LAST TIME OUT: Winston-Salem bested Brooklyn, 5-3, in the opening game of a 6-game series on Tuesday night...2B **Loidel Chapellí** smashed a 2-run home run in the 4th to put the Dash ahead 3-0...LF **Jaylen Palmer** clubbed a solo home run and 3B **Chase Estep** added an RBI double to pull the 'Clones within 3-2 in the 5th...DH **Omar De Los Santos** smashed a home run over the scoreboard in right-center to make it a 5-3 contest in the 7th...RHP **Blade Tidwell** induced 14 swings-and-misses over 4.1 innings, but suffered the loss for Brooklyn...RHP **Jonathan Cannon** went 5.0 frames for his pro win for Winston-Salem...RHP **Tristan Stivors** earned his first career save.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

OMAR ON A ROLL: OF **Omar De Los Santos** is on a 4-game hitting streak to begin his Cyclones career...During the streak, the 23-year-old is 6-for-18 (.333) at the dish with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, and 2 RBI...De Los Santos is also 3-for-3 on stolen base attempts and holds a .979 OPS...Entering Wednesday, the fifth-year pro is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (3) and total bases (11), 3rd in hits (6), and 4th in stolen bases (3)...De Los Santos was tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in 2022 with 70 stolen bases and was named Florida State League MVP.

LABOR PAINS: Few teams have made pitchers labor on the bump than the Brooklyn Cyclones...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn holds 3-of-the-5 players that have seen the most pitches in the South Atlantic League so far in 2023...INF **Kevin Kendall** leads the circuit (73) and IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** (71) is tied for 2nd...C **Kevin Parada** (68) is 5th in the SAL in pitches seen.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES: LHP **Quinn Brodey** and RHP **Manny Rodriguez** made their Cyclones pitching debuts on Saturday afternoon...Brodey yielded one run on one hit, striking out a pair, in 2.1 innings...Rodriguez did not permit a hit or run over 1.2 frames...As an outfielder, Brodey led Brooklyn in RBI (30) in 2017...Rodriguez appeared in 51 games as a shortstop with the franchise in 2018.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn travels to North Carolina for their first matchup against the White Sox' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast nie of the Pale Hose top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), and INF **Loidel Chapellí** (26) are all on Winston-Salem's active roster...INF **Colson Montgomery** (1) and RHP **Jared Kelley** (14) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 in their first 12 matchups against the Dash in 2022...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 from Winston-Salem at Truist Park from September 6-11, the final series of the regular season.

campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

CANARSIE TO CONEY: INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets' "14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30"

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

CAROLINA IN MY MIND: Colón's most recent outing in an official game was at Truist Stadium in Winston-Salem, N.C. last September 9...On the day the Cyclones clinched second half South Atlantic League North Division crown, the 23-year-old earned the win by tossing a career-best 7.0-shutout innings...Colón struck out 8 in Brooklyn's 3-0 victory.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season...Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA'S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)...He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
