**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve continue a six-game set with Harrisburg, the Senators swept the Curve in a 3-game series to open the weekend. Altoona and Harrisburg will play 15 games against each other in the first 33 games of the year.

Alex Clemmey is back for more bruising from the Curve offense. Clemmey failed to throw it over the plate in his first outing against the Curve on Opening Night, April 2, when he walked 5 batters in 3.0 innings. Clemmey attended Bishop Hendricken HS in Rhode Island, same HS as Padres RHP Michael King, and was drafted in the 2nd round by Cleveland in 2023, the Nationals acquired him in July of 2024 in the deal for OF Lane Thomas. Clemmey, who pitched for the National League in the Futures Game last year, is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 11 prospect in the system. Last season he made 6 starts for the Senators and recorded a 6.44 ERA. Altoona tagged him for 5 runs in 4.2 innings on August 28 at Harrisburg's FNB Field.

**SOLO SLAMS:** Altoona has an odd propensity for hitting solo homers early in the season. Entering Wednesday, the Curve have hit 13 homers, 3rd-most among in the Eastern League, 11 of them have been solo.

In a 2-0 win over Portland on April 18 both of Altoona's hits were solo homers. The last time Altoona's only hit was a solo homer was June 21, 2023 when Liover Peguero hit a leadoff homer in a 6-inning rain-shortened win. The Curve last had a game with 2 hits and both were solo homers on May 29, 2021 in a 7-inning game against Erie. Altoona has not had a game where both hits were solo homers in a 9-inning game since 2005.

**BAD TIMING:** The Curve have struggled to get hits with men on the basepaths to begin the year, batting .197 with runners on base - 28th among Double-A clubs. The Curve have grounded into 14 double plays already in 16 games, 2nd-most by a Double-A club.

Altoona's 50 runs are the 2nd-fewest by a Double-A team, tied for the 2nd-fewest by any minor league team (San Antonio, 45 R in 15 games).

**SEEING THE WOODS THROUGH THE TREES:** Lefty Jaden Woods is off to a solid start to begin the season out of Altoona's bullpen. Since joining the club to begin the second half of the 2024 season (June 22, 2024) he has the most strikeouts by an Eastern League reliever (124 in 103.2 IP). This season Woods has picked up 14 strikeouts in 10.0 innings across 6 outings and he's been unscored upon 4-of-6 outings this year.

**OH THAT WAS FAST:** The Curve played the fastest game in franchise history on Saturday, April 18 against Portland, winning 2-0 in one hour and 47 minutes.

**A SLOW START:** The Curve set the franchise record for longest losing streak to begin a season with an 0-12 start, surpassing the 2009 Curve team that went 0-8 to start the year, a streak that finally ended on April 17 with a 5-3 win over Portland. Altoona was the only team in professional baseball without a win when they finally broke through.

**MOSS IS BOSS:** First baseman Callan Moss has a hit in 9-of-15 games to begin his Double-A career, reaching base safely in 11 games overall. In Altoona's first win on Friday he recorded two run-scoring hits, including the game-tying knock in the fifth inning.

**CURVE DOGS:** Altoona and Portland have played each other for 5 series over the last 20+ seasons and after each of them, the Sea Dogs have had a player named Eastern League Player/Pitcher of the Week or Player of the Month. This year, John Holobetz earned the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award last week after striking out 11 batters in 7.0 innings in his start.
