THREE-RUN SIXTH PROPELS RIDER TO 5-3 WIN OVER TULSA, EARN SERIES VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Tulsa Drillers 5-2 on Saturday evening from Riders Field. The RoughRiders (16-10, 60-35) threatened early against Tulsa (13-12, 47-47) starter **Carlos Duran** as they had two reach in both the first and second innings, but were unable to manufacture a run. **Ryan Garcia** (8-4) cruised through 3.0 scoreless innings, but **Damon Keith** broke the scoreless tie with a solo homer to left in the top of the fourth. Frisco responded in the home half of the fourth inning when **Abimelec Ortiz** launched an opposite field shot, tying the game at 1-1 with his seventh homer of the season. **Daniel Mateo** gave the Riders the lead with a two-out RBI single, plating **Keyber Rodriguez**. Garcia exited after recording the first out of the sixth inning, spinning 5.1 one-run innings in which he allowed five hits and a walk while striking out seven. **Robby Ahlstrom** picked up the final two outs of the sixth before going on to allow one unearned run in the seventh. In the bottom of the sixth, the RoughRiders extended the lead on an **Alejandro Osuna** RBI single, scoring **Frainyer Chavez**. **Liam Hicks** made it a 5-1 advantage with a two-run single that brought Osuna and Jung across the plate. The Drillers cut the deficit to 5-2 in the top of the seventh. **Reid Birlingmair** turned in 1.1 scoreless innings with four punchouts while surrendering a hit and a pair of walks. **Tyler Owens** earned his eighth save of the year, tossing a 2-3 top of the ninth inning. Offensively, the Riders snagged 10 hits with Osuna and Chavez leading the way with two-hit nights. Hicks paced the offense with two RBI as Jung went 1-for-4 and scored a run.

I WANT TO BE FOREVER JUNG:

Rangers third baseman **Josh Jung** is slated to rehab with the RoughRiders Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Jung was a star during the World Series run last season with the Rangers, batting .308/.329/.538/.867 with four doubles, three home runs and eight RBIs in 17 playoff games. During the regular season, he was the AL All-Star starter at third base while finishing fourth in AL Rookie of the Year voting. With the RoughRiders in 2021, Jung played 43 games, batting .308 with 10 home runs and 40 RBIs before finishing out the season with Triple-A Round Rock and debuting in 2022 with Texas. In his first two rehab games on Friday and Saturday, he has gone 2-for-7 with two singles.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Maximo Acosta has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders in July, hitting .281 (18-for-64)/.338/.406/.744 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, eight RBIs, 10 runs scored and seven stolen bases. As one of six qualified players in the Texas League age 21 or younger, Acosta is hitting .341 (14-for-41)/.404/.512/.916 over his last 11 games. He has also excelled with runners in scoring position, placing third in the Texas League with a .333 average with RISP and first with a .462 average with RISP and two outs.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-14 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .714 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +84 run differential, a 3.57 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .760 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-21 with a 3.41 ERA, but a +17 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .633 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .346/.403/.605/1.008 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .346 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 20 games, he is hitting .320 (24-for-75)/.416/.587/1.003 with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Over his last 17 games, he is batting .339 (21-for-62)/.447/.629/1.076 with five doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .375 (6-for-16) with three doubles and a 1.063 OPS for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 18 games, he is hitting .302 (19-for-63)/.384/.524/.908 with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBIs and seven runs scored. This season, he has a career high in average (.278), slugging percentage (.470) and OPS (.808) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (72) and home runs (18).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.93 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.47), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .227 BAA is on pace to be the best in the franchise's history.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

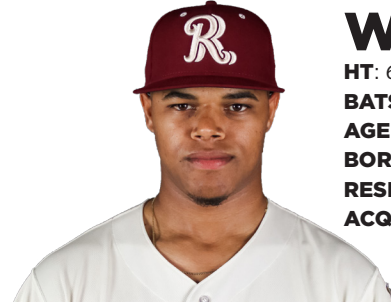

- Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.
- Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.
- Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.

2024 SEASON

- After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.
- Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.
- After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.
- Poured in best Double-A start in second outing against Arkansas, allowing one unearned run over five innings with seven strikeouts in a win.
- Participated in the Futures Game in Arlington, allowing an unearned run over one inning pitched.
