In eight appearances with Binghamton, Thomas went 1-0 with a 0.77 ERA and 0.51 WHIP. He allowed just one earned run on five hits over 11.2 innings with a 13-to-1 strikeout-to-walk ratio. He signed with the Mets on June 5 and tossed six-straight scoreless appearances before earning the promotion to Triple-A.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Erie SeaWolves 5-2 on Friday night. Branden Fryman hit a go-ahead two-out two-run double in the fourth inning to put the Ponies up 2-1. Tyler Stuart made his second Double-A start and allowed two runs over a Double-A career-high seven frames. Stuart has allowed two runs or fewer in all 16 of his starts this year. Erie scored three runs in the eighth to eventually win the game.

Ty-namic: Right-hander **Tyler Stuart** made his second start at the Double-A level on Friday night. He threw a Double-A career-high seven innings. Stuart allowed two runs on a sacrifice fly and solo home run. He totaled one strikeout and did not issue a walk. In 16 starts across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, Stuart leads all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.62 ERA. He has allowed two runs or fewer in every start.

Don't Try Fry: Shortstop **Branden Fryman** extended his hitting streak to four games with a two-out two-run double last night. Since June 20 at Akron, which began Fryman's then-10-game hitting streak, he is hitting .329 with five doubles and two triples. In that 19-game stretch, the 25-year-old has a .442 BAbip and holds an .813 OPS.

Welcome Back, Suozzi: Outfielder/first baseman **Joe Suozzi** was reinstated from the 7-day injured list on Friday. The Long Island native will make his first start for Binghamton since June 23 at Akron. In 22 games for the Rumble Ponies, Suozzi is hitting .293 with an .806 OPS. He has two doubles, a triple, two homers, six runs batted in, 10 runs scored and eight walks at Double-A. He went 2-for-3 with a double, a walk, a stolen base, and two runs scored in a rehab assignment in the Florida Complex League on July 15.

Griffin's last two appearances came with Double-A Binghamton and he was placed on the Development List on on June 24 after his last start and was reinstated on Thursday.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
