"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

GASPER THE HERO AS SAINTS WALK IT OFF ON A HOMER, AGAIN! The St. Paul Saints walked it off with a three-run home run for the second night in-a-row as catcher Mickey Gasper took a first pitch curveball deep, breaking a 10-all tie in the bottom of the ninth to catapult St. Paul to their fifth straight victory. Left-hander Josh Walker, who gave up the three-run homer the night before to Mike Ford with the Saints down two, again found himself on the mound, this time looking to send it to extras when Gasper ambushed him on a first pitch swing, marking just the second time in Saints franchise history that St. Paul walked it off on back-to-back nights, and for the first time doing so with two home runs. In a game in which the Saints led for the first time after Mike Ford singled in a pair in the eighth to make it a 10-8 game, they quickly gave up the lead when DH Riley Tirota homered in the top 9th to extend the game to the bottom half. Outfielder Carson McCusker had another strong showing, finishing the night 3-for-3 with a double and two walks, reaching in all five trips to the plate, and plated a key run in the fifth that made it 6-5. McCusker has now hit safely in 11 straight to match a career-high. Will Holland homered for the second time in five games back with the Saints, and Ryan Fitzgerald homered for a second consecutive night with a two-run fly in the third.

THE SAINTS ARE HOT: After back-to-back walk-off victories, the Saints have now won eight of their last nine games, the best winning-percentage (.889) in the International League going back to Sunday, April 27, and the second-best among 120 full-season minor league teams in that span, trailing only Las Vegas (9-1, .900). Over the past nine games, the Saints have outscored the opposition 55-42 (+13). St. Paul's team batting average of .309 (90-291) & OPS of .915 are both the best among all 120 full-season minor league teams in that span while their 16 homers are tied for the 2nd-most. St. Paul are riding a season-best five-game win streak and are four games above .500 for the first time this season.

MY POWER IS BEYOND YOUR UNDERSTANDING: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 32 round-trippers in their last 20 games, which ranks second only to Charlotte (37) in the IL in that span. St. Paul have hit at least one home run in their previous five games, a season-high.

MCCUSKER MCCRUSHING: Recently named the Twins minor league player of the month for March/April, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). On one swing on Tuesday night, he simultaneously tagged the Saints' hardest-hit ball (114.7 mph) and the longest home run of the season (426 feet), a go-ahead, two-run blast in the sixth vs Buffalo. McCusker now has the two hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including two batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is one of seven hitters in the minors with at least 9 homers this year and has already tied Junior Severino in 2024 for the most home runs in Saints history by the end of May. The Sparks, Nevada native is also currently in the midst of an 11-game hitting streak, the longest by a St. Paul batter so far this year and tying his career-high, a stretch he previously established from May 26-June 7, 2023 in indy ball. With a one home run in his next two games, he would reach 10 homers in a season in the 3rd-fewest number of games in Saints history (see below):

BUILT FORD TOUGH: Mike Ford has now homered in four of his last eight games after Wednesday's walk-off blast. The Princeton grad has also hit safely in ten straight dating back to April 26, a stretch where he is batting .364 (12-33) with 4 HR, 13 RBI, and 7 walks. It mark's Ford's longest hit streak since he collected a knock in 11-in-a-row from July 3-July 17, 2021 with the Durham Bulls (TB). The longest hit streak of his career was a 12-gamer from July 12-August 18, 2014 with the Charleston RiverDogs in A-ball.

RUNNING INTO OUTS: The Saints are just 25-of-39 (64.1%) in stealing bases as a team this year, making them the 2nd-least efficient team in Triple-A in stealing and bottom-10 in the minor leagues (they currently rank 112th out of 120 full-season teams). The Minnesota Twins are also the worst team in stolen-base% (71.0%) in the majors and Double-A Wichita are bottom-20 in the minors as well (66.7%).

"I'M JUST LOOSENING MY ARM": Saints utility-man Jeferson Morales now has five outfield assists on the year, which places him t-2nd in baseball (majors & minors), trailing only the Guardians' Steven Kwan (6). He's already just the sixth-ever St. Paul Saint with at least five outfield assists in a season, joining Jimmy Kerrigan (2x, 9-2021, 6-2021), Mark Contreras (2x, 8-2022, 5-2021), DaShawn Keirsej, Jr. (7, 2024), Jake Cave (6, 2022), Matt Wallner (5, 2023).

STRAIGHT GAS: The Saints pitching staff rank as the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season with an average pitch velocity of 89.5 mph that ranks as a harder throwing staff than 20 Major League teams. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 11th in Triple-A in K-rate (24.7%) and 9th in whiff-rate (28.9%). By average velo on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks t-11th in Triple-A (92.5). Jacob Bosikovic (96.9, 16th), Ryan Jensen (96.8, 20th) and Alex Speas (96.5, 25th) are all top-25 in the Triple-A circuit in average fastball velo (min 100 pitches).

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America. The Saints tout four of Minnesota's Top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's Top-100 list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (18-20) have won five straight after completing a sweep of the Orioles yesterday afternoon at Target Field. Byron Buxton's 3-game streak with a homer was snapped, but the Twins centerfielder is still hitting a robust .270 with 9 HR and an .844 OPS and ranks t-6th in the AL in fWAR (1.6). Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (16-14) snapped a five-game skid with a win at NW Arkansas yesterday. High-A Cedar Rapids (19-10) have won 8 of their last 10 despite giving up two grand slams to Marlins prospect Ryan Ignofo last night in a loss in Beloit. Low-A Fort Myers are 15-15 to start this season after losing at home to Dunedin.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Friday in game one of a doubleheader in Columbus, cut short due to rain in five innings. After a clean 1-2-3 top 1st, ran into trouble with back-to-back walks to start the second. Gave up a run on a sac fly. Walked three batters, including the leadoff man, in the third and allowed three more runs, but left two runners stranded with the help of an inning-ending double play. Threw 18 cutters (29%), 17 curveballs (27%), 15 sweepers (24%), 6 four-seamers (10%), 4 changeups (6%), and 2 sinkers (3%). Induced five swings-and-misses, all coming on his curveball and cutter, and struck out two hitters on the curve.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletes run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.

LAST APPEARANCE: Got the win in relief on Sunday in Columbus pitching behind Zebby Matthews and MLB rehabber Michael Tonkin. Worked three scoreless innings between the 7th, 8th, and 9th to hold a 2-2 game where it was and send it to extras in an eventual Saints win. Pitched around traffic each inning, including stranding three runners in scoring position that represented the go-ahead run. Threw 20 four-seam fastballs (42%), 11 changeups (23%), 11 sinkers (23%), and 6 sweepers (13%). Induced six whiffs, led by three on the four-seamer. Recorded a strikeout apiece on the four-seam and changeup.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp an the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints will mark the 10th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings; he worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineout in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT! Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former "Dirtbags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.
