Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener in a six-game series at the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Lugnuts are 3-9 against the TinCaps this year, with all of the games taking place in Michigan's state capital. These are the final meetings of the season between the two teams. Southpaw Mac Lardner, coming off six scoreless innings on the 4th of July in his last start, battles TinCaps lefty Noel Vela.

Last Game: Lugnuts 4, Loons 0. Right-hander Jake Walkinshaw struck out nine in four scoreless innings and four Lugnuts relievers wrapped up a five-hit shutout, the Nuts' second shutout of the series, in handing Great Lakes its first series defeat since mid May. The Nuts scored three runs in the second inning and one in the fifth to supply all the offense, with Tyler Soderstrom leading a balanced 10-hit attack with a single and a double in four at-bats.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the TinCaps through Sunday before taking four days off for the Major League Baseball All-Star Break. Only three home games remain this month, from July 22-24 against the Lake County Captains.

Congratulations: Southpaw Jack Owen was nearly perfect last Friday, setting down the first 14 Loons and settling for six innings with one base runner (a Jose Ramos fifth-inning single), striking out seven. For his effort, Owen was honored as the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week. He becomes the second Lugnuts pitcher honored by Minor League Baseball this year, joining Jeff Criswell (May 1).

The Future is Now: Outfielder Denzel Clarke, the A's No. 14 prospect, is among the top prospects selected for the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium this Saturday, July 16. The 22-year-old Clarke, MLB Pipeline's No. 14 Athletics prospect and No. 3 Athletics outfield prospect, becomes the fourth current Lugnut to participate in the Futures Game, joining Ángel Perdomo (2016) and Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017). A native of Pickering, ON, Clarke was drafted by the Athletics in the fourth round in 2021 from Cal State Northridge. He joined the Lugnuts on June 14 from Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .295/.420/.545 with 14 doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 14 stolen bases. He has two doubles and two home runs through 13 games with the Lugnuts, though he has not played since June 29th.

Clean Baseball: The Lugnuts have committed just three errors in their last 11 games, with nine of those games purely error-free. During that stretch, the Nuts' opponent has played eight error-free games.

Zeroes: Lansing pitchers not only blanked the Loons on Friday (a two-hit 1-0 win) and Sunday (a five-hit 4-0 win), the Lugnuts shut out Great Lakes on Thursday until the ninth inning, settling for a 10-1 victory. The Nuts' team ERA is 5.28 entering this series. Before this recent four-game stretch, it was 5.49. Overall, the Lugnuts have a 3.43 ERA in the month of July.

Streaking: INF/OF Joshwan Wright has reached base in 11 consecutive games, hitting .405 (15-for-37) with four walks over that stretch. Wright is coming off an 8-for-17 series vs. Great Lakes

Soder Pop: Tyler Soderstrom had eight RBIs last series and is three away from matching Cedar Rapids' Christian Encarnacion-Strand's total of 60 for the Midwest League lead. Soderstrom is 5th with 134 total bases, tied for 4th with 33 extra-base hits and 5th with 14 home runs. Others among the league leaders include Kumar Nambiar, who is 1st with 29 relief appearances, while Trayson Kubo is tied for 4th with seven saves.

The Injury Bug: When OF Lawrence Butler departed on July 4th and was placed on the Injured List, he became the latest top A's prospect on the Lugnuts' Injured List. Butler (MLB Pipeline's No. 17 prospect) joined pitcher Gunnar Hoglund (No. 6, 60-day IL), outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 9, 7-day IL), pitcher Mason Miller (No. 16, 60-day IL) and pitcher Grant Holman (No. 30, 7-day IL).

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher Max Castillo (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018) and catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Ryan McBroom had gone 5-for-5 at Dayton earlier in the season. On this day, he topped himself, going 6-for-6 to tie the franchise and Midwest League records, supplying three singles, two doubles and a home run, as well as a walk and four RBIs. But Argenis Aldazoro hit a walk-off RBI single in a three-run 13th to give the Dayton Dragons a 10-9 win at Fifth Third Field. The Dragons rallied to tie the game in the 9th and 11th innings, with the Nuts blowing leads of 6-5, 7-6 and 9-7. **2018:** Chavez Young hit a grand slam to erase a 6-2 deficit, and the Nuts defeated Burlington at Community Field, 11-8. Bees starter Oliver Ortega threw six wild pitches (one short of the league record) and struck out nine batters in 4 1/3 innings.

The Next Step: Released by the St. Louis Cardinals on March 28, Mac signed with the Washington Wild Things on April 7... said Washington manager Tom Vaeth, "Mac is an important signing for us, being a rookie and left-handed he helps fill the void left by Hennen's departure. Mac was very successful while at Gonzaga with a reputation as a strike thrower with a three-pitch mix. After bouncing between starting and relieving while with the Cardinals, we feel Mac will return to his old form pitching in the rotation."... unfortunately for Washington, the Oakland Athletics signed Mac on May 4.
