ROUGHRIDERS DROP SERIES OPENER TO ROCKHOUNDS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were outraced by the Midland RockHounds 12-3 on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field. Midland (24-16) struck first in the top of the first when Luke Mann hit an RBI single. to take a 1-0 lead Then in the top of the second, Brennan Milone ripped an RBI single and Mann cranked a grand slam to put the RockHounds in front 7-0. In the top of the third, Milone hit his second RBI single of the game to give Midland an 8-0 lead. The RockHounds then scored two in the top of the sixth when Henry Bolte hit a lead-off home run and Junior Perez scored Luke Mann by grounding into a double play. Frisco (22-17) tallied two runs in the bottom of the seventh. Theo Hardy and Ian Moller rolled back-to-back RBI groundouts to score Cam Cauley and Luis Mieses, cutting the Riders lead to 7-2. Euribiel Ángeles plated Midland's final two runs on a fielder's choice in the top of the eighth and an RBI single in the top of the ninth, extending the RockHounds lead to 12-2. **Aaron Zavala** knocked an RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, knifing the Riders deficit to 12-3 before Midland reliever, and former RoughRider, CD Pelham struck out Sebastian Walcott to end the game. RockHounds starter Gage Jump (2-0) turned in his second-straight quality start, pitching six shutout innings while fanning eight. RoughRiders starter **Trey Supak** (3-1) took the loss, allowing four earned runs across 1.1 innings.

KNOCK THAT STARTER OUT ASAP:

The RoughRiders have been much better against the bullpen on offense than they have been against starting pitchers. Against starters, the RoughRiders have been much better against the bullpen on offense than they have been against starting pitchers. Against starters, the RoughRiders are slashing .240/.315/.281/.696 with the second-fewest RBIs in the league (66). When the Riders face opposing bullpens, they are hitting .253/.349/.389/.738 with a league-best 111 RBIs and 20 HR (2nd).

Over the last six games, the Riders are averaging 6.8 runs per game, better than their season average of 5.1. Over this span, the Riders are slashing .2607.353/.447/.800 with 10 home runs. Abimelec Ortiz and Sebastian Walcott both hit three home runs last week to lead the Riders.

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .236 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 22 games. In that stretch, the Riders are just 10-12, batting .182 (34-for-187)/.266/.289/.555 with RISP. Their .182 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 28th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While having reached in his last 10 games, Ortiz is hitting .425 (17-for-40)/.511/.750/1.261 with four doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs . His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (Josh Stowers). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single. He is seventh in the Texas League in May average (.345), third in RBIs (16), tied for third in home runs (four) and third in OPS (1.065). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 14 this month, which is seventh in the league and have allowed 21, which is the most. Frisco's 4.82 ERA is eighth in the league during the month while they are just 8-8

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .324 (23-for-71)/.462/.535/.997 over his last 21 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (32) and is second in OBP (.436) while leading the league in walk rate (24.1 percent), a mark which also ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball (min. 120 PA). He is currently on an 13-game on-base streak, batting .383 (18-for-47)/.517/.574/1.091 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and 13 walks. During the streak, he has reached multiple times in 10 of the 13 games. In May, he is hitting .353/.484/.529/1.013, ranking sixth in average and fifth in OPS in the Texas League.

The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 síashline against the RockHounds. Since 2015, the Riders have had just one winning season against Midland, going 96-126 (.432) against the As affiliate.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:
Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first seven starts, his 2.21 ERA is second in the Texas League. His 4.1 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.83 K/BB is also first.

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA ($20\,\mathrm{ER}/93.1\,\mathrm{IP}$) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins.

2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

-He is 1st in the Texas League (min. 20 IP) in K-rate (39.1%) and batting average against (.120) while he is fifth in swinging strike rate (15.8%) and WHIP (0.90).

-On May 7th at San Antonio, threw 6.0 innings of no-hit baseball, at one point retiring 16 batters in a row. **Ryan Lobus** and **Skylar Hales** then finished out the sixth no-hitter in RoughRiders franchise history.

2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
