Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Norfolk Tides to start a six-game set tonight at First Horizon Park. The Sounds are coming off a series split with Memphis, while the Tides enter with the best record in the league. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville, facing Norfolk's Drew Rom.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley will start for the Sounds to open the series. He is 0-0 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1 IP/1 ER) in two starts. Boushley's last outing was in game two of a doubleheader on April 6 at Memphis. He held the Redbirds scoreless through 3.1 innings (2 H, 3 BB, 3 K). Boushley went 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA (127.1 IP/46 ER) across 25 starts with Nashville a season ago. The Wisconsinite was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. He was originally selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Drew Rom: 23-year-old Drew Rom starts for the Tides tonight. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (5.0 IP/3 ER) to start the 2023 campaign. Rom last pitched on April 5, taking the win against Gwinnett (5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 3 K). He is tabbed as the No. 19 prospect in the Orioles organization by MLB Pipeline. In 2022, Rom went 8-3 with a 4.43 ERA (120.0 IP/59 ER) in 26 games (25 starts) between Norfolk (7) and Double-A Bowie (19). He was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star last season and a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star in 2019. Rom was drafted by Baltimore in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Highlights High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 3, Third: 2, Fourth: 1, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

Duel of the Fates: Heading into the six-game series, both Nashville and Norfolk rank at the top of the International League in ERA and runs allowed. The Sounds have a 2.68 ERA (74.0 IP/22 ER) through their first nine games, while Norfolk boasts a 3.00 ERA (72.0 IP/24 ER) through their first eight contests.

Keston Crushing: Infielder Keston Hiura went deep for the second time in '23 with a solo homer in Sunday's loss to Memphis. He has hit safely in six of his last seven games and boasts a .972 OPS to start the year.

That's a Relief: Sounds relievers held Memphis to a run after having to eat up 8.0 innings after Stock's short outing on Sunday. Though they've worked the third-most innings in the league, the Sounds bullpen holds the second-lowest ERA at 2.18 and the third-lowest WHIP at 1.19 in the IL.

Stingy Sounds: Nashville pitching has held opponents to a .211 batting average allowed (57-for-270), the lowest average in the league. The club also ranks second with a .311 slugging percentage allowed.

High Tide: Norfolk comes into Hit City with the best record in Triple-A at 7-1. The Tides swept the reigning champion Durham Bulls to begin the campaign, then won five of six over Gwinnett in their first home series. Last season, Worcester opened the year 7-1 before falling to sixth place in their division by the season's end.

We'd Like to Report a Theft: Memphis stole six bases in Sunday's game, becoming the first Sounds opponent to steal six bases in a game since the New Orleans Baby Cakes did so on July 26, 2019. Current Sound Eddy Alvarez stole the first base in that contest.

Elvis and Erceg: Relievers Elvis Peguero and Lucas Erceg have combined to pitch 10.0 scoreless innings of relief. Peguero is 1-0 and has limited opponents to four hits and two walks with eight strikeouts, while Erceg is 2-0 and has yet to allow a hit in his 5.0 innings on the mound.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 605-522 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley started game two of a doubleheader on April 6 at Memphis. He allowed a couple hits and three walks but did not yield a run. Boushley struck out three Redbirds on 66 pitches in a no decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is facing Norfolk for the fourth time in his career, with all previous games coming in 2022. His most recent start came on August 2, 2022 at Norfolk, when he pitched 5.0 one-run innings for a win (2 H, 2 BB, 3 K). Boushley is 2-0 with a 2.30 ERA (15.2 IP/4 ER) and nine strikeouts in his career against the Tides.
