Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the finale of a six-game series. This is also the final meeting in the 23-game season series between the two clubs; the Whitecaps are 17-5 against Lansing this season after going 18-3 against the Nuts in 2025.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander **Jorge Marcheco** makes his second start of the series and his sixth start overall for the Lugnuts in his first year in the A's organization; he was selected in the Rule 5 Draft in December from the Angels' organization. The Whitecaps counter with the reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, **Connor Fenlong**, a former member of the Quad Cities River Bandits, released by the Royals in November 2024, signed by the Tigers from independent Lake Country in late June, now making his fourth start for West Michigan. Fenlong shut out Fort Wayne in 5 1/3 innings on August 9 in his last outing.

Last Night: Whitecaps 10, Lugnuts 6. In a doubling up of the totals of Friday's 5-3 Caps win, West Michigan center fielder **Andrew Sojka** played a **Jake Reinisch** triple into a three-run Little League homer in the third inning, then lost two consecutive fly balls in the lights for doubles in a three-run Nuts fifth-inning rally, but redeemed himself with a home run to key a Saturday night victory. **Brady Smith** left early due to injury precaution in the West Michigan win.

LUG-NOTES

Streaking: Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** went 2-for-4 with a single, triple and walk yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 27 games, the longest of the Nuts' season. Reinisch is batting .300/.452/.500 with 27 base hits and 23 walks during the streak.

Power Disparity: No team in the Midwest League has hit fewer home runs than Lansing's 71; West Michigan only has 101, ranking 9th in the 12-team league, but the Whitecaps have homered a league-leading 24 times this month (compared to the Lugnuts' league low eight homers in August). On the other hand, the Nuts have collected 122 hits in August, more hits than West Michigan, or, for that matter, any team not named Wisconsin in the Midwest League. (Note that the Whitecaps have homered 49 times at home while the Lugnuts have 43 home runs at home... but the Nuts only have 28 home runs in 58 games on the road.) 18 different Nuts have homered this year.

Midwest League Leaders:

- **Samuel Dutton** leads the league in innings (108 1/3) and ranks 3rd in ERA (4.40) and tied for 3rd in starts (20).
- **Steven Echavarria**, now promoted to Double-A, allowed the 3rd lowest average (.254), pitched the 6th most innings (93 2/3) and struck out the 8th most batters (93).
- **Riley Huge** made his 35th relief appearance Friday, three behind the league-leading Juan Reynoso of Beloit.
- **Ali Camarillo** is 5th in in the Midwest League in hits (96), 4th in doubles (23) and ranks 7th in batting average (.282).

How About Otto! 2019 Lugnut **Otto Lopez**, who won the Midwest League batting title and now plays for the Miami Marlins (under 2008-2009 Lugnuts manager **Clayton McCullough**), currently leads the Major Leagues in base hits (149) and ranks 3rd in doubles (29), 2nd in triples (7) and 4th in batting average (.308).

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Filling the Squad: On the current Athletics active roster, there are 10 former Lugnuts: **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Gage Jump**, **Jack Perkins**, **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White**, **Jacob Wilson**, **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler** and **Tyler Soderstrom**.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

AUGUST 16 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: Emilio Guerrero went 6-for-6 to tie the team/league record, including a third-inning grand slam amid a nine-run rally, and the Lugnuts destroyed the West Michigan Whitecaps, 14-5.

2019: The Lugnuts set a new franchise record for margin of victory with a 19-1 victory over Fort Wayne at Cooley Law School Stadium. Griffin Conine, Ryan Gold and Rafael Lantigua each hit a two-run homer in the win. The TinCaps finished the game with two different position players, Tyler Benson and Kelvin Alarcon, combining to pitch the eighth. Benson recorded the first two outs, allowing five runs, before Alarcon recorded the final out.

2024: The Nuts pass 10 million fans in franchise history on a wild night: a crowd of 7,851 watch the Lugnuts build a 7-0 lead against West Michigan behind Will Simpson and T.J. Schofield-Sam home runs, the Whitecaps rally to tie the score with four run in the fifth and three in the sixth, and the Nuts go on to overwhelm the 'Caps 13-8 behind a six-RBI performance from Simpson. The game featured 30 combined hits (from 18 different batters) and was concluded in two hours and 57 minutes.

In a Nutshell: Drafted 45th in the Triple-A phase of the 2025 Rule 5 Draft from the Angels' organization...makes his third start of the season today (April 29, Game 2 vs. Dayton: 2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 0 K | July 24 vs. Great Lakes: 4 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K)... joined the rotation following the promotion of Ben Hansen and Zane Taylor to Double-A... in his finest professional start, Marcheco faced an ACLA's lineup on August 22, 2022, with rehabbers Lawrence Butler, Cody Thomas, and Austin Beck, plus Henry Bolte, and tossed 6 shutout IP with 12 K.
