LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned their 2nd-straight victory with a 5-1 triumph over Jersey Shore on Friday night...RHP Blade Tidwell tied a career-high with 7.0 innings pitched and punched out a career-best 11, earning his team-leading 5th victory of 2023...The 22-year-old allowed 1 run on 3 hits...RHP Paul Gervase tossed a pair of scoreless innings to close out the win, earning his 2nd save...DH Kevin Parada powered a solo home run to left in the 1st and RF Stanley Consuegra added one of his own in the 8th...CF Alex Ramírez added an RBI double in the Cyclones' 3-run 2nd...1B Rixon Wingrove tallied a multi-hit game for the BlueClaws, while C Anthony Quirion provided the team's only run with a solo home run in the 5th.

TURNING THE TIDE: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023... The 22-year-old has tossed 3-straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in all 3 outings, permitting just 2 run on 10 hits over 20.0 innings...He has walked only 4 (5.6 BB%) and struck out 26 (36.6 K%) in those contests...He whiffed a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 on Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 8 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 5-0 with a 1.34 ERA (6 ER in 40.1 IP) with just 20 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 59 (36.6 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .146 batting average (20-137) against him... Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (146) and is 2nd in strikeouts (59) and 3rd in ERA (1.34) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 2nd in the SAL in batting average against (185), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (86), and 4th in wins (5).

PITCHING IN: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pictching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted an Mil.B-low 2.53 ERA (97 ER in 345.0 IP) over their last 40 games, holding a 22-18 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.82) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.2% and a walk rate of 11.5%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (11) and have accrued the lowest opposing OPS (.589) in Mil.B over that time period...The Cyclones are also 3rd in hits-per-9 innings (6.60)...RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.34) and Tyler Stuart (1.43) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in Mil.B during that time (min. 40.0 IP).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.06) in not only the entire South Atlantic League, but throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East is 2nd (3.16) in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.46) is 2nd in the circuit...RHP Paul Gervase (1.10) and RHP Wilkin Ramos (1.54) hold the top 2 ERA's among SAL relievers (min. 25.0 IP).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless nings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 6-straight scoreless outings since the date (11.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.78 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.7% strikeout rate.

FINISHING STRONG: After suffering a walk-off defeat in 3-of-4 games to start a road series in Aberdeen, Brooklyn closed out the month of June with a flourish...Starting with Saturday, June 17's win over the IronBirds, the Cyclones won 8-of-11 contests to finish the season's third month... In that time, the Cyclones have the South Atlantic League's lowest ERA (2.00) and batting average against (.165)...Brooklyn's 8-3 mark is tied for the 2nd-best record in the circuit in that time frame... Only Hickory (10-1) has a better win percentage.

STAN THE MAN: OF Stanley Consuegra has made an impact since being reinstated off the injured list prior to Wednesday's series opener...The 22-year-old collected a double in his return on Thursday evening and added a massive solo home run in the 8th inning on Friday...Consuegra's home run traveled 416 feet and carried an exit velocity of 1097 mph...Prior to landing on the IL, the Dominican native slashed .246/.306/.455 with a .761 OPS...Consuegra added 16 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 19 RBI in 35 games.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart tossed 7.0 more innings of 1-run ball on Thursday, earning his 3rd win...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his previous start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro... Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP Kevin Canelon whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Wilmington's LHP Jake Bennett (1.77) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.1%), is 2nd in FIP (3.01), 4th in xFIP (3.37), WHIP (1.06), and innings pitched (69.2), 6th in strikeouts (79) and batting average against (.206), and 10th in strikeout rate (28.4%) and walk rate (7.9%),

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks... Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .329/.382/.614 with a .996 OPS and 168 wRC+ in 18 games...Parada has accrued 9 runs scored, a double, 2 triples, 5 home runs, 15 RBI, 5 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Saturday on an 10-game hitting streak (15-for-39; .385/.429/.821) and a 15-game on-base streak (.3397/.632)...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Saturday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (15), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (26), 7th in total bases (110), and tied for 8th in hits (65).

WALK THIS WAY: OF Alex Ramírez is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (16) and is 4th walks (17) during the month of June...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (66) and is 25 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He is also tied for 3rd in doubles (27) and 6th in hits (119) and total bases (178).

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9...Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones will then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

ON THE MEND: Brooklyn currently has 3 players on their roster undergoing rehab assignments: RHP Elieser Hernández, RHP Sean Reid-Foley, and OF Abraham Almonte...Hernández joined the Cyclones on Sunday and has made 2 relief appearances...The 28-year-old has permitted 2

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 12-game homestand, finishg with 6 contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 5 of new York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: RHP Orion Kerkering (6), INF Hao Yu Lee (7), OF Gabriel Rincones (10), C Caleb Ricketts (19), and RHP Tommy McCollum (23)... Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening series of 2023... Brooklyn captured 2-of-3 games...The Cyclones are 6-8 against the BlueClaws in the first 14 meetings of the campaign... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn is 43-31 all-time against Jersey Shore (.581).

runs on 3 hits over 2.0 innings, striking out 3 (33.3 K%)...Reid-Foley was added to the roster on Wednesday and made his first appearance later that day...The 27-year-old posted a perfect frame of relief, striking out 2...Almonte joined Brooklyn on June 20...The 34-year-old is 2-for-10 (.200) at the plate in 5 games with 3 RBI and 7 walks (38.9 BB%).

OH MY, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 28 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 98 stolen bases in that span, which is ited for 4th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (105), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (103), and Dísakos prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (99) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 4 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF Omar De Los Santos provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in Sunday's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH Kevin Parada delivered a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...18 Chase Estep provided a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramirez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...211% (15-of-71) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 23.7% (9-of-38) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...36.6% (26-of-71) have been determined by just 1 run.

DINKY DONUTS: RHP Joshua Cornielly (3.0 IP), RHP Dylan Tebrake (2.1), LHP Eli Ankeney (1.2), and RHP Wilkin Ramos (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 2-0 win vs. Hudson Valley on Saturday evening...That marked the Cyclones' st donut of an opponent since a 5-0 victory at Aberdeen last Saturday..RHP Blade Tidwell (7.0 IP) and Tebrake (2.0) united on a 4-hit blanking of the IronBirds...It was also the Cyclones second shutout of Hudson Valley this season...RHP Tyler Stuart (6.1 IP) and RHP Jace Beck (0.2) picked up a 4-hitter in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21... The 'Clones have accumulated 6 shutouts through the first 67 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 11 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER in 19.0 IP) on 7 hits and 9 walks, registering 28 strikeouts (13.26 K/9)...That equates to a 38.4 K% (28/73).

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...Over his last 4 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 9.1 innings, earning a save and allowing only 3 hits, 4 walks, and striking out 9...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.29 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 28.6% strikeout rate with a 11.4% walk rate.

HOMER HAPPY: Last Friday night, the Cyclones set a team season-high with 4 home runs vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn's previous high water mark was 3 on June 13 at Aberdeen...It was the first time the 'Clones had clubbed at least 4 home runs in a single game since July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF Alex Ramirez homered twice on a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run blast in the 6th...C José Mena and 1B Joe Suozzi went back-to-back in the 7th...Brooklyn's 3-home run 3rd inning on Friday was also the first for the franchise since the team smashed a trio in the top of the 5th on July 27, 2021, at Jersey Shore...DH Edgardo Fermín (2-run) and SS Ronny Mauricio went back-to-back before 2B Luis González added a 2-run shot of his own later in the frame...Friday also marked the first time the Cyclones have poked 4+ home runs at Maimonides Park since a 5-home barrage on September 18, 2021, vs. Jersey Shore...CF Jaylen Palmer, C Oscar Campos, 2B Luke Ritter, DH Francisco Álvarez, and 1B Wilmer Reyes all went deep.

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in last Tuesday's defeat and added another scoreless inning in relief, earning the win, on Sunday...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8 on Tuesday... Over his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.00 ERA (4 ER in 12.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 12.0 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 33.3% (16/48) in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

NORTHERN BOUND: Ankeney started his 2023 season with Single-A St. Lucie when he joined the squad on April 16...Had a stint on the 7-day injured list from May 10-23...Did not allow an earned run (1 total) over 9.0 innings and 6 relief appearances...Permitted just 2 hits and 2 walks, striking out 14 (46.7 K%)...Transferred to Brooklyn on June 3.

2022: Ankeney made his professional debut with the Florida Complex League Mets after signing on August 1 and being assigned on August 12...Made 3 relief appearances and did not yield a run or hit over 3.1 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out 6 (60.0 K%)...Struck out 2 of 3 hitters faced in his debut on August 13 vs. the FCL Cardinals.

UP THE ANTE-LOPE: Ankeney was selected by the New York Mets in the 20th round of the 2022 MLB draft out of Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Ariz...Spent 3 seasons with the Antelopes...Tallied a 3-3 record with a 2.68 ERA (12 ER in 40.1 IP) and 61 strikeouts (37.2 K%) in 29 appearances... Did not pitch in the 2020 campaign due to injury...Played his final season at GCU with his younger brother, Beau, who played infield and outfield.

SCRAPPY BUNCH: Prior to being drafted last summer, Ankeney made 5 relief appearances for the Mahoning Valley Scrappers of the new MLB Draft League...Ankeney tallied a 3.38 ERA (2 ER in 5.1 IP) with 6 strikeouts...Was managed by former New York Yankees infielder Homer Bush, whose son, Homer Jr., was Ankeney's college teammate at Grand Canyon...Bush now manages the Staten Island FerryHawks of the Atlantic League.
