TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Gwinnett Stripers (Atlanta Braves) are set for game three of their six-game series on Thursday. Gwinnett took a 2-0 series lead after their 6-3 victory on Wednesday night. The Stripers did all of their damage in the top half of the second inning. RF Ben Gamel and CF José Azocar tallied back-to-back RBI doubles to start the scoring. Azocar would later score from third on a fielder's choice, LF Luke Williams scored on a 3B Nacho Alvarez Jr. groundout and SS Jim Jarvis came home on 1B Rowdy Tellez's double. After eight scoreless frames, the Express posted a crooked number in the ninth. But RHP Austin Pope retired the side, salvaging the 6-3 Gwinnett victory.

ALEJANDRO'S ON IT

OF Alejandro Osuna went 2-for-5 with an RBI and a strikeout on Wednesday night, marking back-to-back multi-hit games. Osuna is batting .300 (6-20) and leads the Express with 19 balls in play and a 47.1 hard hit percentage. Since the start of the 2025 season, Osuna has drawn 19 walks at the Triple-A level for a 21.1% walk rate, the highest of any PCL player in that span (min. 75 PA).

PITCHING POWER

The Express bullpen posted its first shutout of the season on Wednesday night. Relievers RHP Mason Thompson, RHP Marc Church, RHP Patrick Murphy and RHP Michel Otañez held the Stripers to four hits in the final 4.1 innings. Round Rock's bullpen ranks second in all of Triple-A with a 1.67 ERA. RHP Gavin Collyer ranks second in the Pacific Coast League with a 44% whiff rate and RHP Peyton Gray is fifth at 42.9%. Round Rock's pitching staff, as a whole, leads the PCL in strikeout percentage (25.5%) while holding opponents to a league-best, .207 expected batting average.

BRADFORD TOES THE SLAB

LHP Cody Bradford joins the Express on a Major League Rehab assignment, marking his first action since Sept. 25, 2024. The southpaw missed the entirety of the 2025 season after suffering a left elbow sprain that required 'internal brace' surgery. Bradford owns a 10-6 record and a 4.28 ERA over 34 appearances (21 GS) for the Rangers from 2023-24. The Aledo, Texas native was named the 2023 PCL Pitcher of the Year after going 9-2 with a 3.63 ERA over 14 starts with the E-Train. Bradford started the season with Round Rock and made seven starts before he made his Major League debut on May 15, 2023 against the Atlanta Braves. He also appeared in 5 postseason games during Texas' 2023 World Series championship run, going 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, APRIL 2, 1993

Nolan Ryan returns to pitch at the Astrodome for the first time since leaving the Astros as the Rangers played an exhibition game in Houston. Before the game, Ryan accepted a saddle from the Astros. The largest crowd ever to watch a baseball game in Texas, 53,657, came to see Ryan pitch as former President George H.W. Bush threw out the first pitch. While Ryan went 6.0 innings and allowed four runs in a 4-3 loss, the game was secondary to his homecoming.

No one in the lineup for the Astros that day had reached the first grade by the time Ryan was in the majors. Twenty-five year-old Luis Gonzalez had three hits while 27-year-old Craig Biggio batted leadoff and went 0-for-3. Astros owner when Ryan left for Texas prior to the 1989 season, John McMullen, was paraphrased in the Houston Post, "If I knew then what I know now, I would have never let him go. But if I knew then what I know now, I wouldn't have voted for Nixon."

C Ed Taubensee was elated to collect a hit off Ryan.

"I'm glad I had the opportunity to face him because I probably never will have it again. When I got (the hit), I tried not to look at him. I was scared. I didn't want him to do anything to me the next time I went up there. But it was Nolan Ryan. I kind of peeked when he wasn't looking."

CAREER NOTES

- Set to make his first appearance since 9/25/24 at Oakland.
- Was the starting pitcher against the A's in their penultimate game at the Oakland Coliseum.
- Threw 3.2 IP allowing 1 run, 1 earned run, 6 hits, 3 walks and struck out 4...was not the pitcher of record.
- Missed the entire 2025 season due to a left elbow sprain which ultimately required 'internal brace' surgery.
- Went 6-3 with a 3.54 ERA (30 ER/76.1 IP) over 14 games/13 starts in 2024 - his first 'full' Major League season - although a low back strain/rib stress fracture sidelined him for a large chunk of that campaign.
- In his 2023 MLB debut season, went 4-3 with a 5.30 ERA over 56.0 IP spanning 20 G/8 GS.
- Also appeared in 5 postseason games during Texas' 2023 World Series championship run, going 1-0 with 1.17 ERA.
- Split 2023 season with Round Rock and Texas...made 14 appearances (14 GS), posting a 9-2 record and a 3.63 ERA...was named PCL Pitcher of the Year.
- Had his contract selected on 5/15 after going 5-0 with a 0.64 ERA...named Rangers Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month and PCL Pitcher of the Month for April.
- Made his Major League debut on 5/15/23 vs. Atlanta.
- Became 4th-ever native Texan to make his MLB debut as a starting pitcher for the Rangers in Arlington (also Glen Otto, Chris Young and Jim Gideon).
- Tossed 5.0 IP, allowed 7 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO...took the loss in the 12-0 shutout at Globe Life Field.
- Paced all Rangers farmhands in both strikeouts (252) and innings pitched (215.0) from 2021-22...named a 2021 Texas Organization All-Star (MLB.com) in his first professional action.

2025 NOTES

- Missed the entire 2025 campaign due to a left elbow sprain which ultimately required surgical intervention ('internal brace' surgery on left elbow on 6/25/25).

AMATEUR/PERSONAL NOTES

- Pitched collegiately for three seasons at Baylor University from 2017-19, posting a 12-11 record and 3.86 ERA (76 ER/177.1 IP) over 32 G/31 GS.
- Had his best year as a sophomore in 2018, when he was named Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Year after going 7-6 with a 2.51 ERA and 87 strikeouts in 96.2 innings over 14 starts.
- Became first pitcher in Baylor program history to throw back-to-back complete game shutouts, doing so on 4/20/18 vs. TCU and 4/27/18 at Kansas State.
