### Happy Mother's Day

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils finish a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It is the sixth matchup of the season between the teams, as Reading won last year's season-series 11-8. New Hampshire has the 3-2 edge in the 2023 season series. Reading goes to New Hampshire from May 30-June 4 and again from August 8-13. The Fisher Cats return to Reading from August 29-September 3.

### Pitching Powers to Win

Last night, the R-Phils won 4-1 behind an excellent outing from six different relief pitchers. It was a planned bullpen game from the start and Cristian Hernandez led off the group with two-strong innings pitched. Offensively, Reading was quiet with just three hits, but they scored timely runs. Included was a solo home run from McCarthy Tatum to snap a recent dry spell for him.

### Packing Them In

The Fightin Phils fans have turned in season-high crowds on back-to-back nights. On Friday, 8,213 fans packed in FirstEnergy Stadium and last night 8,405 fans attended. Both night's featured post-game fireworks. So far in 2023, Reading is averaging 4,974 fans per game, which paces for 343,206 over a 69-game schedule. In 2022, Reading averaged 5,577 fans per game and finished the year with 368,068 total fans.

### Flipping the Script

After recent struggles, the Fightin Phils bullpen turned in its best performance of the season. Six pitchers combined to throw nine innings, allowing just one run on five hits, with nine strikeouts. They also combined to allow no walks. That mark helped move the Fightin Phils from sixth to second-ranked in the Eastern League in walks, per nine innings pitched, with a mark of 4.27.

### **Looking Ahead**

Following tonight, the Fightin Phils are back on the road at the Somerset Patriots. Somerset is playing great baseball right now as it sits at 20-11 on the season and just one-half game back of Portland in the Northeast Division Standings. This week, the Patriots have taken three-of-five games so far from Portland, with game six scheduled for today at 1 p.m. The teams have alternated wins in the series so far, with Somerset winning Saturday.

### Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies stayed hot with a 7-4 win at Colorado last night, that featured a Bryce Harper home run. The Phillies have now won five games in a row. Lehigh Valley fell again to Memphis 5-3 to drop uner .500 at 18-19. Jersey Shore topped Greensboro 9-5, while Clearwater beat Dunedin 8-3 to improve to a Florida State League-best 24-8 on the season.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 14, 2006: At Reading, Zack Segovia makes his Baseballtown debut by going seven shutout innings for the win in a 2-0 victory over Erie. Segovia gives up five hits and a walk while striking out seven. Joey Hammond and J.J. Johnson supply the offense with a pair of 2nd inning homers.

### **New Opponent**

For the first time this season, Reading and New Hampshire meet. The Fisher Cats are 16-15 this season and won four-of-six games at home against Harrisburg last week. After dropping the first two of the series, New Hampshire was won four straight. After this week, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Binghamton.

### Nice to See You Again

For the second time this week, Reading will face Paxton Schultz. Overall, he is 1-3 with a 4.08 ERA over six starts. In 28.2 innings pitched, Schultz has allowed 22 hits, 14 walks and has 31 strikeouts. Tuesday, he earned the win, going six innings, allowing four hits, one-earned run, one walk and six strikeouts. He spent all of 2022 with New Hampshire, going 7-6 with a 4.04 ERA over 25 games and 20 starts for the Fisher Cats.
