



Pregame Clinic FAQ

Q: Is there an age restriction?

A: Pregame clinics are designed for ages 5-12.

Q: Are parents allowed on the field?

A: Parents are NOT allowed on the field for pregame clinics, however parents may watch from the Bowl seating until the conclusion of the clinic.

Q: Do kids need to bring any equipment or bats?

A: Participants will need to bring their own glove, but will not need to bring a bat or any other equipment. Uniforms are not required, but may be worn if they choose to.

Q: When is the pregame clinic?

A: Pregame clinic registration check-in will start 2 ½ hours before first pitch and the clinic will begin 2 hours before first pitch.

Q: I did not receive a confirmation email, do I need it of check-in?

A: The confirmation will show on the webpage once you've submitted the registration. You will NOT receive an additional email nor will one be required for check-in. They will just need the name of the participant when checking in.

Q: Do I need a ticket to the game to attend a pregame clinic?

A: Yes, game tickets are required in order to participate in the pregame clinic.
