The Express and Isotopes get ready for the series finale on Sunday afternoon at Dell Diamond, with first pitch scheduled for 1:05 p.m. CT. Round Rock LHP John King is slated to make the start up against Albuquerque RHP Antonio Senzatela.

ANOTHER SERIES WIN

The Express took down Albuquerque 9-8 on Saturday night. Albuquerque C Grayson Greiner scored in the third thanks to a Nolan Jones single then hit a two-run home run that scored 1B Michael Toglia in the top of the fourth to make it 3-0. Round Rock tied things up in the bottom of the fourth as 1B Blaine Crim, 2B Justin Foscoe and DH Dio Arias all came home on a combination of three singles, one walk, one Albuquerque error and one ground out. Toglia gave the Isotopes a 4-3 advantage with a solo dinger in the sixth before LF Hunter Stovall scored on a sacrifice fly in the seventh and made it a 5-3 game. The Express offense responded with six in the seventh. After working a leadoff walk, LF J.P. Martinez scored on a double from SS Jonathan Ornelas, who then found home when Crim singled. Foscoe plated two with a triple to make it 7-4. A bases-loaded walk from Martinez scored Foscoe before a passed ball allowed 3B Davis Wendzel to score and extended Round Rock's lead to 9-4. Two Albuquerque runners scored in the eighth on three singles and a double before DH Elehuris Montero brought the visitors within one with a one-out home run. Despite allowing one more baserunner, the Express secured the final two outs for the win.

KING ME

Express LHP John King gets the baseball on Sunday afternoon. The lefty is set to make his second start of the year. His last start on April 25 against Sacramento was his first start since 2019. King went 2.1 innings in the series opener against Albuquerque on Tuesday and allowed one unearned run on three hits with one walk and one strikeout.

MARTINEZ, MARTINEZ, MARTINEZ

Express LF J.P. Martinez extended his on-base streak to 21 games after going 1-for-2 with three walks, one RBI and one run scored. He also stole two bases, bringing his season total to a Triple-A-leading 15. He is fifth in the PCL in batting average (.351) and third in on-base percentage (.490).

CRIM CRUSHING

1B Blaine Crim posted his second multi-hit game of the series on Saturday after going 2-for-4 with a double, RBI, two runs scored and a walk. Crim had the two hardest hit baseballs in yesterday's game. A 111.8 mph line-drive out in the eighth inning and a 108.4 mph double in the second inning. His seventh inning single at 104.7 mph was also the fourth hardest hit baseball of any player last night. In his last 11 games, the righty is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with four doubles, two home runs, five RBI, 10 runs scored, six walks and two strikeouts.

25 GAMES DOWN

Round Rock's 17-8 record is their best through 25 games since 2004 and ties their second-best start in club history. The best start in team history came in 2001 when the E-Train went 18-7 to open their campaign.

THE MOUND IS OURS

The Express have the best ERA in the Pacific Coast League (3.59) and the next closest team is the Oklahoma City Dodgers (4.72). Round Rock is second in strikeouts (251), first in WHIP (1.35) and they have issued the least amount of walks (100). The Express are the only team that has now allowed 100 earned runs this season (89).

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
