LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones snapped their brief 2-game slide with a 5-1 win over the Renegades on Thursday night...RHP Tyler Stuart tossed a career-high 7.2 innings and registered a career-best 11 strikeouts, en route to his 2nd win of the year...The 23-year-old allowed 4 hits and 1 walk...Only run scored on a C Antonio Gómez solo home run in the 2nd...Brooklyn grabbed the lead for good in the 4th...LF Abraham Almonte gave the 'Clones the lead with a 2-run single...He reached base 3 times, adding 2 walks...3B William Lugo capped the frame with a 2-run home run to left, as part of a 2-hit night... RHP Benito García registered the final 4 outs to close out Brooklyn's win.

SECOND VERSE: Today marks the start of the second half of the 2023 South Atlantic League season...Brooklyn finished the first half with a 28-37 mark...Hudson Valley won the First Half North Division title, while Greenville captured the South Division...In 2022, the Cyclones advanced to the SAL Playoffs by winning the circuit's Second Half North Division crown...Brooklyn (40-26) won the division by 2.0 games over Hudson Valley (37-27).

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strike-outs (11), earning his 2nd win of the year on Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart is also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum is the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP Kevin Canelon whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.44)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.5%) and FIP (2.89), 2nd in xFIP (3.18), 3rd in strikeouts (78), 4th in strikeout rate (31.0%) and innings pitched (62.2), 5th in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20) and WHIP (1.09), and 6th in batting average against (.209).

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old registered a career-high 7.0 innings of shutout ball, earning the win last Saturday night at Aberdeen...Tidwell is the first Cyclone to post 7.0+ innings in a shutout victory since RHP **Jeffrey Colón** did the same in a 3-0 win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts in his previous start on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 6 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 3-0 with a 1.32 ERA (4 ER in 27.1 IP) with just 13 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 22 and struck out 39 (12.84 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 34.2% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .141 batting average (13-92) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.141) and is tied for 4th in ERA (1.32) since that date (min. 25.0 IP)...He is also tied for 7th in strikeouts (39).

BULLS ON PARADA: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .314/.364/.471 with a .834 OPS and 129 wRC+ in 13 games...Parada has accrued 5 runs scored, a triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Friday on a 5-game hitting streak (8-for-20) and a 10-game on-base streak (.316/.381/.447)...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Friday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (14).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.22) in the entire South Atlantic League and 2nd-best among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids leads (3.13) lead the classification...Hudson Valley (3.35) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 3rd best in all of Mil.B...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads Mil.B (3.09).

A-RAM IT: OF Alex Ramírez walked twice more on Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...In the month of June, the 20-year-old is 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (14)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchis history in RBI (65) and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...He is also tied for 4th in hits (116), 5th in total bases (174), and 6th in doubles (26).

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Benito García has come into his own in Brooklyn's bullpen over the last few weeks...The 23-year-old tossed 1.1 innings of scoreless relief on Thursday and has not allowed a run over his last 4 appearances dating back to June 9...In that span, García has allowed just 5 hits in 5.1 innings with no walks and 5 strikeouts...Benito also accrued his first save with the franchise on June 14 at Aberdeen...Since returning from Single-A St. Lucie on May 30, García holds a 1.17 ERA (1 ER in 7.2 IP) and 6 strikeouts in 6 relief outings.

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 26 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (103), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (101), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (99), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (97) and Red Sox INF David Hamilton (97) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 6 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in Tuesday's defeat...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8...His 91 pitches also set a career-high...Over his last 2 starts, Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.27 ERA (4 ER in 11.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 13.09 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 35.6% (16/45) in that span.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 12-game homestand, starting with 6 contests against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21...The Cyclones went 4-2 in the set, taking 4-straight games from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Cyclones are 131-138 (.487) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 10 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.08 ERA (2 ER in 16.2 IP) on 5 hits and 7 walks, registering 25 strikeouts (13.50 K/9)...That equates to a 39.7 K% (25/63).

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn posted a career-best performance in Saturday's win at Aberdeen...The 24-year-old tallied a professional-high-tying 3 hits and collected his 1st career multi-home run game...Osborn added a season-best 4 RBI, as well...His 1st 3-hit night came on April 30, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie vs. Daytona...The multi-home run performance was the first by a Cyclone since RF Alex Ramírez blasted two long balls on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...Osborn is the first 'Clone to record 2+ home runs, 3+ hits, and 4+ RBI in a single game since DH Brett Baty (3/4, 2 HR, 4 RBI) accomplished the feat on June 3, 2021, at Jersey Shore...3 of Osborn's last 4 hits have been home runs and 4 of his last 6 have left the ballpark, as well...Osborn is tied for the team lead in home runs with 6...This is despite having 39 fewer plate appearances than INF Mateo Gil (6 HR/138 PA), 48 fewer than OF Stanley Consuegra (5 HR/147 PA), and 155 fewer than OF Alex Ramírez (5 HR/254 PA) and C Kevin Parada (5 HR/254 PA).

DINKY DONUTS: RHP Blade Tidwell (7.0 IP) and RHP Dylan Tebrake (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 5-0 win at Aberdeen last Saturday night...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since an 8-0 victory at Jersey Shore on May 30...Tidwell (3.2 IP) also started that night...RHP Jace Beck (2.1), RHP Brendan Hardy (1.2), RHP Michael Krauza (0.1), and RHP Joshua Cornielly (1.0) also united on a 5-hit blanking of the BlueClaws...The 'Clones have accumulated 5 shutouts through the first 62 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...ln addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after last Friday's loss at Aberdeen...21.5% (14-of-65) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 24.3% (9-of-37) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...38.5% (25-of-65) have been determined by just 1 run, including 7 of the team's last 11 affairs.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and added another 4.0 more scoreless frames out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.26)...Gervase averages 13.81 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.1% strikeout rate.

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023... Over his last 3 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 7.1 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 8...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.64 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.1% strikeout rate with a 11.2% walk rate.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Friday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (197), at-bats (646), plate appearances (773), runs scored (99), walks (106), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last week...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

TOP PROSPECT: Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list by MLB Pipeline...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 7 overall farmhand by Baseball America...Only Cyclone alum RHP Matt Vasil is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft... Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent... At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP Ryan Weathers...Ryan's father, David, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
