BULLPEN SHINES IN 3-1 WIN OVER MEMPHIS

Both Andrew Pintar and Heriberto Hernandez homered and the Jacksonville bullpen dominated with seven innings of one-run ball in a 3-1 victory over Memphis. Pintar and Hernandez homered in the first to give the Jumbo Shrimp an early advantage. Josh Simpson made his first start since 2021 and went 2.0 perfect innings. The Jacksonville bullpen combined from there to cede just one run in 7.0 frames. After the lone Redbirds run of the game came home in the fifth. Troy Johnston laced an RBI single in the sixth to set the final score at 3-1.

BIG. BEAUTIFUL INNINGS

Over the season's first 39 games, Jacksonville mustered at least four runs in an inning six times. However, over their last 10 contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have put up four runs or more in an inning seven times. Relatedly, over these last 10 games. Jacksonville has piled up 57 runs (5.7 per game). Over the previous 12 contests, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated only 36 runs (3.0 per game - second-fewest in

PINTAREST

Jacksonville outfielder Andrew Pintar got off to a slow start to the season, slashing just .240/.296/.280/.576 with two doubles, three RBIs, six runs and two stolen bases in his first 12 games. The Provo, Utah native has been on a tear in the 30 games since. During this stretch, Pintar is hitting .355/.391/.505/.896 with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 15 RBIs, six walks, 12 runs and 10 stolen bases. On the season, Pintar ranks ninth in the IL in average (.324), tied for ninth in hits (47) and tied for 14th in steals (12).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 21-7 at home this season, the most home wins of any Minor League Baseball team. Jacksonville has outscored their opponents by a 116-87 margin at VyStar Ballpark. The road for Jacksonville, however, has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 9-12 on the road, getting outscored by an 115-103 margin. Jacksonville has hit similarly at home (.721 OPS) versus on the road (.710 OPS). However, their team ERA is 2.47 at home (1st, also 4th in MiLB) compared to 5.41 on the road (24th).

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching. The club ranks third in Triple-A with a 3.69 ERA, and their 202 runs allowed are the fourth-fewest at the level. Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have also limited walks (178, tied for the sixth-fewest in Triple-A). Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks tied for 12th in Triple-A in strikeouts (433), but their 347 hits allowed are just the third-fewest, meaning the club has supressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.2 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 40 of their last 48 games, with multiple steals in 31 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank first in Triple-A and third in the minor leagues with 115 stolen bases.

SO. BABY. PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 40 games, a whopping 30, or 75.0 percent, have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 20-10 (.667) in these closelydecided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 22-11 (.667) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-6 (.647) mark in onerun games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied for the most in the International League and tied for fourth in MiLB.

SHRIMP BITES

At 30-19. Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2010 Jacksonville Suns also started the campaign 30-19 en route to a Southern League championship. A Jacksonville victory on Saturday would mark the club's best 50-game start in recorded club history (2005-present)... Jakob Marsee's 15-game on-base streak is the longest for a Jumbo Shrimp player this season... Heriberto Hernandez is hitting .273/.363/.534/.897 over his last 25 games.



ABOUT ROBINSON

-A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.

-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

2024 SEASON

-Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.

-Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a 4.79 ERA (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .279/.329/.487/.816 against Piña. Those figures dropped to .245/.285/.431/.716 with runners on and .217/.246/.433/.679 with runners in scoring position.

2023 SEASON

-Piña posted fairly similar platoon splits, actually faring slightly better against left-handed hitting (.225/.338/.318/.656 in 213 plate appearances). Right-handed hitters batted .242/.351/.320/.671 against him over 210 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, Piña held opponents to a .205/.323/.274/.597 line in 219 plate appearances. With runners on, however, that swelled to .267/.369/.373/.742 over 205 plate appearances.
