vs HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (56-52, 24-18)





ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones lost a 4-0 lead after four innings, allowing the Renegades to score seven unanswered runs en route to a 7-4 victory on Tuesday night in the opener of a six-game series. RHP **Dominic Hamel** tossed four scoreless innings, but allowed five runs in the fifth to take the loss. Brooklyn's offense was led by OF **Matt Rudick** who was 3-for-5 and INF **Shervyen Newton** who was 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored. Hudson Valley relievers RHP **Shawn Semple** and RHP **Nelvin Correa** yielded just one earned run over the final six frames to close out the win.

SUBWAY SERIES: For the final time in 2022, the Cyclones face the Hudson Valley Renegades. Last series, at Dutchess Stadium, the Cyclones won four out of six, winning a series at the home of the Renegades for the first time since the 2019 season. This year, Hudson Valley has won 13 games while Brooklyn has won 12 games of the 25 in the season series. The run differential is +7 in favor of Brooklyn.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 23 games remaining and four series: five more vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game behind of Hudson Valley for first place.

THE RETURN: 1B **JT Schwartz** returns to the field tonight for the Cyclones after missing 14 games on the injured list. Schwartz was hit by a pitch on July 30th and came out of the game, hitting the IL for the

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees affiliate host five of the Bronx Bombers' Top 30 prospects, including two in the top 10. OF Jasson Dominiguez ranks second in the system and 42nd in baseball. SS Trey Sweeney ranks No. 6, LHP Yoendrys Gomez ranks No. 12, LHP Edgar Barclay ranks No. 29, and RHP Juan Carela ranks No. 30. The Renegades finished the first half nine games behind division-winner Aberdeen.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .831 over his past 29 games with a 16-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 27 of the past 29 games, hitting .279 with a .379 OBP. The current active streak leader is Asheville OF **Kenedy Corona** (a 2019 Brooklyn Cyclone) who has a 24-game on-base streak.

TOMMY BOY: Mets reliever RHP Tommy Hunter has begun a rehab assignment with the Brooklyn Cyclones. The 36-year-old veteran has been on the Mets injured list since August 6th with lower back tightness. Signed to a MiLB contract Arpril 28, pitching with Triple-A Syracuse eight times until his contract was selected on June 17 to MLB.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks tied for first in the North Division with a +16 run differential with Hudson Valley. The Cyclones have allowed just 165 runs over 43 games (3.8 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.0 runs per game in the second half.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 426 runs in 109 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and fifth-worst in Minor League Baseball in fewest runs.

LATE BLOOMER: The 22-year-old righty did not appear in a game until June 2 with Low-A St. Lucie. Once active, Colon made four starts and nine appearances out of the bullpen, striking out 28.6% of hitters and walking just 5.5% with a 2.58 FIP and a 3.23 ERA.

MORE STARTS IN 2022: Prior to the 2022 season, Colon made only four starts in his 57 appearances. This season, the righty has made four starts. Colon has been used in late innings in his career, posting seven holds and saves in eight of 13 chances.
