**Last Time Out:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies chipped away but fell short to the Portland Sea Dogs 7-5 on Friday night at Mirabito Stadium. The Sea Dogs put up a four-spot against Dom Hamel in the first inning. Binghamton chipped away with Joe Suozzi hitting a home run and RBI single, and Brandon McIlwain homering. Wyatt Young hit an RBI double and Hayden Senger hit into an RBI fielder's choice.

**Surging Suozzi: Joe Suozzi** crushed his second home run in as many days on Friday, marking the first two homers of his Double-A career. In 17 games with Binghamton, Suozzi is batting .339 (19-for-56) with an .933 OPS. He has two doubles, one triple, and two home runs with nine runs scored with the Ponies. He drove in two runs in last night's game with a solo homer and RBI single. The Long Island native grew up a Mets fan.

**Brandon Belts:** Outfielder **Brandon Mcllwain** has also homered in back-to-back days, in game one of the doubleheader Thursday and once on Friday. Mcllwain now has six homers this season and is tied with Jose Peroza for the team lead with 33 runs batted in. In the past three games, Mcllwain has five hits, two homers, one double, three runs batted in, and four runs scored.

**Peroza Party:** Infielder **Jose Peroza** is currently on an eight-game hitting streak, which is his longest of the season. The 23-year-old is batting .302 with a .945 OPS on the season. He leads the team with 15 doubles, and is tied for the team lead with nine home runs and 33 runs batted in. Peroza ranks top five in the Eastern League in: 4th in SLG (.558), T-4th in XBH (25), and T-5th in 2B (15).

**The Binghamton Stakes:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies as a team have hit the second-most home runs in the Eastern League in the month of June with 26. Binghamton ranks second in SLG (.485) and OPS (.838) this month as a team. The Ponies are in the top half of the league, batting .262 as a team this month. Binghamton is also fifth in the league with 59 walks this month.

**Upcoming Schedule:** Tonight's game closes out Southern Tier Shortcakes weekend with the first 1,000 fans receiving a R.E.D Shortcakes themed T-Shirt. The series finale is set for Sunday at 6:35 PM with Miller Auto Team Fireworks to follow.



#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
