TODAY'S GAMES: In their longest homestand of the season, the Space Cowboys conclude their six-game series with Round Rock... This is Game 6 of 12 during Sugar Land's two-week homestand and Game 12 of 18 at Constellation Field in August... The Space Cowboys have lost 9 in a row and also fallen in their last 9 straight against Round Rock.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: The Express struck for three in the first and two more in the fourth... RHP Colton Gordon hurled five innings for the Space Cowboys, striking out three... For Round Rock, LHP Cody Bradford allowed a hit in the first and then retired 14 straight, allowing just three hits in six innings... In the eighth, Marty Costes tripled in a run, Michael Brantley brought in a run with a single and a throwing error brought in a third run, but Sugar Land fell 8-3.

ROSTER MOVES: 8/19 - OF Corey Julks recalled by Houston... 8/17 - RHP Shawn Dubin activated from the IL... LHP Nick Allgeyer placed on the Development List... 8/16 - C Andrew Knapp signed to a contract and assigned to Sugar Land... RHP Kyle McGowin released by Houston... 8/15 - OF Joey Loperfido promoted to Sugar Land... OF Michael Brantley assigned to Sugar Land on Major League rehab.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 9 players drafted by the Astros, 2 players signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

PROSPECTING: With the re-ranking of MLB Pipeline's Prospects on Thursday, Sugar Land now has seven of the Astros' Top 30 prospects on their roster, including RHP Spencer Arrighetti (#3), OF Joey Loperfido (#6), LHP Colton Gordon (#7), OF Pedro Leon (#13), OF Justin Dirden (#14), INF Shay Whitcomb (#25) & RHP Misael Tamarez (#30).

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 5-12-1 in sixgame series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 3-7-0 overall at Constellation Field in 2023

WHIT-BOMB: With a two-run homer on 8/11, Shay Whitcomb is now tied for third in Minor League Baseball in home runs, launching 28 total homers between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (16)... Whitcomb has hit safely in eight of his last 21 games with 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 13 RBI, 5 runs scored and a stolen base.

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs (28), RBI (84), Hits (109) & Total Bases (210), is T-3rd in Runs Scored (67) & Extra-Base Hits (45).

UNC STRENGTH: OF Michael Brantley connected for a two-run homer on Tuesday night, his first home run of 2023 and the first home run for Brantley since June 17, 2022 for the Astros against the Chicago White Sox.

Additionally, Brantley has reached safely in all 12 games he's played with Sugar Land this year, going 2-for-4 with an RBI single on Saturday night.

Upcoming Probable Pitchers

VOTE FOR PEDRO: Pedro Leon teed off for three-home runs on 8/12 at El Paso, the first three-home run game of his career and the fifth three-home run game in Space Cowboys' history... For the series against El Paso, Leon went 8-for-22 (.334) with a double, 5 home runs, 13 RBI and 7 runs scored.... He had an RBI in all five games he played in and had two five-RBI games.

The La Habana native had his 20-game on-base streak snapped on 8/11, but over his last 27 games is slashing .303/.371/.569/.940 (33-for-109) with 5 doubles, 8 home runs, 25 RBI, 16 runs scored and has walked 13 times... Leon has hit safely in 21 of those 27 games and has 11 multi-hit efforts in that stretch.

MEET THE NEW GUY: Astros' #6 prospect Joey Loperfido was promoted to Sugar Land on Tuesday and made his Triple-A debut, going 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored... At the time of his promotion, Loperfido was tied for the Texas League lead in OPS (.940), 2nd in Slg % (.548), T-5th in Home Runs (19), 6th in Avg (.296) & OBP (.392), 8th in extra-base hits (40) & total bases (172).

Taken in the 7th round of the 2021 draft out of Duke, Loperfido led the Astros' organization in batting average in 2022 (.316) and was 3rd in stolen bases (32).

TWO-BY-FOUR: JJ Matijevic went a perfect 5-for-5 with 4 doubles on 8/8 at El Paso... The four doubles in the contest are a franchise record for doubles in a single game, passing Alex De Gotti (5/30/21 vs. ABQ) and Justin Dirden (5/4/23 @ ABQ).

Matijevic is now tied for second in the PCL in triples (6), T-4th in extra-base hits (48), T-5th in doubles (26) & T-8th in RBI (71) ... Matijevic had his 12-game on-base streak snapped on 8/6 in a pinch-hit at bat, but over his last 22 games is slashing .280/.372/.610/.982 (23-for-82) with 10 doubles, a triple, 5 homers, 17 RBI and 16 runs scored and has hit safely in 16 of his last 22 games.

POSITION. PLAYER. PITCHING: In the 10th inning on 8/2, Marty Costes made his professional pitching debut... The outfielder walked two batters but got a double play and allowed just one unearned run before picking up the win in a 7-6 Space Cowboys victory... It's the second time this season Sugar Land has used a position player to pitch (Michael Sandle - 5/3 @ ABQ)

DOUBLE-DOUBLE: On 8/1, Rylan Bannon and JJ Matijevic both had multi-homer games... It was the first multi-homer contest of the season for Bannon and his first since 8/19/21 with Norfolk... Coincidentally, Bannon had three multi-homer games in a seven-game span from 8/11-8/19/21... It was the third multi-homer game of the season for Matijevic, who hit two home runs on 4/5 vs. RR and then again on 4/13 @ OKC.

RIDE THE BIKEL: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT: Got the start on Tuesday night in the opener against Round Rock... Allowed a single and a two-run homer, but then retired the next six in a row... Surrendered two more in the third and one in the fourth, departing trailing 5-2... Took the loss in a 6-3 Space Cowboys defeat.

STARTING WITH THE 'STROS: As a starter with Houston this year, is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA, hurling 38.0 innings and allowing 20 runs, all earned, on 21 walks with 35 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .226 batting average against.

MOVES IN 2023: Optioned to Sugar Land on August 3... Recalled and started for Houston on August 2... Optioned to Sugar Land on July 8... Was recalled by Houston on July 6 and started that day against Seattle, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs... Had been slated to start for Sugar Land that day but was recalled... Was optioned to Sugar Land on July 2... Originally recalled by the Astros on June 1.

NO RUNS FOR YOU: Hurled 16.0 scoreless frames with Sugar Land from his outing on May 9 to the second inning on July 15, spanning four appearances... His 16.0 inning scoreless streak is the longest streak for a Space Cowboys pitcher in 2023.

FIRST START SINNNNCCE: When Blanco started for Sugar Land on May 9, it was his first start since July 26, 2019 while he was with Tri-Cities.... Even then, Blanco only threw two innings.. He last worked as a full time starter in 2017, making 11 starts in 22 total appearances with Quad Cities, hurling 84.2 innings.

DOWN HERE FOR YOGA: Blanco was optioned to Sugar Land on May 6 to increase his innings and stretch out as a starter... He had previously been in the bullpen for the Astros, making 9 relief appearances in 2023... Tossed 12.0 innings and allowed nine runs, six earned, with seven walks and 16 strikeouts.

DEBUT SZN: Made the Opening Day Roster with the Astros in 2022 and made his Major League debut on April 8.

HOLD ME CLOSER: Has totaled 27 saves in 38 total save chances between 2021 and 2022 with Sugar Land.

WELCOME TO THE 'STROS: Signed as an international free agent when he was 22 on April 27, 2016... Began his carer as a corner infielder and outfielder with a strong arm... Converted to pitching at the age of 18.
