#### FRES-NOTES

FRESNO DESTROYS STOCKTON FRIDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (10-18, 48-45) hammered the Stockton Ports (10-18, 36-56) 16-2 Friday night from Banner Island Ballpark. The Grizzlies kept their momentum going from Thursday's comeback win (5-run 9th), recording a season-high 16 runs on 22 hits. Fresno's two-touchdown margin of victory was their largest in a game this year (previously nine runs). The Grizzlies improved to 77-29 all-time against the Ports (16-6 record this season) with a 42-10 all-time record (12-4 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. The Grizzlies offense talled season-highs in runs (16), hits (22), extra-base hits (6), total bases (31), doubles (4) and consecutive games with a homer (4). Every Fresno starter enjoyed a hit with six of the batters collecting two or more hits. Eight of the 10 batters notched at least one run with half of the players in the lineup grainlying multi-run evenings. The bottom seven batters of the order secured at least one RBI while five of them accumulated two or more knocks. The Grizzlies plated a season-high six runs in the first inning and five runs in the fifth frame. Fresno added two runs in the second and fourth innings while yielding one final run in the ninth. The Grizzlies were beaned once, drew one walk and stole three bases. Fresno only left eight runners on base and went 12-for-19 with runners in scoring position. Despite 16 runs of support, Grizzlies' righty Bryan Perez didn't need it. Perez (4-4, win) was unstoppable over six innings of action. He allowed two runs (one earned), on three hits and two walks while striking out 10. Perez retired 10 straight batters from the second (third out) through the fifth, which included punching out the side in both the fourth and fifth frames. Kannon Handy tossed two hitless and scoreless innings, nipping one batter and fanning three. Jake Madden wrapped up the blowout with a clean ninth. The

MORE NUMBERS ON FRIDAY'S WIN: For the fifth consecutive contest, the Grizzlies scored in the first inning. Fresno had alternated one and two runs in the previous four garnes, but this time, netted six runs after nine batters came to the dish. The Grizzlies hit for the RBI cycle and mustered a sacrifice fly in the frame. Luis Mendez smoked a single to center, Falls there or highest a score of the work of the second, making it 8-0. The Grizzlies batter this season. Braglen Winmer also highlighted the contest with a quartet of hits (we doubles) and four runs scored. Winmer reached base five total times in the win. Mendez logged a trio of hits, RBI and runs in the middle of the lineup. Andy Perez bashed three singles and raced home twice in the leadoff spot. Perez has 10 hits in the current series and has 15 multi-hit games since June 27 (23 games). Hobson and McCabe etched two hits aplece, which included their enormous first-inning knocks. McCabe's two RBI was a career-high. Gile, Hinchman and Tucker pooled together for five RBI.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the fourth of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the third set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 77-29 all-time (18-12 last year) fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 42-10 all-time all-time in a single-season with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

JACK OF ALL TRADES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney, Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #19 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney is from Illinois and grew up with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

NO WALKS WHEN YOU FACE JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has issued one walk over his last seven outings (June 9-July 24), spanning 39 innings. Kaminska has allowed 42 hits and fanned 48 batters in that stretch. He has also not permitted a walk in four straight games (June 30-July 24), spanning 23 innings. Kaminska has scattered 20 hits and struck out 27 batters in that stretch.

ANDY PEREZ IS A MULTI-HIT MACHINE: Since June 27 (25 games), Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez has tallied 15 multi-hit contests. Perez picked up two or more hits from June 27-July 1 (5 games) and has enjoyed multiple hits in four straight games of the current series against the Ports (10 hits overall).

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (105), first in total bases (162), tied for first in triples (6), second in extra-base hits (35), tied for second in doubles (21), third in RBI (57), fifth in batting average (292) and tied for ninth in slugging percentage (.450).

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker, Nate Schierholtz, Jason Ellison and Calvin Murray each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 67 times in 174 plate appearances (37 games; 39% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot), in 11 of those 37 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 32 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-29 (310) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-37, 46% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (28/32 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 28 bases this season. Hobson is currently seven stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.
