Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound today, making his second start (had 0GS in last season of affiliated ball, 2024). Worcester will counter with LHP **Patrick Sandoval**. Columbus is 1-1 (.500) versus left handers this year. Sandoval has never pitched against Columbus, as today marks his International League debut (Triple-A career consists of 15GS in the PCL in 2019).

vs. the Red Sox

Against the WooSox, Columbus is 12-6 all-time and, dating to August of 2014, Columbus has pounded Boston's Triple-A affiliate 37-19. This week marks the fourth trip to Massachusetts in as many seasons, as the Red Sox have still not been to Columbus since moving from Pawtucket. **Kody Huff** has gone 8x22 (.364) with 7RBI against Worcester in his career (6G).

Left Behind

Today will mark the third time this year that Columbus will face off against a southpaw starter (33G last year) and, even with a left-heavy lineup, Columbus is slashing .313/.439/.433 (4th, 3rd and 6th in the IL) with 1HR in 67AB. Last season, 19.9% of Clipper plate appearances came against lefties (7th highest rate in the IL) and they hit .228/.307/.390 in such situations (worst average and OBP, 7th worst SLG).

Interesting Strategy

Columbus enters today's matchup as the only undefeated team in the IL when allowing the opponents to homer (6-0), while being one of six teams with a losing record when keeping opponents in the yard (1-3). The pitching staff is tied for 8th fewest homers allowed (9), but the 5HR allowed with runners on is tied for 7th most (both bombs last night were multi-run shots).

Hitting Back

The 4-run 7th inning allowed by Columbus was the third multi-run 7th for opponents this season, as the Clippers are being outscored 18-7 in the 7th this year (18-3 in the last 5G). However, from the 8th inning on, Columbus is punishing the opposition to the tune of 22-1 (most runs scored, fewest allowed), though the only run allowed was the game-loser on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis (blew 7-run lead).

Walk Before You Run

This week's matchup features the top two in the IL in walks, with Worcester (71) outpacing Columbus by one (70; Clippers were +8 last night, no other IL team has more than 60BB). Both offenses rank among the top three in the IL in scoring with the Sox plating the most (68) and Clippers checking in at 3rd (64). Worcester (.419) and Columbus (.407) are also 1-2 in OBP (4th and 5th, respectively in SLG).

George Town

George Valera was the King of Worcester last night, tying a career high with 6RBI (last: 6/25/19 with Mahoning Valley) on four singles and a couple sac flies (11 of 22SF in career have come with Columbus). He now has an even 200 hits during his 237G in a Columbus uniform (missed 148G while on the DL from 2023-2025), including 40HR (became 30th Clipper to reach 40 in career on 4/3 vs. Indy).

Starting Over

Travis Bazzana had his on base streak snapped at 7G Saturday (.353OBP), but got back on the horse with a pair of hits and a walk last night. The Clippers saw three more season-opening on base streaks of 7G snapped on Sunday (**Nolan Jones**, .516OBP; **Stuart Fairchild**, .581OBP and **Milan Tolentino**, .444OBP), with Fairchild reaching base three times last night and Tolentino twice.

Big Dog

Nolan Jones saw his 15G hit streak with the Clippers snapped on Sunday (dated to 9/21/22, hit .352, 19x54, with 6HR, .778SLG, and 16RBI over the stretch). Including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .327/.447/.665 with 21HR and 73RBI over his last 75G in Triple-A, having reached base in 68 of them (has 21 hitless games). He has also scored 69 times and gone perfect in steal attempts (5).

Filling In

Game 11 will find a catcher starting at 1B for the eighth time this year, with **Kody Huff** getting his fifth start (ninth of career; **Dom Nunez** has 3GS this year and 17GS in his career, all with Columbus). Both backstops have been flawless when playing in fair territory, as has almost all the rest of the defense (5E total; all throwing errors, including 3E on throws from the catcher during steal attempts).

This Date in Clipper History

4/8/2010

The Clippers recorded 19 hits in a 17-4 win vs. Indianapolis to open the season. The 17 runs were the most scored by Columbus on opening day and the 13-run margin of victory was also a first game record. The 19 hits were a sign of things to come, as the 2010 squad went on to set a team record with 1,407 hits during the regular season. The Triple-A National Champs tacked on 113 more hits in the post season.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 393-409 (.490), 363-363 with Columbus (.500).
