JUMBO SHRIMP AND STRIPERS SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER Dane Myers went a perfect four-for-four, including a home run with seven RBIs and Austin Allen blasted a solo home run as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp split their doubleheader with the Gwinnett Stripers 11-8 and 8-1 Thursday night. Jacksonville took an early 4-0 lead before Gwinnett plated two runs in the bottom of the second. The Jumbo Shrimp used a four-run top of the fourth to jump out to an 8-2 lead but the Stripers cut into the deficit with a four-run bottom of the fourth. Myers' three-run blast highlighted a three-run sixth for Jacksonville en route to an 11-8 win in game one. Allen's solo blast in game two ended Gwinnett RHP Michael Soroka's no-hit bid but the Stripers cruised to an 8-1 win.

GONE FISHIN'

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 27-13 (.675) against the Gwinnett Stripers. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 23 times, with Jacksonville winning 17 of those contests (.739). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Gwinnett 191 to 169 or an average of 4.8 to 4.2 runs per game. In four different series last year, the Jumbo Shrimp had a clean sweep, going 4-0 against the Stripers. Since 2021, Jacksonville has lost only one series to Gwinnett (9/29 - 10/3).

THF BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, Brian Miller had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 25 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 28-for-87 (.322/.388/.437/.825) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 12 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022. Miller is walking in 10.6 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.5 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 23 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 30 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 30 home runs are tied for 18th-most in Triple-A over the last 23 games.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU Jacksonville's 31-40 record is tied for 17th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fiftythree of the club's 70 games, or 75.7 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 48 games against teams with a winning record. Jacksonville is 23-30 (.434) against teams who have posted a record of at least 500

IT'S *STARTING* TO TURN AROUND

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4 Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last 15 contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this recent 15-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 49 runs, 49 earned, on 78 hits (11.0 H/9) in 64.0 innings for a 6.89 ERA with 42 strikeouts (5.9 K/9) against 23 walks (3.2 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in five of these last 15 contests.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 11 of their last 15 games, going 7-8 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 81 to 75 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won five of their last nine. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak by splitting their series last week with Nashville. After falling in the final two contests last weekend against Memphis, Jacksonville has split their last two series and have now gone without a series win for over one month (May 2-7) Collin Lowe became the 15th different pitcher to start for the Jumbo Shrimp in 2023...In 2022, 25 different starters took the mound for Jacksonville, which was a franchise record.
