

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones collected their 5th walk-off win of the season on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...DH Kevin Parada powered a go-ahead solo home run in the 7th and provided the walk-off RBI single in the 9th, as part of a 3-hit game...Greenville tied it in the 8th on a sacrifice fly...Trailing 5-2, C Drake Osborn pounded a game-tying 3-run shot in the 6th and scored the winning run, starting the rally with a single...SS William Lugo tallied 2 hits and an RBI, while CF Alex Ramírez singled, walked twice, and stole a pair of bags...LF Nick Decker posted 2 hits — both doubles — and an RBI for the Drive...LHP Eli Ankeney retired all 6 batters he faced, earning his first Cyclones victory.

**RAMÍ ROCKETS:** CF Alex **Ramírez** homered for the second-straight game on Tuesday night vs. Greenville...The 20-year-old pounded a game-tying 3-run home run to left in the 7th inning...Ramírez also tallied a solo blast in the 6th inning of Sunday's 9-3 win at Jersey Shore...It marked the 2nd time this season a Cyclone player has homered in consecutive games...RF **Stanley Consuegra** first accom-plished the feat on April 14 and 15 at Winston-Salem...Ramírez is now tied for the team lead in home runs (5) with Consuegra and INF **Mateo Gil**...Alex enters Thurs-day on a 4-game hitting streak...He is 6-for-his-last-13 (.462) with 6 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 steals in that time...Since joining Brooklyn on July 4 of last year, the Mets' No. 2 prospect per MLB Pipeline leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (63), hits (109), doubles (26), extra-base hits (37), total bases (167)...Ramírez is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (63) trailing only team-mate IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** (65), and INF **José Peroza** (69).

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-end-ing, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Ab-erdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year... Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign... 21.2% (11-of-52) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón tossed another gem last Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits... The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

**REMEMBER US?:** This week marks the first time a Boston Red Sox affiliate has played at Maimonides Park since the Cyclones captured the final New York-Penn League championship against the Lowell Spinners in Game 3 of the 2019 NYPL Championship Series on September 10, 2019...PH Alex Erro – who made the final out for Lowell on a strikeout against LHP Andrew Edwards – OF Nick Decker and OF Gilberto Jiménez appeared in that contest and are currently on Green-ville's roster...Jiménez is presently on the 7-day injured list...Current New York Mets 3B Brett Baty started in all 3 games of the series for Brooklyn.

**KEVIN CAN DO:** C **Kevin Parada** extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a 3-hit performance on Wednesday...The 3 knocks matched a career-best...The 21-year-old is 15-for-his-last-46 (.326) with 2 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, and 3 walks...Parada holds a 125 wRC+ and .377 wOBA in that span...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (14)...Since the start of May, Parada is tied for 4th in the circuit in two-baggers (10) and extra-base hits (14), as well as tied for 8th in hits (33).

**GOING, GOING, GIL:** INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .268/.369/.571 and he has registered an impressive .941 OPS, 149 wRC+, and .416 wOBA in that time...Gil is 15-for-56 at the plate (.268) with 11 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 2nd in the league in home runs (4), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (9), tied for 4th in RBI (13), 5th in slugging (.571), and 8th in OPS (.940) and total bases (32).

**THE BEST AROUND:** The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 21 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 49 earned runs (65 total) on 140 hits through the last 178.0 innings...That is good for a 2.48 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia is 2nd in MiLB (2.58)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 79 (10.6 BB%) and struck out 207 in that span (27.8 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 05.65 ever the 21 game stretch. Brooklyn is 12-9 during that span 95-65, over the 21-game stretch...Brooklyn is 12-9 during that span.

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.15) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.51) is 2nd in

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 5 of Boston's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: SS/3B Eddinson Paulino (11), RHP Wikelman González (12), 1B/3B Blaze Jordan (14), IF Brainer Bonaci (16), and LHP Dalton Rogers (29)... Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate in the regular season since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League

**NOT SO STUART LITTLE:** At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May... Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified pitchers in Minor League Baseball — in ERA (1.43)...Stuart is also 9th in the circuit in WHIP (1.20) and 10th in batting average against (.228)...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (87.2%), is 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.46), 4th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 7th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23... Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him.

1-2, E-STEP: After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 26 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .300/.364/.478 with a .841 OPS...Estep has accumulated 15 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 14 RBI in 99 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 128 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 178 points in that time (.047 to .225).

ALL GAS, NO TE-BRAKE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 6 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 3 walks over 9.1 innings, registering 15 strikeouts...That equates to a 42.9 K% (15/35).

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (97), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (96), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (93) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 39...Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 set back in 2017.

**CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Wednesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (185), at-bats (610), plate appearances (730), runs scored (95), walks (100), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (191), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and tied for 5th in hits (113).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They in-clude Parada (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (23/26) and RHP Christian Scott (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 18 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

**FLORIDA'S FINEST:** During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
