**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost the series finale against the Baysox, 5-1, at Prince George's Stadium. The Baysox took a 3-0 lead in the third with a two-run homer by Maverick Handley and an RBI single by Cristopher Cespedes. Zach Watson extended the lead to 5-0 in the seventh with a two-run homer. **Diego Rincones** broke the shutout with an RBI single in the eighth. He finished the game with three hits.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only match-up of the season between the two teams. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-4 against the Fightin Phils, including a 3-3 mark at The Diamond.

**FIREWORKS:** The Flying Squirrels have played at home every season on Independence Day since the franchise's first year in 2010, and each year the game has been sold out. The team's first July 4 game was in 2010 and the Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 4-3, with a walk-off single by Clay Timper in the bottom of the 10th inning. They also won on a walk-off hit by C.J. Hinojosa in 2014, topping the SeaWolves, 4-3. Overall, the Flying Squirrels are 9-2 on July 4, with the only losses coming against Akron in 2013 and 2018.

**FACING THE FIGHTINS ON THE FOURTH:** The Flying Squirrels have played three Independence Day games against the Fightin Phils, going 3-0. Richmond faced Reading on July 4 in 2014 and swept a doubleheader. In Game 1, Kelvin Marte pitched a complete-game shutout and Devin Harris brought in the game's only run in the sixth inning for a 1-0 win. In Game 2, Clayton Blackburn, Josh Osich and Hunter Strickland combined for a shutout in a 2-0 win, with the only runs scoring on a solo homer by Harris in the second and an RBI single by Kelby Tomlinson in the third. They also faced the Fightin Phils on Independence Day in 2016, with Richmond winning, 18-1. Matt Gage started on the mound and worked seven innings, allowing one unearned run. At the plate, Gage had two hits, including a three-run homer and an RBI single, finishing the day with four RBIs. C.J. Hinojosa had four hits, including a homer, and drove in two runs. All time, the Flying Squirrels have outscored the Fightin Phils, 21-1 on July 4.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a four-game losing streak with Saturday's win but lost on Sunday, falling in five-of-six games in the road series against the Baysox to open the second half. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost four and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 840 strikeouts and rank second with 97 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 22-14 at home this year. Richmond is 19-11 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** went 29-40 in the first half, finishing in fifth place in the Northeast Division and ninth overall in the Eastern League. In their first series of the second half, they went 4-2 at home against first-half Northeast Division-champion Somerset in last week's series. Reading's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including C Logan O'Hoppe (3), OF Johan Rojas (4), RHP Griff McGarry (8), RHP Francisco Morales (9), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (11), OF Simon Muzziotti (19) and RHP McKinley Moore (28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his 14th start of the season. Last time out, he tied a franchise record, allowing 10 earned runs over 4.1 innings pitched in a loss against the Baysox on Wednesday in Bowie. Over his previous six starts since May 24, Frisbee went 3-1 with a 2.95 ERA (13 ER/39.2 IP). He has faced the Fightin Phils twice in his career, going 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP/0 BB/16 SO), with both outings coming on the road in May 2021. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Colton Eastman makes his fifth Double-A start of the season. In his last start on Wednesday against the Patriots, Eastman worked a season-high seven innings and allowed one run in a win. He began the year with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, going 0-5 with a 4.93 ERA. He was assigned to Double-A Reading on June 9. Last year, Eastman made 11 appearances and seven starts for Reading, going 0-3 with a 3.55 ERA. He finished the year with four starts in Triple-A with the IronPigs and went 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA. Eastman was selected in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Phillies out of Cal State Fullerton. He has faced the Flying Squirrels two previous times, both also going head-to-head against Matt Frisbee last May in Reading. In those starts, Eastman went 0-1 with a 5.14 ERA (4 ER/7.0 IP).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,198) and total attendance (216,919). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 97 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League with Somerset (98). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 20 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 176 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .439 (29-for-66) with four doubles, five homers and 17 RBIs over his last 17 games since June 7. On June 12 against the SeaWolves, he picked up his first three-hit game of the year, capped with a walk-off single, his second walk-off winning with the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in four of his last 10 games played. In last week's series at Bowie, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. He picked up a season-high four hits last Tuesday in the series opener.

**SHANE TRAIN:** Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .298 (39-for-131) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked sixth in batting average (.287), fourth in OBP (.417) and sixth in OPS (.914).

**TOASTY:** **Frankie Tostado** has picked up four hits in his last two games after batting .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.299), third in hits (75) and eighth in total bases (121).

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 20th homer of the year on Saturday night against the Baysox, tying him with **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He hit a homer last Sunday in the series finale against the Sea Dogs, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissou** (2014) for the second on the list. Roby is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 16 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.299), third in hits (75) and eighth in total bases (121). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (20). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in batting average (.287), fourth in OBP (.417) and sixth in OPS (.914). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for sixth in stolen bases (17). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

**WHERE THE FIGHTIN PHILS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Logan O'Hoppe is tied for seventh in homers (14), seventh in SLG (.531), seventh in OPS (.912) and tied for ninth in runs (42). Josh Ockimey is sixth in OBP (.407) and first in walks (56). Vito Friscia is seventh in OBP (.402) and third in walks (49). Jonathan Guzman and Kevin Vicuna are tied for second in triples (4). Brian Marconi is tied for second in games pitched (28) and tied for first in saves (10). McKinley Moore is fourth in games pitched (27) and Bubby Rossman is fifth (26).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (10), **Ricardo Genoves** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
