, 5~H, 4~R, 2~E\!R, 3~B\!B, 3~K\!N)$ , allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

#### 2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

#### **2020 SEASON**

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

#### **2019 SEASON**

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.8 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

#### **2014-2018 SEASON**

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
