Sacramento River Cats (21-18) at Round Rock Express (16-25)

HITTING (ROUND) ROCK BOTTOM: Sacramento dropped last night's game in walkoff fashion, 5-6, after initially holding a 5-1 lead... marked their third walkoff defeat of the season, all of which have come in regulation time...the Cats have dropped 12 of the 33 total games in which they have held the lead at some point...however, marked the first time they have lost a game when leading in the seventh and eighth innings...they are now 14-1 and 16-1 in such games, respectively...Seth Lonsway was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed one run on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and a season-high five strikeouts in a season-high-tying 5.0 innings of work and on a season-high 83 pitches.

▶ Jake Holton went 2-for-4, his sixth multi-hit game of the season, with a three-run double in the eighth...marked his first three-RBI at-bat since September 9, 2025, with the Double-A Erie SeaWolves (also a three-run double)...is also his third career three-run at-bat that was not a home run.

▶ Buddy Kennedy went 1-for-5 with a double, his 11th of the season, and is now tied for fifth-most in the PCL...he is batting .333 (25-for-75) with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .613 slugging percentage and a 1.032 OPS over his last 19 games since April 19...his 12 extra-base-hits since that date are fourth-most in the PCL and T-8th most in Triple-A.

THIS AIN'T IS TEXAS: The River Cats won yesterday's game, 9-2...Sac is 13-2 in games where they score in the first inning, and have won all nine games in which they record multiple home runs...Spencer Bivens was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed no runs on no hits, with two walks and a season-high five strikeouts in a season-high 4.0 innings...was Bivens' first 4.0-plus-inning hitless outing of his career...Osleivis Basabe knocked his third home run of the season, a solo-shot to left field in the seventh...Victor Bericoto homered that same inning, his fourth of the season, tied for the team-lead, scoring Buddy Kennedy.

▶ The Cats had a no-hit bid through 6.2 innings until Jonah Bride singled on a soft ground ball to Basabe...it marked the first time Sac has gone hitless through 6.0 innings since May 17, 2024...Sacramento's only no hitter came on September 3, 2021 when they had a near-perfect game, allowing no walks but hitting one batter.

▶ 11 totals walks by the Sacramento pitching staff marked a season high...the Cats allowed 11-or-more walks once in 2025 (April 1 at LV) and have done so 32 total times in franchise history...the team-high is 16 walks, done on April 18, 2023 vs. Round Rock

▶ Marked the second time in Triple-A recorded history a team has allowed two-or-less hits and 11-or-more walks in a single game...also happened on April 15, 2022, Louisville at Omaha, where Omaha allowed two hits and 14 walks, and won the game 6-4.

KNOCK KNOCK: River Cats batters hit four total home runs on Thursday, tying their season high (also, April 29 at Salt Lake)...the Cats had four games last season where the knocked four-or-more home runs...the second (Susac, 421 feet), fourth (Kennedy, 418 feet) and fifth (Susac, 409 feet) longest home runs by River Cats batters were all hit last night.

▶ Harrison Bader (MLR) (1-for-4) knocked his second home run of the season (also, March 30 with San Francisco), a leadoff solo-shot off the first pitch to left-center field...it was the second leadoff homer for the River Cats this season (also, Nate Furman, April 25 vs. ABQ), as well as Bader's eighth leadoff homer of his career and first since October 2, 2021 with St. Louis...was also the fourth leadoff homer on the first pitch in the PCL this season...was Bader's fourth leadoff blast on the first pitch in his career, with all three others occurring in 2016 with the Double-A Springfield Cardinals, most recently May 10, 2016.

▶ Daniel Susac (MLR) (3-for-4) hit his first home run of the year (and first since August 31, 2025), a two-run, 409-foot shot to left center field in the third inning...marked the third-longest homer by a River Cat this season...followed that up with a second homer in the fifth, making him the second River Cat this season to have a multi-homer game (also, Bryce Eldridge, April 29 at Salt Lake)...Susac had two multi-homer games in 2025 with Las Vegas, most recently on June 10 vs. Salt Lake...marked his fifth multi-hit game of the season, and third three-hit game.

▶ Buddy Kennedy (2-for-4) hit his third home run of the year directly after Susac, marking the first back-to-back home runs for the River Cats since June 17, 2025 when Bryce Eldridge and Marco Luciano had back-to-back knocks...also was Kennedy's first time homering in back-to-back games since May 14-17, 2025 when he homered in four-consecutive games...also hit an RBI double in the seventh, his third multi-extra-base-hit game of the season...marked his 11th multi-hit game of the year, tying him with Eldridge and Victor Bericoto for most on the team.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Catcher Drew Cavanaugh and infielder Aeverson Arteaga were called up from Double-A Richmond on May 12...in 22 games with Richmond, Cavanaugh was batting .279 (19-for-68) with seven doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 17 walks, three stolen bases and a .971 OPS...Arteaga was batting .318 (21-for-66) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, six walks, a .500 slugging percentage and an .895 OPS in 23 games with Double-A Richmond this season.

▶ Cavanaugh joined the River Cats for 14 game last season where he batted .184 (9-for-49) with one double, one home run, three RBI, four walks and a .510 OPS...Arteaga is set to make his Triple-A debut tonight.

WHIZ KID: Southpaw Carson Whisenhunt is set to start tonight night at Round Rock...last pitched on May 8 vs. Reno where he did not factor into the decision of Sacramento's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on four hits with two walks and season-high-tying eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...over eight appearances (7 starts) this season, Whiz has posted a 4.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 17 ER) with one home run, 18 walks, 43 strikeouts and a .231 opponent batting average...his 43 strikeouts are second-most in the PCL, behind Josh Stephan (48)...he is ranked first in the PCL in opponent batting average and third in ERA, as well as fifth in WHIP (1.36) and T-8th in innings pitched...in 2025, Whisenhunt started 21 games for Sac...posted a 4.43 ERA (107.2 IP, 53 ER) with 35 walks, 95 strikeouts and a .273 opponent batting average...also made his MLB debut in 2025...started five games for the Giants; had a 5.01 ERA (23.1 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks, 16 strikeouts and a .267 opponent batting average.

BOYS IN THE BIGS: On Tuesday, Eric Haase knocked two home runs, becoming the first player to homer twice off Yoshinobu Yamamoto in the same game...four Cats batters are currently playing on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats so far this season:
