LAST TIME OUT

The Sky Carp managed just one run between both games of Thursday's doubleheader, falling 3-0 in game one and 3-1 in game two. In game one, Beloit couldn't crack Loons starter Gavin Stone, who hurled six shutout innings. Beloit had a bases-loaded opportunity in the top of the 7th with one out, but couldn't capitalize. In game two, the Sky Carp struck first in the 1st inning with a Victor Mesa Jr. RBI double. The lead didn't last long, as the Loons tallied the first of three unanswered runs off Beloit starter Hunter Perdue in the bottom of the first. The Sky Carp outthrew their fowl friends 7-4, but couldn't take advantage.

LET'S JUST PLAY ONE

Doubleheaders haven't been kind to Beloit, as the Sky Carp are now 0-4 in twinbills. In Beloit's first doubleheader vs Wisconsin, Beloit lost 1-0 and 7-4. After yesterday's sweep, Beloit has been shutout twice and has managed just five total runs in doubleheaders.

THAT'S A LOT OF GOOSE EGGS

After last night's goose egg in the run column, Beloit has been shutout seven times this season in 24 games. In 2021, Beloit was shut out just five times throughout the entire campaign. On the other side of the scorecard, the Sky Carp pitching staff has pitched just one shutout. Beloit is last in all of High-A in runs scored, tallying 74 - an average of 3.0. Beloit's .195 batting average is also the worst in High-A.

HOT AND COLD

After compiling 20 runs on 23 hits in the final two games of their series with Cedar Rapids, the Sky Carp have scored just two runs in three games vs the Loons.

ROAD BLUES

Beloit enters action today 3-9 on the road, mostly due to their cold bats. In 12 road games, the Sky Carp are averaging an even three runs per game with a .200 batting average. Beloit has failed to win more than two straight road games, and has lost both of their road series this season.

THESE GEESE CAN RUN

The Sky Carp have been aggressive on the basepaths this season; swiping 34 bags, which is good for 3rd in the Midwest League. Beloit has been caught 14 times, which is tied for first. Nasim Nunez is 2nd in the league with 13 stolen bases, while Orr is 5th with 10.

STILPS ESREVER

An astounding number of Beloit lefthanded hitters have posted reverse splits this season, hitting significantly better against left handed throwers than against righties. Davis Bradshaw is batting .545 vs LHP and .289 vs RHP. Tanner Allen has posted a BA of .421 vs lefties and .204 vs righties. Victor Mesa Jr. is hitting .417 against southpaws and .214 against righties. As a team, Beloit is hitting .245 against lefthanded pitchers and .171 vs righthanders.

IN COMMAND

Beloit's pitching staff's strength has proved to be strikeouts. Beloit ranks 5th in the MWL in K/9 as a staff with a mark of 10.99 - just .35 short of first. Beloit's staff ranks third with a 2.85 K/BB ratio. The Sky Carp bullpen is especially in control, posting a 3.72 K/BB ratio and 12.12 K/9 rate - best among MWL bullpens.

CIRCUS TRIP

Today's game marks the fourth of 12 straight road games for the Sky Carp. After six games in Midland battling the Loons, Beloit will travel to Grand Rapids for six games with West Michigan.

APRIL STRUGGLES BRING... MAY WIN STREAKS?

Beloit finished April with a 6-14 record, good for the worst mark in the Midwest League. The month was highlighted by two long losing streaks; a 7-gamer to open the season, and a 5-game skid from the 23rd through the 28th. Beloit's bats struggled to adjust to the cold, posting league-lows in batting average (.190), OBP (.259), and Runs (59).

2022 SEASON

- Went 5.1 innings in last start, on 4/29 vs CR. Surrendered 2 earned runs, while striking out a season-high 8 and walking a season-low 1.
- Started opening day for Beloit on 4/8 at Cedar Rapids; surrendered 6 earned runs, 5 of which in the fourth inning. Struck out four and walked four.
- Enters the season as a top-20 Marlins prospect per multiple outlets.
