ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn and Jersey Shore split a doubleheader with each team eeking out a 2-1 victory. In game one, RHP **Carson Seymour** allowed two earned runs over four innings in the loss, getting outdueled by BlueClaws Top 30 prospect RHP **Cristian Hernandez**. In the nightcap, RHP **Junior Santos** struck out six over five innings of one-run ball, while RHP **Sammy Tavaraz** locked down the save, striking out five of his six outs in relief. Offensively, C **Matt O'Neill** reached three of six times in the doubleheader and OF **Brandon McIlwain** led the way in game two, going 2-3 with a triple.

BMAC ATTACK: OF **Brandon McIlwain** has been on base in eight of his past nine games, hitting .419 with a .526 on-base percentage with two home runs in his past seven games and a 4-for-4 game last Saturday at Bowling Green. McIlwain currently ranks second on the team with a 128 wRC+ and has already matched his career high with eight stolen bases.

MONEYBALL MATT: C **Matt O'Neill** leads the Cyclones with a 140 wRC+ and a .397 wOBA and has reached base in 10 of 16 plate appearances in the series. O'Neill leads Mets minor leaguers with more than 95 plate appearances with a 21.8% walk rate. O'Neill's 140 wRC+ number ranks tied for second in the system with Low-A OF **Omar De Los Santos** (140 wRC+), sitting behind Low-A St. Lucie outfielders **Carlos Dominguez** (145 wRC+).

CONGRATULATIONS: RHP **Jordan Yamamoto** and RHP **Hunter Parsons** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton after Tuesday's game. Parsons has spent three different seasons with Brooklyn. Since 2019, the Maryland native has made 47 of his 51 career appearances with Brooklyn.

NEWCOMERS: Following the promotions of both RHP **Jordan Yamamoto** and RHP **Hunter Parsons**, the Mets promoted LHP **Nathan Lavender** and

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division and the South Atlantic League entering the series. The Cyclones have won seven of the first 10 with the first trip to New Jersey this week. Eight of Philly's top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, are in Jersey Shore, including No. 3 RHP Mick Abel, No. 4 OF Johan Rojas, and No. 7 OF Ethan Wilson.

RHP **Luis Moreno**. Moreno has been used as both a starter (25 times) and reliever (18 times) in his Mets career that began in 2019, while Lavender came to the Mets out of Illinois in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft and has been used exclusively in relief.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 16 home runs in the past 12 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

MAY FLOWERS: INF **Jose Peroza's** month of May has reflected the talent of the No. 29 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*. After an April in which the Venezuelan hit .155 with no extra base hits and three walks, Peroza hit .263 in May with eight walks, four doubles, and two home runs.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** joined the team in Bowling Green last week after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, has been well-rounded in his first full season. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 63 total bases and 14 doubles.

THE HIGH-A DEBUT CONTINUES: Mike Vasil makes his second start at High-A and first against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws.

TOP 30: Vasil ranks as the No. 21 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

FLORIDA PHENOM: Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

TAMP DOWN: In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

VASIL AT VIRGINIA: The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

MASSACHUSETTS MIKE: The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
