TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve open their final home series of the regular season with a 2.5 game lead over the Richmond Flying Squirrels.

Jack Choate makes his 7th career appearance against Altoona tonight. Choate pitched twice against Altoona out of the bullpen during the series in early-August. A 9th round draft selection out of DII Assumption College in 2022 by the Giants, Choate made three starts against the Curve last season going 1-2 with a 4.73 ERA. Choate racked up video game numbers in his final season of college baseball, playing in the highly-competitive wood-bat league The Northeast 10, he struck out 127 batters in 70.1 innings. That included a 19-K game and an 18-K game.

20 NICK'S: First baseman Nick Cimillo is the first Curve batter since 2022 (Andres Alvarez, Aaron Shackelford) to hit 20 homers in a season with Altoona. Cimillo, who is now third among PIT MiLB in homers behind teammates Esmerlyn Valdez (26) and Javier Rivas (21), returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 37 games, he's picked up 26 extra base hits (.286 BA, 1.069 OPS). Cimillo, the runner-up for Eastern League Player of the Month in August, led all Double-A players with 11 HR, ranked 3rd in RBI (19), and 3rd in OPS (1.092) in August. Cimillo matched Brad Eldred (August, 2005) for the franchise record for most home runs in a month (11).

Cimillo has a hit in each of his last 7 games (14-for-29), with 3 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 12 RBI, wtih an insane 1.717 OPS.

POSTSEASON CURVE: With 9 games remaining in the Second Half, Altoona holds a 5.5 game lead over Richmond in the Southwest Division. The Curve were last in the postseason in 2018 when they fell to the Akron RubberDucks in the Division Series.

DUCE IS LOOSE: Infielder Duce Gourson has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. In his last 20 games, he is 27-for-72 (.375) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI and 14 BB (since August 7). Gourson had a season-long 12-game hit streak end on Thursday, September 4, he has reached in 13 straight games overall.

SWEEP THE WEEK: For just the fourth time in franchise history the Curve swept the Eastern League's weekly awards as Esmerlyn Valdez was named the Player of the Week and Wilber Dotel was named Pitcher of the Week. Phil Irwin (Pitcher) and Adalberto Santos (Player) were the last Curve teammates to win the awards in the same week on July 30, 2012. Dotel's first career weekly award came after he threw 10.2 scoreless innings across two starts in a critical series win over Harrisburg. Valdez batted .444 (12for-27) with 1 2B, 4 HR and 9 RBI including a homer in three straight games (8/28-30) and had a hit in 5-of-6 games played.

THE 'MERYLN OF VALDEZ: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez homered four times across three games August 28-30, marking the first time in his career that he's homered in three straight games. Valdez leads all Pirates minor leaguers with 26 homers this season. In August, Valdez batted .311 with a 1 2B, 6 HR and 19 RBI, he ranked 3rd among Eastern League players in HR and 4th in RBI in the calendar month.

Valdez has a hit in each of his last 7 games, (14-for-29) with 3 2B, 4 HR and 9 RBI totaling a 1.559 OPS.

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, Konnor Griffin, has a hit in 12-of-14 games with the Curve, including each of the last 12, batting 314 (16-for-51) with a .951 OPS since joining the Curve on Monday, August 18. Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since Paul Skenes in 2023. Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (1st, 110), stolen bases (7th, 65), hits (4th, 149), 5th in RBI (89) and batting average. (5th, .330).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and

RECORD WATCH: With two projected starts remaining in the 2025 season, righty Wilber Dotel will finish in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 124 strikeouts match **Tom Gorzelanny's** 2005 campaign in which he struck out 124. **Ian** Snell holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004. Luis Ortiz in 2022 was the most recent Curve pitcher to threaten the franchise record for strikeouts, earning 126 that season.

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder Mitch Jebb has 33 stolen bases this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchsie history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.

Sammy Siani

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
